Fall Sports Report

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College fall sports season is going very well. The 10 Yellow Jacket fall teams have a 145-84 record with a solid .633 winning percentage entering today's action.

The 10th-ranked Yellow Jacket men's soccer team, 11-1 overall and 2-0 in the Ohio Athletic Conference plays host to the Cardinals of Otterbein University immediately following this match. The team defeated Capital University, 3-0 last Monday, October 3 for a school-record 11 straight win. To date, senior three-time All-OAC forward **Carlin Vandriessche (Medina)** tops the team in scoring with 24 points. Junior goalie **Ryan Hulings (Centerville)** earned his three shutout in the past five matches. The men's next two matches are OAC road contests when they travel to Heidelberg University to take on the Student Princes Tuesday, October 11 at 7:00 p.m. and play the Polar Bears of Ohio Northern University on Saturday, October 15 at 1:00 p.m.

The volleyball team is 13-9 overall and played this afternoon at Otterbein University. Junior outside hitter **Amanda Sawicki (Mentor/ Lake Catholic)** and junior middle hitter **Rachel Switalski (North Royalton/ Holy Name)** are the offensive leaders. Junior setter **Jessica Stitts (Eastlake/ North)** sets up the offense and junior libero **Natalie Emmons (Ashland)** is one of the OAC's top defenders.

The football team, 3-1 overall and 2-1 in the OAC, is playing at Otterbein tonight at 7:00 p.m. Fans can listen to that game LIVE on campus radio station WBWC, 88.3 FM, and via the internet at www.wbwc.com. Highlighting last Saturday's 17-7 win at Marietta was senior **Derron Hamilton (Euclid)**, who is this week's OAC and Beyond Sports Network *Defensive Player of the Week*. **Hamilton** had a career-high 11 tackles and 3.5 quarterback sacks.

The defending OAC-champion women's golf team is 16-14 overall despite playing a national caliber schedule and ends its fall season this weekend at the Wittenberg "Clash at the Clouse" Tournament. Sophomore **Miranda Cunningham (Dayton/ Christian)** tops the team in stroke average at 86.0 per 18-hole round.

The men's and women's cross country teams are idle this weekend after running at the All-Ohio Championships last Friday (Sept. 30). The Yellow Jackets have been led all season by junior **Ken Janosko (Mentor)** and **Sarah Rospert (Milan)**.

The men's tennis team competed in its final fall event at the Oberlin Invitational Tournament last weekend, and the defending OAC-champion women's tennis plays its final fall matches on Saturday when it plays both Carnegie-Mellon (Pa.) and Grove City (Pa.) at Oberlin.

The men's golf team completed its fall season at the Wittenberg Invitational last weekend. Senior **Ricky Jaskolski (North Royalton/Padua Franciscan)** topped the squad in stroke average at 75.71.

Yellow Jacket Women's Soccer Team Hosts Otterbein University In OAC Showdown

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's soccer team, 8-4 overall and 1-1 in the OAC, plays host to Otterbein University, 5-4-1 overall and 2-0 in the OAC, on Tressel Field at The George Finnie Stadium.

The Yellow Jackets come into the match with a two-match winning streak following a 1-0 victory over Penn on Wednesday night.

The Yellow Jackets are led by forward **Heather Keller** with a team-high tying four goals and team-best four assists for 13 points. Senior **Lindsey Cooper** has contributed a team-best tying four goals and one assist for nine points and sophomore **Rachel Gokey** has tallied three goals and three assists for nine points.

In net, B-W has used a trio of goalkeepers. Freshman **Gabrielle Bodo** has started in eight games and has a record of 4-4. **Bodo** has recorded 32 saves while allowing 13 goals for a 1.69 goals-against-average. Freshman **Claire LoPresti** has started three games and has a record of 3-0, including her first career shutout on Wednesday night and sophomore **Kristina Mathur** one start in three appearances with a record of 1-0. **LoPresti** has tallied 10 saves and a 0.36 GAA while Mathur has recorded three saves with 0.53 GAA.

Otterbein comes into match after recording three straight shutouts against Earlham (Ind.), John Carroll and Heidelberg.

The Cardinals are led by Morgan Hendrickson with a team-high three goals and one assist for seven points and Jessica Yaney (2 goals and 1 assist) and Rachel Denz (1 goal and three assists) for five points.

Netminder Melissa Zang anchors the defense. She has tallied 13 saves and allowed one goal in six games for a 0.20 GAA with three shutouts.

The Yellow Jackets are back in action on Wednesday, October 12 when they host Heidelberg University in an OAC match at 7:00 p.m.
