The **BALDWIN-WALLACE COLLEGE YELLOW JACKET** men's basketball team travels to New Concord, Ohio looking to break a two-game losing streak to Ohio Athletic Conference rival Muskingum University on Saturday, December 17, 2011 on Performance Court in the Muskingum Recreation Center at 3:00 p.m. This is B-W's eighth game of the regular season and fourth OAC contest.

**RADIO** -- Baldwin-Wallace College campus radio station WBWC, 88.3 FM, broadcasts all Yellow Jacket men's and women's games, home and away. The games also can be heard via the WBWC's Internet Web site at [www.wbwc.com](http://www.wbwc.com). The pregame show begins 15 minutes prior to tipoff.

**Pre-game Setup** -- The Yellow Jackets enter this game at 5-2 overall and 2-1 OAC record following their 59-56 loss at Wilmington College on Saturday, December 10 in Wilmington. B-W has won four of its past five games, including OAC victories against previously No.4-ranked Marietta College, 93-74, on Dec. 3 in Berea and a 90-69 triumph against Heidelberg University in Tiffin on Dec. 7.

Muskingum enters this game with a 2-6 overall and 0-3 OAC record following its 64-52 loss to Heidelberg in New Concord last Saturday (Dec. 10). The Fighting Muskies have lost three straight OAC contests, including to Ohio Northern University, 63-48, on Dec. 3 in New Concord and 87-77 to then No.10-ranked Marietta in Marietta on Dec. 7.

**The All-Time Series Between B-W and Muskingum** -- This is the 96th all-time meeting between B-W and Muskingum in men's basketball. The Fighting Muskies lead the all-time series, 53-42, including two straight wins. Muskingum won both games last season, including a 71-68 victory in Berea on December 19, 2010 and a 67-66 triumph in New Concord on February 5, 2011. The last B-W win came on February 13, 2010 in Berea by an 86-73 score.

**In the Last Meeting Between B-W and Muskingum on February 5, 2011 in New Concord: Muskingum -- 67, Baldwin-Wallace -- 66** -- In the last meeting between B-W and Muskingum, on February 5, 2011 on Performance Court in New Concord, current Fighting Muskie 6'5" junior forward Seth Howard scored 20 points to lead the winners. B-W was led by current 6'5" All-OAC sophomore forward **Kyle Payne (Brunswick)** with 19 points and eight rebounds. In addition, current 6'6" junior forward **Chris Ameen (Broadview Heights/ Walsh Jesuit)** had 10 points and six rebounds in the loss. B-W had a chance to win, but Muskingum stole B-W's inbounds pass with 1.9 seconds remaining to seal the win.

**The Baldwin-Wallace College Starters and Information** -- B-W likes to run with the basketball and will play aggressive man-to-man defense. B-W scores 76.3 ppg. and allows 62.0 ppg. for a plus 14.3 ppg. differential. The Yellow Jackets grab 38.7 rpg. and allow 34.0 rpg. for a plus 4.7 rpg. differential. B-W shoots 45.3 percent from the floor on 192-of-424 attempts, including 33.5 percent from three-point range on 54-of-161 attempts, and 67.6 percent from the foul line on 96-of-142 attempts.

Look for Head Coach Duane Sheldon to give 10-to-12 players court time. He will start **Kyle Payne**, 6'2" junior **Ben Umbel (Poland/ Seminary)** and 6'7" sophomore **Tyler Ferrell (Brunswick)** at the forward positions. In the backcourt, look for 5'10" senior All-OAC point guard **Promis Cabbil (Elyria/ Senior)** and 6'4" sophomore **Kevin Krakowiak (Valley City/ Parma Heights Holy Name)** to start. **Krakowiak** leads the team in scoring at 13.7 ppg., grabs 2.4 rpg. and is second on the team with 15 three-pointers. **Payne** is second in scoring with 11.7 ppg. and leads the team in rebounding with 6.3 rpg. **Ferrell** is fifth and scores 7.5 ppg. and is second with 5.3 rpg. **Umbel** scores 6.0 ppg., grabs 4.6 rpg., is second with 19 assists and first with 22 steals. **Cabbil** scores 4.3 ppg., grabs 1.7 rpg. and is third with 18 assists.

