## Head Coach Duane Sheldon Wins 100th Career Victory

Fourth-year **Head Coach Duane Sheldon** won his 100th career game on Saturday, December 3 when the Yellow Jackets upset then No. 4-ranked Marietta College, 93-74, in Berea. He enters tonight's game with 103 career victories. Prior to returning to his alma mater, **Coach Sheldon** built a successful high school program at nearby Middleburg Heights Midpark, assisted legendary B-W Coach and Hall of Famer Steve Bankson and rebuilt the program and led OAC-rival Heidelberg University to an OAC Tournament title and an NCAA Division III National Tournament berth.

## Umbel Earned All-Tournament Honors at Transylvania

Junior guard **Ben Umbel** earned all-tournament team honors at the Transylvania (Ky.) University Don Lane Classic on December 20-21 when he scored 21 points, grabbed 14 rebounds, passed for eight assists, made five steals and blocked a shot. It is his first all-tourney team award. **Umbel** transferred to B-W as a sophomore from NCAA Division I Youngstown State University.

## Payne Was the OAC Player of the Week on December 19

Sophomore All-OAC forward **Kyle Payne** was named the OAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week on December 19 for his season-high 24-point and career-high 11 rebound effort in a 68-63 win at Muskingum University on December 17. It was the second time that the 2010-11 OAC Freshman of the Year earned that accolade.

## Yellow Jackets Host Alma College Scots To End 2011 Portion of Schedule

**BEREA, OHIO** -- The Baldwin-Wallace College men's basketball team hosts the Alma College of Michigan Scots tonight in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium inside the Lou Higgins Center in a nineleague game.

The Yellow Jackets enter the game with a record of 7-3 overall following their 79-63 victory against Hendrix (Ark.) College in the consolation game at Transylvania University Don Lane Classic in Lexington, Kentucky. B-W lost to 14th-ranked Wabash (Ind.) College, 63-61, in the first round. For his efforts at Transylvania, junior guard **Ben Umbel** earned all-tournament team honors. He scored 21 points, grabbed 14 rebounds, passed for eight assists, made five steals and blocked a shot in the two games.

The Scots enter the game with a 4-6 record following their 103-94 victory against Finlandia (Mich.) University in Alma on Dec. 21. Alma has won two straight and is averaging 103 points-per-game.

This is the fourth all-time meeting in men's basketball between B-W and the Scots. The Yellow Jackets lead the all-time series, 3-0, including a 73-63 victory in Alma, Michigan on January 3, 2009. Prior to that contest, the last meeting between the two schools occurred during the 1986-87 season when B-W beat Alma, 65-49, in Berea..

Look for Yellow Jacket **Head Coach Duane Sheldon** to start **Promis Cabbil, Tyler Ferrell, Kevin Krakowiak, Kyle Payne** and **Ben Umbel**. **Payne** leads the team in scoring with 13.4 points-per-game and in rebounding with 6.4 rpg. **Krakowiak** is second with 12.4 ppg., grabs 2.2 rpg. and is second 17 three-pointers. **Farrell** scores 6.8 ppg. is second with 5.2 rpg. and tops the squad with seven blocked shots. **Cabbil** scores 3.7 ppg., grabs 2.2 rpg. and is third with 24 assists. **Umbel** scores 6.5 ppg., grabs 4.8 rpg., and has a team-leading 28 assists and 27 steals.

Off the bench, look for **Jaron Crowe, Chris Ameen, Aaron Selmek, Grant Fairhurst, Scott Branchick** and **Sean Rothermel** to see action. **Fairhurst** is third in scoring at 9.1 ppg., grabs 1.7 rpg. and has a team-leading 24 three-pointers. **Ameen** is fourth with 8.2 ppg. and grabs 4.4 rpg. and has eight triples. **Crowe** scores 5.3 ppg., grabs 1.4 rpg. and is second with 27 assists. **Selmek** scores 5.1 ppg. and grabs 3.3 rpg.

Alma Head Coach Sam Hargraves to start Greg Silverthorn, Cory Schneider, Brandon Krause, Tommy Erickson and Tyler DeLap. Erickson, who has started eight times, tops the team in scoring at 12.6 ppg., is second with 5.1 rpg. and shoots 64.5% from the floor on 49-of-76 attempts. Silverthorn is second at 11.7 ppg., first with 5.6 rpg., is first with 12 steals and tied for first with 26 assists. He also has 13 three-pointers. Schneider is third at 9.9 ppg., grabs 3.3 rpg., is first with 24 treys on 47.1% shooting on 24-of-51 attempts. Krause scores 6.7 ppg., grabs 1.7 rpg. and is second with 25 assists. DeLap has started six contests and scores 6.0 ppg., grabs 2.1 rpg. and is second with 16 triples.

