

**Middle Childhood Generalist Endorsement
Additional Course Requirements**

Please Note: The Middle Childhood Generalist Endorsement is ONLY available to students who are currently enrolled in Middle Childhood Education in TWO content areas.

If you do NOT have math as one of the initial concentration areas:

MTH-111	Mathematics for Early & Middle Childhood Teachers I	4 hrs.
MTH-112	Mathematics for Early & Middle Childhood Teachers II	4 hrs.

If you do NOT have science as one of the initial concentration areas:

BIO-101	Human Biology	3 hrs.
BIO-122L	Principles of Biology II	4 hrs.
AST-121	Astronomy of the Solar System	3 hrs.

If you do NOT have language arts/reading as one of the initial concentration areas:

ENG-131	Workshop in Exposition and Argument	3 hrs.
EDU-341	Adolescent/Young Adult Literature	2 hrs.
EDU-343	Reading Instruction in Middle Childhood	3 hrs.

If you do NOT have social studies as one of the initial concentration areas:

One course from each of TWO areas for a total of six (6) semester hours:

ECN-100	Survey of Economics	3 hrs.
POL-201	American National Government	3 hrs.

SOC-100D	Principals of Sociology	4 hrs.

Students seeking the middle childhood generalist endorsement will need to take an additional methods course per the schedule below with a field component in the 4th, 5th, or 6th grades. Students need to have completed the content prior to taking the required methods course for the generalist endorsement. Students may take the 3rd methods course concurrently with one or more methods courses.