Off the bench, Sheldon has played 6'0" freshman guard **Jaron Crowe (Mentor)**, 6'6" junior forward **Chris Ameen (Broadview Heights/ Walsh Jesuit)**, 6'8" sophomore center **Aaron Selmek (Delaware/ Columbus St. Francis DeSales)**, 6'1" sophomore guard **Grant Fairhurst (Ashland)**, 6'3" junior guard **Brandon Schmidt (Wellington)**, 6'3" junior forward **Scott Branchick (Mentor)** and 6'5" junior forward **Sean Rothermel (Delaware/ Hayes)**. **Ameen** is third in scoring and rebounding with 8.9 ppg. and 4.6 rpg. and tied for third with seven triples. **Fairhurst** is fourth in scoring with 8.0 ppg., has a team-leading 16 three-pointers and is second with nine steals. **Crowe** scores 5.8 ppg., grabs 2.0 rpg. and has a team-leading 20 assists and is tied for third with seven treys. **Selmek** scores 6.1 ppg., grabs 3.0 rpg. and is shooting 66.7% from the floor on 20-of-30 attempts.

**In B-W's Last Game: Wilmington -- 59, Baldwin-Wallace -- 56 in Wilmington on December 10 --** In B-W's last game, a 59-56 loss to Wilmington College on December 10 in the Fred Raizk Arena in Wilmington, the Yellow Jackets were led by Kevin Krakowiak with 13 points. He was the only B-W player to score in double figures. In addition, Kyle Payne grabbed a game-high eight rebounds. The keys to the loss included the Quakers forcing the Yellow Jackets into making 20 turnovers and outscoring B-W from the foul line by four points.

**Scouting the Fighting Muskies of Muskingum University --** Muskingum likes to play a base of seven players with three or four others seeing limited court time. The Fighting Muskies score 58.0 ppg. and allow 63.5 ppg. for a minus 5.5 ppg. differential. The Muskies grab 33.9 rpg. and allow 33.5 rpg. for a plus 0.4 rpg. differential. Muskingum shoots 39.1 percent from the floor (164-of-419 attempts), including 29.3% from three-point range (34-of-116), and 62.6% from the foul line (102-of-163).

Look for Head Coach Gene Ford to start 6'1" senior JJ Armstrong and 5'7" sophomore Isaiah Shakespeare in the backcourt. At the forward positions, look for 6'4" senior forward Josh Brindley, 6'5" senior forward Kyle Clinedinst and 6'3" freshman Jonathan Primes to start. Clinedinst tops the team in scoring with 15.8 ppg., grabs a team-leading 9.4 rpg., has a team-leading 20 assists and 16 steals to go with seven three-pointers. Brindley is second at 15.5 ppg., grabs 6.5 rpg. for second and shoots 50.5% from the floor on 47-of-93 attempts. Primes, who has played in three games and started for the first time in his career last Saturday against Heidelberg, scores 6.0 ppg. Armstrong scores 4.1 ppg., grabs 3.3 rpg. and is second with 19 assists. Shakespeare scores 1.4 ppg. and has started twice, including versus Heidelberg.

Off the bench, Ford has played 6'0" senior guard Carson Thomas, 6'2" freshman guard Logan Kimble, 6'2" sophomore guard Clay Owings, 6'3" sophomore guard Allen Harris, 5'11" junior guard Shaq Duncan and 5'9" senior guard George Williams. Thomas has started six times and leads the "bench bunch" in scoring at 7.0 ppg., grabs 1.6 rpg., leads the team with 16 three-pointers and has 15 assists. Kimble has started four times and scores 5.0 ppg., grabs 2.5 rpg. and has 10 assists.

**In Muskingum's Last Game: Heidelberg -- 63, Muskingum -- 52 in New Concord on December 10 --** In Muskingum's last game, a 63-52 loss to Heidelberg University on Saturday, December 10 on Performance Court in New Concord, the Fighting Muskies were led by Kyle Clinedinst with 17 points and Josh Brindley added 13. The keys to the loss included Heidelberg making 52.4% of its field goals on 22-of-42 attempts compared to just 41.3% for Muskingum on 19-of-46 attempts and outrebounding the Fighting Muskies, 35-25.

**Yellow Jackets Heading to Kentucky During Winter Break --** The Yellow Jackets travel to Lexington, Kentucky the week before Christmas to participate in the Transylvania University Don Lane Classic. B-W plays No. 25-ranked Wasbash (Ind.) College on Dec. 20 at 5:30 p.m. and then play either host Transylvania or Hendrix (Ark.) College on Dec. 21 in either the consolation game at 5:00 or in the championship contest at 7:00 p.m.

**B-W Picked to Finish Seventh in OAC --** B-W was picked by the Ohio Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Coaches to finish seventh in the league this season.

**Two Doubleheaders to be Televised by SportsTime Ohio --** Two B-W women's and men's basketball doubleheaders will be televised this winter on regional cable television giant SportsTime Ohio. The two DHs are the Saturday, January 28 doubleheader versus Wilmington College and the Saturday, February 18 Seniors' Day doubleheader versus Ohio Northern University.
