The Transient Student Application for Admission is designed for students who are enrolled at another college or university but wish to enroll in coursework at Baldwin-Wallace College for one semester with the purpose of transferring that coursework back to their home institution.

To qualify as a transient student at Baldwin-Wallace College, students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 and be considered in good academic standing at their home institution.

Admission to B-W as a transient student is approved for one term only. If a transient student wishes to continue with courses at B-W after one term, he or she must complete a new Transient Student Application form and submit it to the Registrar from the home institution for continued approval. This process must be completed each term a student plans to enroll at Baldwin-Wallace College as a transient student.

Transient students are permitted to register for classes at Baldwin-Wallace College once pre-registration has been completed for degree-seeking students; therefore, course availability may be limited. An admission counselor can assist you in course selection.

B-W course work may apply toward a degree at the student's home institution, based upon approval by that institution.

To apply:

- Complete the top portion of the application form and forward it to the Registrar's Office of your home institution for verification of your enrollment there in good academic standing.
- The Registrar at your home institution should complete the bottom portion of the application and return it to the B-W Office of Admission.
