The **BALDWIN-WALLACE COLLEGE YELLOW JACKET** men's basketball team travels to Bethany, West Virginia for its first road contest of the season when it plays the Bison of Bethany College in a non-league game in the Hummel Field House at 7:00 p.m. This is the second game of the regular season for B-W and the 17th all-time meeting between the Yellow Jackets and Bison.

**Pre-Game Setup** -- The Yellow Jackets opened the 2011-12 season on Tuesday, November 15 when they defeated Cleveland cross-town and nonleague rival Case Western Reserve University, 73-60, in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in the Lou Higgins Center Berea. B-W had a 9-16 overall record a year ago and returns 10 lettermen and four starters. The Jackets are tabbed to finish seventh in the rugged Ohio Athletic Conference.

The Bison enter this game 1-0 following an impressive, 82-60 win at Allegheny College in Meadville, Pennsylvania on Nov. 15. The Bison compiled a 21-8 record, won their 13th Presidents Athletic Conference title but lost in the first round of the NCAA Division III Tournament a year ago.

**The All-Time Series Between B-W and Bethany** -- This is the 17th all-time meeting between Baldwin-Wallace and Bethany in men's basketball. The Yellow Jackets led the all-time series, 14-2, including a 76-71 victory a year ago in Berea. B-W has won three straight contests versus the Bison. The last Bethany win came on Nov. 28, 2001 when it beat the Yellow Jackets, 75-68 in Bethany.

**In the Last B-W versus Bethany Game on Nov. 18, 2010 in Berea: B-W -- 76, Bethany -- 71** -- In the last season's meeting between B-W and Bethany, on November 15 in Berea, the Yellow Jackets prevailed, 76-71, in the Ursprung Gym. The game was close throughout until B-W went on a 8-4 run in the final 2:18 to secure the victory. B-W was led by current 6'6" sophomore All-Ohio Athletic Conference forward **Kyle Payne (Brunswick)** with a game-high 19 points and five rebounds. Also, current 6'6" junior forward **Chris Ameen (Broadview Heights/ Walsh Jesuit)** added 16 points and a team-high eight rebounds and current 5'10" senior All-OAC point guard Promis Cabbil scored 10 points and grabbed six rebounds. Bethany was led by current All-PAC 6'6" senior forward British Alexander with 18 points and six rebounds and current 6'3" junior forward Nick Wilcox with eight points and five assists.

**The Baldwin-Wallace College Starters and Information** -- Look for **Head Coach Duane Sheldon** to give 10-to-12 players court time. B-W likes to run with the basketball and will play aggressive man-to-man defense.

Look for **Duane Sheldon** to start 6'7" transfer **Kyle Payne (Brunswick/ via Division II Wheeling, W.Va. Jesuit)**, 6'2" junior **Ben Umbel (Poland/ Seminary via Div. I Youngstown State University)** and **Kyle Payne** at the forward positions. In the backcourt, look for **Promis Cabbil** and 6'4" sophomore **Kevin Krakowiak (Valley City/ Parma Heights Holy Name)** to start. In its 73-60 season-opening win versus CWRU, **Krakowiak** led the way with 12 points, three assists, one rebound and a steal in 30 minutes without a turnover. **Payne** scored 11 points and grabbed six rebounds, **Umbel** and **Farrell** each had nine points and **Cabbil** had four points and three steals.

Off the bench, Sheldon played 6'0" red-shirt freshman guard **Jaron Crowe (Mentor)**, 6'6" junior forward **Chris Ameen (Broadview Heights/ Walsh Jesuit)**, 6'8" sophomore center **Aaron Selmek (Delaware/ Columbus St. Francis DeSales)**, 6'1" sophomore guard **Grant Fairhurst (Ashland)**, 6'3" junior guard **Brandon Schmidt (Wellington)**, 6'3" junior forward **Scott Branchick (Mentor)** and 6'5" junior forward **Sean Rothermel (Delaware/ Hayes)**. **Crowe** and **Ameen** each scored 10 points in the win versus CWRU. In addition, **Ameen** had a team-high seven rebounds and **Crowe** had a team-high five assists. **Selmek** added six points and **Schmidt** two to lead a 28-19 bench scoring advantage for B-W.

**Bethany W. Va. College Information and Probable Starters** -- In 2010-11, Bethany had a 21-8 overall record. The Bison lost, 78-50, to Manchester (Ind.) College in the first round of the NCAA tournament. Look for Head Coach Andrew Sachs to play seven main players and then rely on others for "spot" playing time.

Look for Sachs to start 5'10" junior James Barton and 5'11" junior Reece Mabery at the two guard positions and Nick Wilcox, British Alexander and 6'5" sophomore Leslie Addy at the forward spots. In Bethany's 82-60 season-opening win at Allegheny (Pa.), Alexander had a team-high 19 points and a game-high 12 rebounds and five blocked shots. Barton was second with 18 points, Mabery had 16 points and a team-high four assists, Wilcox had 13 points, four rebounds and six steals and Addy had nine points and four steals.

Off the bench, look for Sachs to utilize 6'3" junior forward Brady Pacific and 6'3" freshman guard Dylan Gravatt the most. Pacific played 22 minutes at Allegheny and had seven points, two rebounds and two assists. Gravatt played nine minutes but did not score. A number of other players saw minimal court time in the 22-point blowout win.

**Yellow Jackets Heading to Kentucky During Winter Break --** The Yellow Jackets travel to Lexington, Kentucky the week before Christmas to participate in the Transylvania (Ky.) University Don Lane Classic. B-W plays Wasbash (Ind.) College on Dec. 20 at 5:30 p.m. and then play either Transylvania or Hendrix (Tenn.) College on Dec. 21 at either 5:00 (consolation game) or 7:00 p.m. (championship game).

**B-W Picked to Finish Seventh in OAC --** B-W is picked by the Ohio Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Coaches to finish seventh this season.

**Early Road Games --** The Yellow Jackets play eight of their first 10 games on the road.

**Two Doubleheaders to be Televised by SportsTime Ohio --** Two B-W women's and men's basketball doubleheaders will be televised this winter on regional cable television giant SportsTime Ohio. The two DHs are the Saturday, January 28 doubleheader versus Wilmington College and the Saturday, February 18 Seniors' Day doubleheader versus Ohio Northern University.
