The following corrections by the author to “Bach and the Middle Ages” by E. Frederick Flindell should be noted:

- on p. 4, in the 12th line, it should read: “Renaissance” instead of “enaissance”
- on p. 25, in the third line of footnote 67, it should read: “numeros ρυθμος” and in the fourth line “μέτροις id es ...”
- on p. 43, in the 8th line (from the bottom), it should read; *ibid.*, “Commentary as ...” instead of Boyce, “Commentary as ...”,
- on p. 46, in the first line of footnote 128, it should read: Q VIII, 3, 5, instead of A VIII, 3, 5,
- on p. 49, in Part IV in the eleventh line, it should read: “inheritance” instead of “in heritance”
- on p. 71, in the third line of footnote 203, it should read: done well by others instead of ... done wellby others
- on p. 77, in the fourth line of footnote 225, it should read: [in detail], to perform instead of [in detail] to perform
- on p. 79, in footnote 231, it should read Q X, 2, 22 instead of Quintilian QX, 2, 22
- on p. 87, in the column under Quintilian, in the second line under molossus, it should read: ”Q IX., 4, 57” instead of “Q L VII, 193”
- on p. 92, in the ninth line under 1a-2, it should read: “secundum modum” instead of “secundummodum”,
- on p. 93, in the second line under Johannes de Garlandia ... (Wiesbaden: Steiner, 1972), 35-37, it should read: “intentio de ipsa” instead of “intentio de pisa”
- on p. 94, in the seventh line of the Latin text 1b-2, it should read: “Modi generales” instead of “Modi grenerales”
- on p. 97, in the fifth line, it should read: περίοδον instead of περζίοδον
- on p. 103, in the column under Thierry of Chartres at B., it should read: “Ars intrinsecus” instead of “Ars extrinsecus”,
- on p. 107, at 10., it should read: “the metrical modes” instead of “the metorical modes”
