**BEREA, OHIO --** In addition to tonight's s wrestling match against Case Western Reserve, eight other Yellow Jacket teams are in action this weekend.

The men's and women's swimming and diving teams are in action tonight as it traveled to Defiance to take on Defiance College in an OAC Dual Meet, which started at 6:00 p.m. Defiance, who is not a member of the 10-team OAC, is competing in its first season of OAC swimming and diving. The teams are back in action tomorrow afternoon when it will host Washington & Jefferson (Pa.) College in a non-conference meet in the B-W Natatorium inside the Lou Higgins Center at 4:00 p.m.

The men's and women's cross country teams are in action tomorrow morning, Saturday, November 12 as it will travel to nearby Oberlin to take part in the NCAA Division III Great Lakes Regional Championships hosted by Oberlin College. The men's team has been led by junior **Ken Janosko (Mentor)** and the women have been paced by junior **Sarah Rospert (Milan/ Edison)**.

The men's soccer team, 16-5 overall, is in action on Saturday, November 12 as it will travel to Oneonta, New York to take on SUNY-Oneonta in the first round of the NCAA Division III National Soccer Tournament at 1:30 p.m. This is the first appearance in school history for the team to appear in the tournament. With a victory, the team will play on Sunday at 1:00 p.m. against the winner of Hobart (N.Y.) and Penn State-Behrend.

The football team, 7-2 overall and 6-2 in the OAC, host the Blue Streaks of John Carroll 1:30pm at George Finnie Stadium on Senior's Day. The men's basketball team will open its 2011-12 season on Tuesday, November 15 when it will host Cleveland cross-town rival Case Western Reserve in the first game of a men's and women's basketball doubleheader at 6:00 p.m.

The women's basketball team will open its 2011-12 season on Tuesday, November 15 when it will host Wittenberg University in the second game of a men's and women's basketball doubleheader at 8:00 p.m.

The men's and women's indoor track and field teams begin its season on January 20, 2012 when it will host the B-W Mid January meet at 5:00 p.m.

## Yellow Jackets Open Jamie Gibbs Era With Non-Conference Dual Match Versus Case Western Reserve

**BEREA, OHIO --** The Baldwin-Wallace College Yellow Jacket wrestling team begins its 2011-12 campaign when they host cross town rival Case Western Reserve University tonight in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in the Lou Higgins Recreation Center. Head Coach Jamie Gibbs will be making his Yellow Jacket coaching debut.

Returning to lead this year's team are five lettermen, **Jeremy Dombrady, Andrew Taylor, Grant Steward, Joe Georgian** and **Ryan Tudor**.

A year ago, **Dombrady** had a 21-17 record with five pins and tied for the team lead with 24 near falls. **Taylor** split time between the 133, 141 and 149-pound weight classes and had a 20-17 mark as a freshman with six pins and was among the leaders in takedowns. **Steward** had his best season yet and was 18-21 overall with three pins. **Georgian** split time between 184 and 197 pounds and fashioned a 19-13 mark with three pins. **Tudor** was the backup at 285 pounds and was 6-10 overall.

Coach Gibbs will look to the youth of the team, with seven freshmen and two sophomores all making their debuts on the mat this season.

The Yellow Jackets wrestling team will look to move their way up the standings this season as they were voted to finish in 5th place in both the Dual meet and the championship polls. Leading the poll is defending conference and tournament champions Mount Union. They are followed by Ohio Northern, Heidelberg in 3rd, John Carroll in 4th then finally Baldwin-Wallace in fifth and Muskingum in sixth.

The starting line up for the Yellow Jackets looks like Dombrady at 133, Taylor at 141, Sam McIntosh at 149, Eric Gase or Alexander Cahill at 157 or 165, Sam Recinos at 174, Tyler Blaine at 184, Tudor at 197.

The Case Western Reserve University Spartans come into tonight's match after placing eighth last weekend at the Messiah Invitational. The team was led by sophomore Ryan Pyciak with a runner-up showing at 197 lbs.

Leading a roster that consists of seven upperclassmen (four seniors/three juniors) are senior captains Cale Harter and Kyle Weaver. Harter competed in a team-high tying 40 matches and posted a record of 21-19 with eight pins in the heavyweight division as a junior. He was also named a National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA) Scholar All-American and the University Athletic Association Wrestler of the Week on February 14. Enjoy the match!

## Please Meet First-Year Head Coach Jamie Gibbs

Jamie Gibbs is entering his first season as the Head Wrestling Coach at Baldwin-Wallace College in 2011-2012.

Coach Gibbs is the first full-time wrestling coach in the history of the College and he replaces Rich Fleming, who served the College with distinction the past 24 seasons as its part time head coach.

Coach Gibbs comes to the College after serving as the head wrestling coach at NCAA Division II the University of North Carolina at Pembroke for the past five seasons.

While at UNC-Pembroke, Gibbs mentored seven NCAA Division III All-Americans and eight student-athletes to the NWCA (National Wrestling Coaches Association) Division II All-Academic team. Overall, 16 of his student-athletes made appearances at the NCAA Division II National Championship Tournament. Individually, Gibbs' teams compiled a 51-40 dual meet record in five seasons and posted its best finish by being ranked 11th during the regular season and tied for 17th at the 2011 NCAA Division II National Championship tourney.

Last winter, Gibbs' squad had a 13-5 overall record and placed third at the 2011 NCAA Division II National Duals. The Most Valuable Wrestler at the Duals was his 165-pounder. During the last two seasons, Gibbs completed the rebuilding process of the UNC-Pembroke program. His team had a combined 27-13 record and was ranked as high as sixth nationally in both 2009-10 and 2010-11.

Prior to UNC-Pembroke, Gibbs served as an assistant coach at Coe College in Iowa for four years and as a graduate assistant coach at the University of Wisconsin at Lacrosse.

In two seasons as a collegiate competitor at Coe, Gibbs was an All-Iowa Conference wrestler and a two-year starter and captain. Prior to Coe, he attended Iowa Central Community College and was a national qualifier. Gibbs received an associate degree from Iowa Central C.C., a Bachelor of Arts degree from Coe and a Master of Science degree in exercise sports science from the University of Wisconsin at La Crosse.

Jamie and his wife, Jana, have a son, Bodey.
