Sophomore guard **Jessica Lairson** was named to the all-tournament team at the RDV Classic last week. She totalled 18 points, seven rebounds, two steals and an assist.

Rossman Passing Her Way Into Record Books

Junior point guard **Rachel Rossman** enters tonight's game with 203 career assists and needs 42 more to move into a tie for 11th all-time. Mandy Zolciak (1998-2001) is 11th with 245. **Rossman** tops the team this season with 51 assists in 12 contests.

Head Coach Cheri Harrer Approaching 450 Career Victories

Veteran Head Coach Cheri Harrer enters tonight's game with 440 career victories and is 10 wins shy of capturing her 450th career victory. Coach Harrer has a 440-158 career record with a .733 winning percentage. She is the winningest women's basketball coach in school history. In addition, Coach Harrer needs just 17 more wins for her 300th career OAC victory. Harrer enters the 2011-12 season among the winningest coaches in the NCAA Division III as she is 14th in winning percentage and 21st in wins.

Yellow Jackets Hosts Cleveland Cross-town Rival John Carroll In First Game of 2012

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team hosts cross-town rival John Carroll University in an Ohio Athletic Conference game in the Ursprung Gymnasium inside the Lou Higgins Center.

The Yellow Jackets enter the game with a record of 7-5 overall and 2-3 in the OAC following their 62-45 loss to No.17-ranked Hope (Mich.) College in the Championship Game of the RDV Classic in Orlando, Florida.

John Carroll enters the game with a record of 4-7 overall and 1-4 in the OAC following its 78-63 loss to Medaille (N.Y.) College on December 30 in University Heights. The Blue Streaks have lost six of their last seven contests.

This is the 63rd time that B-W and John Carroll will meet in women's basketball. The Yellow Jackets lead the all-time series, 41-21, but JCU has won the last two meetings and captured two of three encounters last season. The visiting team won all three matchups a year ago. The last B-W win was a 78-64 victory in University Heights on January 5, 2011. The first-ever meeting occurred during the 1971-72 season with the Yellow Jackets winning, 25-16.

Look for **Head Coach Cheri Harrer** to start **Catherine Spisak, Nancy Coulter, Natalia Simovic, Jessica Carpenter, Jessica Lairson** and **Rachel Rossman** to start. **Lairson** tops the team in scoring at 12.0 ppg., grabs 3.2 rpg. and has a team-leading 19 steals. **Carpenter** is second at 9.8 ppg., grabs 2.5 rpg. and has a team-leading 12 three-pointers. **Coulter** is fourth at 7.2 ppg., grabs 4.7 rpg. and has a team-leading 14 blocked shots. **Rossman** scores 4.3 ppg., grabs 1.8 rpg. and tops the team with 51 assists. **Spisak** scores 3.9 ppg. and grabs a team and OAC-leading 9.8 rpg. **Simovic**, who started both games at the RDV Classic, scores 3.6 ppg., grabs 3.2 rpg. and is second with 12 blocked shots.

In addition look for **Harrer** to utilize **Lexi Rohrbach, Megan Frisina, Audrey Smolik, Shari Mangas, Jenna Andreas** and **Sharlee Bailey**. **Smolik** is third in scoring at 8.0 ppg. and grabs 2.5 rpg. **Rohrbach** scores 4.3 ppg. and grabs 3.2 rpg. **Simovic** scores 3.6 ppg., grabs 3.2 rpg. and has 12 blocked shots.

Look for Head Coach Kristie Maravalli to start Emilee Ritchie, Allison Lustig, Emily Day, Missy Spahar and Hilary Liwosz. Spahar tops the team in scoring, rebounding, blocks and steals at 14.8 ppg., 9.9 rpg. and eight blocked shots and 20 steals. Ritchie is second at 12.6 ppg., grabs 3.4 rpg. and tops the team with 20 three-pointers and is second with 26 assists and 18 steals. Liwosz has played in seven games, including six starts, and scores 10.3 ppg. and grabs 3.6 rpg. Lustig scores 8.1 ppg., grabs 2.3 rpg., tops the team with 55 assists and is second with 15 treys and 18 steals. Day scores 3.9 ppg., grabs 3.2 rpg. and has nine triples.

Off the bench, look for Beth Switzer, Heidi Mervar and Meghan Weber, who started four games in Liwosz's absence, to see playing time. Switzer, who has started once, scores 6.0 ppg. and grabs 3.4 rpg. Mervar scores 2.8 ppg. and has five three-pointers. Weber, who has started four contests, scores 3.1 ppg. and grabs 3.1 rpg.

B-W is back in action this Saturday, January 7, when they play host to Capital University in an OAC game in the Ursprung Gymnasium at 3:00 p.m. The game will be carried **LIVE** via radio and the Internet by campus radio station WBWC. The pregame show starts 20 minutes prior to tipoff.

Men's Basketball

The Baldwin-Wallace College men's basketball team is 8-2 overall and 2-1 in the Ohio Athletic Conference and is currently playing John Carroll University in University Heights. The game started at 7:00 p.m.

The men enter the game on a two-game winning streak after posting victories over Hendrix (Ark.) College on December 21 and Alma (Mich.) College on December 30.

To date, sophomore forward **Kyle Payne (Brunswick)** tops the team in scoring and rebounding at 14.5 points-per-game and 6.5 rebound-per-game. Sophomore guard **Kevin Krakowiak (Valley City/Holy Name)** is second at 12.6 ppg.

The team will travel to Bexley this Saturday, January 7 to take on the Crusaders of Capital University in an OAC game at 3:00 p.m. The next home game is on Wednesday, January 11 when the team will play host to the Purple Raiders of the University of Mount Union in an OAC game in the Ursprung Gymnasium at 7:30 p.m.

Wrestling

The wrestling team, 1-0 in dual match competition, is back in action this Saturday, January 7, when it travels to Waynesburg, Pennsylvania to compete in the Waynesburg University Tournament.

B-W last competed on December 18 at the Cleveland State University Open. Freshman 149-pounder **Sam McIntosh (South Euclid/Brush)** led the Yellow Jackets as he recorded two victories on the day before being knocked out of the tournament.

To date, **McIntosh**, sophomore 133-pounder **Andrew Taylor (Columbus/Worthington Kilbourne)** and **McIntosh** top the team with records of 7-6 and 7-5 respectively. Freshman **Tyler Blaine (Worthington/Kilbourne)** is third with a mark of 6-4.

The next home match is on January 17 versus OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll at 7:30 p.m. The 26th Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament is on Saturday, February 4. Swimming and Diving

The swimmers and divers last competed on Sunday, January 1 when the teams competed in an unscored meet with Kenyon College, the U.S. Coast Guard Academy and Washington (Mo.) University.

To date, the women are 3-3 overall and 2-1 in the OAC and are led by junior four-time NCAA Division III All-American diver **Julie Pinter (Brecksville/Brecksville-Broadview Heights)**. The men are 2-4 overall and 2-1 in the OAC.

The next meet is on Friday, January 13 when the teams welcome Ohio Wesleyan University in the B-W Natatorium in the Lou Higgins Center at 4:00 p.m.

Indoor Track

The 2011 indoor track season begins on Friday, January 20 when the team will host the B-W Mid-January Meet on the Harrison Dillard Track inside the Lou Higgins Center at 5:00 p.m. The team hosts three other meets during the winter, including the annual Greater Cleveland College Championship Meet on Friday, February 17 at 5:00 p.m.
