Yellow Jacket Sports Report

BEREA, OHIO -- In addition to today's swimming and diving teams competing against Wilmington College, six other Yellow Jacket teams are in action.

This morning in Ada, Ohio, the men's (53-34) and women's (62-31) cross country teams are competing at the annual OAC Championship Meet, hosted by Ohio Northern. The B-W women have won 16 of the 26 titles since the OAC began sponsoring women's championships in 1985. To date, junior Kenny Janosko (Mentor) has led the men's team and junior Sarah Rospert (Milan) the women's squad. The meet began at 11:00 a.m.

The football team, 6-1 overall and 5-1 in the OAC, hosted the Fighting Muskies of Muskingum on Professor Appreciation Day at 1:30 p.m. Sophomore Josiah Holt (Elyria/ Grafton Midview) is this week's OAC *Special Teams Player of the Week*. Junior quarterback Ryan O'Rourke (Avon/ Senior) and junior running back Tyler Lohr (Kent/ Roosevelt) have paced the offense and senior linebacker Brett Thompson (Shelby) and senior defensive end Derron Hamilton (Euclid) lead the defense.

The volleyball team entered its 12:00 noon Seniors' & Parents' Day match against Muskingum at 16-12 overall and 4-4 in the OAC, is taking on Muskingum University today, at 12:00 p.m. on Senior/Parent's day. Junior outside hitter Amanda Sawicki (Mentor/ Lake Catholic) leads the offense and is second in the OAC with 338 kills. Junior setter Natalie Emmons (Ashland) anchors the defense and is third in the OAC with 530 defensive digs. Prior to the match, seniors Chelsea Nissen (Williston/ Genoa) and Mandy Mass (North Royalton) and their parents will be recognized for their contributions to the program.

The women's soccer team entered its 1:00 p.m. final regular season match at Muskingum with a 10-8 overall and a 3-5 OAC record. Sophomore forward Heather Keller (Parma) leads the team in scoring and has a four goals and a team-best five assists for 13 points. Senior midfielder Lindsey Cooper (Westererville/ New Albany) is second on the team with 11 points on a team-best five goals and one assist.

The men's soccer team, 14-4 overall and 5-3 in the OAC, plays Muskingum at 3:00 p.m. in its final regular season match. The men open OAC Tournament play on Monday, Oct. 31 at Finnie Stadium at 7:00 p.m. Senior all-time leading scorer Carlin Vandendriessche (Medina) tops the team and OAC in scoring.

Yellow Jackets Open the 2011-12 Swimming & Diving Season With an OAC Dual Meet Against Wilmington College

BEREA, OHIO – The Baldwin-Wallace College swimming and diving teams open the 2011-12 season today against Ohio Athletic Conference rival Wilmington College in the B-W Natatorium inside the Lou Higgins Recreation Center.

Last season, the men finished with a record of 3-1 in the OAC and an overall record of 7-5-1. The team set six school records and two B-W Natatorium records. The Yellow Jacket women finished 0-4 in the OAC and 2-12 overall. The team set 10 school and one Natatorium record. The ladies are bringing back eleven varsity letterwinners, while eight varsity lettermen return to another season of Swimming and Diving, as Baldwin-Wallace College introduces their new Head Coach, **Laura Wolff**.

Leading the men's team this year are senior freestyler **Nic Null**, junior diver **Tony Tijerina**, junior freestyler **Matthew Zych**, and sophomore **Patrick Donhoe**, competing in the butterfly, breaststroke, and individual medley events.

In 2010-2011, **Null** competed in his third season of swimming and set team bests in the 50 free, 100 free, and the 200 free. He also swam the 50 breaststroke and was second best on the team. **Null** also competed in the 400 medley relay at the OAC Championships, taking second, and set a school record in the 200 free relay.

Competing in his second season of diving, **Tijerina** posted career bests last season in the 1 meter optional. He also established personal-best times in the 50-meter freestyle, the 50-meter butterfly, and in the 100-meter butterfly.

Zych completed last season with personal bests in 50 free, 100 free, 200 free, 50 fly, and 100 fly. He was also a part of last season's record breaking 200 Free Relay team.

Competing in his first season of swimming for the Yellow Jackets last year, **Donhoe** had a team best time in the 500 freestyle, 50 breaststroke, and the 400 IM. He took second place in the 400 IM at the OAC Championships, achieving both a team best and a school record. In addition to his team bests, **Donhoe** also swam the 200 freestyle, 50 breaststroke, 100 breaststroke, 200 breaststroke, 200 fly, and the 200 IM.

Leading this season's Lady Yellow Jackets are junior diver **Julie Pinter**, junior **Kelsey Richards** and sophomore **Emma Gerdes**, both competing in freestyle and backstroke events, and sophomore **Angela Musille**, competing in breaststroke and individual medley events.

Pinter competed in her second season of diving and earned her second varsity letter last year. She reset the school-record in the 1-meter optional diving event versus Penn State Behrend, earned OAC Swimmer of the Week last January, set the school-record in the 3-meter optional diving event at Ohio Northern, won the 1-meter and 3-meter events at the 2011 OAC Championships, and was named as the OAC Diver of the Year for the second straight season. **Pinter** also became a four-time NCAA Division III All-American by placing fourth in the 1-meter event and sixth in the 3-meter event.

Competing in her second season of swimming **Richards** had two personal bests last

season in the 100 backstroke and 200 backstroke. She was also a part of last season's record breaking 200 Free Relay team.

Gerdes competed in her first season of swimming last season and had a team best in the 100 meter backstroke and also in the 50 meter backstroke. **Gerdes** was also a part of last year's record breaking 200 Medley Relay.

As a freshman in 2010-2011, **Musille** was named as the Ohio Athletic Conference Female Swimmer of the Week for her efforts at Wilmington College last October and again in December for her performance at the SUNY-Fredonia (N.Y.) Invitational Meet where she set school records in the 100 and 200-yard breaststroke events. **Musille** also earned All-OAC honors in the 200-meter breaststroke and the 100-meter breaststroke. She was a member of the OAC Champion 200-meter medley relay team as well.

B-W returns to action on Saturday, Nov. 5 as they travel to Penn State Behrend. Meet time is 1:00 p.m.

Interim Head Coach Laura Wolff

Baldwin-Wallace College hired Laura Wolff to be its interim head men's and women's swimming and diving coach on September 29, 2011. She replaced Sara Gildea who left to become the head assistant coach at Savannah College (Ga.) of Art & Design.

Wolff is a 1999 graduate of Magnificat High School in Rocky River, a 2003 graduate of St. Bonaventure (N.Y.) University and is currently working on her master's degree in early childhood education at Canisius (N.Y.) University.

Most recently, Wolff was and continues to be the coach of the Lake Shore Swim Club in Rocky River. She took over that position in August of 2009. Previously, she was a volunteer assistant men's swim coach at The Ohio State University during the 2008-2009 season, and she served as the head men's and women's swimming and diving coach at Canisius. While at Canisius, her team's set 41 school records and had its best finish in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference.