Off the bench, look for Sam Clancy, Chris Williamson, Lance Jongekrijg, Jake Murawske, Dustin DeShais, Brian Sheridan and Caleb Van Timmeren to all possibly see action. Clancy has started six times and is fourth in scoring at 7.9 ppg., grabs 3.3 rpg. and shoots 54.2% from the floor on 32-of-59 attempts. Williamson scores 6.9 ppg., grabs 1.4 rpg. and leads the team with 26 assists. Jongekrijg scores 6.3 ppg. in nine games and has 15 threes.

B-W is back in action on Wednesday, January 4 when it travels to University Heights to play Ohio Athletic Conference and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University in a key OAC game at 7:00 p.m. The next home game is on Wednesday, Jan. 11 against the University of Mount Union in the Ursprung Gym at 7:30 p.m.

### Women's Basketball

The Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team had a 6-4 overall record prior to playing in the RDV Classic on December 28-29 in Orlando, Florida. The Yellow Jackets played Olivet (Mich.) College on Dec. 28 and then played host and 17th-ranked Hope (Mich.) College yesterday.

To date, sophomore forward **Jessica Lairson (Louisville)** tops the team in scoring at 12.6 points-per-game and junior All-Ohio Athletic Conference forward **Jessica Carpenter (North Canton/ Hoover)** is second at 10.1 ppg. Senior forward **Catherine Spisak (Sandusky/ St. Mary's)** leads the team and OAC with 11.1 rebounds per game.

The women next play on Wednesday, January 4, 2012 when they host OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in the Lou Higgins Center at 7:30 p.m.

The women's basketball "Take a Kid to the Game" Day is set for Saturday, January 28 when B-W hosts Wilmington College in a doubleheader. The women play at 2:00 p.m. and the men at 4:00 p.m.

### Wrestling

The wrestling team, 1-0 in dual match competition, is idle until January 7 when it travels to Waynesburg, Pennsylvania to compete at the Waynesburg University Tournament.

B-W last competed on December 18 at the Cleveland State University Open. Freshman 149-pounder **Sam McIntosh (South Euclid/ Brush)** led the Yellow Jackets as he recorded two victories on the day before being knocked out of the tournament.

To date, **McIntosh**, sophomore 133-pounder **Andrew Taylor (Worthington Kilbourne)** and freshman **Tyler Baline (Worthington Kilbourne)** top the team with victories. **McIntosh** tops the squad with record of 7-5. **Taylor** is second with a 7-6 mark and **Blaine** is 6-4.

The next home match is January 13 versus OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll at 7:30 p.m. The 26th Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament is on Saturday, February 4. ### Swimming and Diving

The swimmers and divers and first-year **Head Coach Laura Wolff** are idle until their annual winter training trip to the Sunshine State of Florida when they train, compete and have fun in Sarasota. While in Florida, B-W will train and compete in one meet, on January 1 in Sarasota against Kenyon College, Washington (Mo.) University and the United States Coast Guard Academy.

To date, the women are 3-3 overall and 2-1 in the OAC and are led by junior four-time NCAA Division III All-American diver **Julie Pinter (Brecksville-Broadview Heights)**. The men are 2-4 overall and 2-1 in the OAC.

The next home meet is on Saturday, January 13 when the teams welcome Ohio Wesleyan University in the B-W Natatorium in the Lou Higgins Center at 4:00 p.m.

### Indoor Track

The 2011 indoor track season begins on Friday, January 20 when the team will host the B-W Mid-January Meet on the Harrison Dillard Track inside the Lou Higgins Center at 5:00 p.m. The team hosts three other meets during the winter, including the annual Greater Cleveland College Championship Meet on Friday, February 17 at 5:00 p.m.

### In Other Yellow Jacket News

Junior men's soccer midfielder **Pat Brennan (Akron/ Walsh Jesuit)** was named as a first-team **CAPITAL ONE** Academic All-American. He was the lone junior on the first team. B-W now has 78 Academic All-Americans in its history -- more than any other OAC school, second in the state of Ohio and among the Division III leaders. Junior men's **Kenny Janosko (Mentor)** is this year's OAC Men's Cross Country Runner of the Year. He is the second Yellow Jacket to earn that honor and the first since Tim Budic in 2000-2001. The men's soccer team made its first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division III Tournament and had a school-record 16 wins and a 16-6 record.
