Information and Instructions for Nominating

QUALIFICATIONS

ATHLETE:

1. An athlete's class must have graduated at least ten years prior to selection.
2. The award is based on an athlete's accomplishments while a student at B-W.
3. Criteria to be considered shall include the level of competition; awards and recognition including all-star teams and other honors; school and conference record holders; leadership; and impact on B-W's athletic program.
4. The candidate should represent the finest qualities and highest standards of student-athletes at Baldwin-Wallace.

COACH/ATHLETIC ADMINISTRATOR:

A coach or athletic administrator must have lettered at Baldwin-Wallace or served on the B-W staff at least ten (10) years, and must be retired prior to selection.

HONORARY:

An honorary candidate would not otherwise qualify as a B-W athlete, retired coach or athletic administrator. There are two types of honorary candidates:

1. An honorary Hall of Fame candidate must have made a significant impact on the B-W athletic program; or,
2. An honorary candidate must have achieved regional, state, national or international levels of recognition for athletics outside of Baldwin-Wallace.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

The Selection Committee will pick a maximum of four (4) inductees. In special circumstances, the Selection Committee shall have the power to make exceptions. The Committee will strive to select a class of inductees which represents the depth and breadth of all athletes and sports at B-W.

SELECTION COMMITTEE – Composed of at least 10 persons:

1. President of Baldwin-Wallace College, or his designee
2. Athletic Director of Baldwin-Wallace College
3. Officers of the Association
4. Past Presidents of the Association
5. Selected members of the Association (past officers, members-at-large)
6. Four or more members of the B-W Athletic Hall of Fame
7. Current and past coaches
8. Director of the Office of Alumni and Parents Relations

NOMINATIONS

All alumni are encouraged to send their nominations at any time throughout the year. Detailed information on the nominees will be prepared. Candidates will be considered for selection for five (5) years from the date of their most current nomination and candidates may be renominated. The selection meeting will take place in the summer for induction on Homecoming Weekend.
