**The Pre-Game Setup** -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team will look to get back on the winning track when it travels to Orlando, Florida to play nonleague foe Olivet College of Michigan in the first game of the RDV Classic. The Yellow Jackets also play 17th-ranked Hope in the second game of the classic-style tournament.

The Yellow Jackets enter this game with a 6-4 overall record following its 64-59 loss at No. 24-ranked Otterbein University on December 20 in Westerville, Ohio. B-W has won four of its last seven contests.

Olivet enters this game with a 2-8 overall record following its 66-54 victory against Rochester (Mich.) College on December 20. The victory ended an eight-game losing streak for the Comets.

**A B-W and Olivet Connection** -- The Yellow Jackets have a connection to Olivet College. Current Olivet sports information director Geoff Henson is a B-W graduate and former sports information assistant at the College.

**The B-W versus Olivet All-Time Series** -- This is the first-ever meeting between B-W and Olivet in women's basketball.

**Scouting the Yellow Jackets of Baldwin-Wallace College** -- Look for Head Coach Cheri Harrer to play as many as 12 student-athletes in her rotation. B-W is scoring 58.1 points-per-game and allowing 58.2 ppg. for a minus 0.1 ppg. differential. B-W grabs 37.4 rebounds-per-game and allows 32.4 for a plus 5.0 rpg. differential. The Yellow Jackets shoot 38.8 percent from the field on 206-of-531 attempts, including 28.8% from three-point range on 34-of-118 attempts, and 73.8% from the foul line on 135-of-183 attempts.

Look for **Head Coach Cheri Harrer** to start 5'10" senior **Catherine Spisak (Sandusky/ St. Mary's Central Catholic)**, 6'0" junior **Nancy Coulter (Washington Court House/ Miami Trace)** and 5'7" All-OAC standout **Jessica Carpenter (North Caton/ Hoover)** at the forward positions. In the backcourt, look for 5'9" sophomore **Jessica Larison (Louisville/ Senior)** and 5'6" junior **Rachel Rossman (Olmsted Falls)** to start. **Larison** tops the team in scoring at 12.6 ppg., grabs 3.1 rpg., has a team-leading seven steals and is second with 12 assists, 10 blocked shots and eight three-pointers. **Carpenter** is second at 10.1 ppg., grabs 2.5 rpg. and has a team-leading 11 three-pointers. **Coulter** is fourth at 6.5 ppg., grabs 4.2 rpg. and has a team-leading 14 blocked shots. **Rossman** scores 4.5 ppg., grabs 1.8 rpg. and tops the team with 41 assists. **Spisak** scores 4.5 ppg. and grabs a team and OAC-leading 11.1 rpg.

In addition look for **Harrer** to utilize 5'11" sophomore forward **Lexi Rohrbach (Tiffin/ Columbian)**, 5'7" junior guard **Megan Frisina (Corry, Pa./ Corry Area)**, 6'1" sophomore forward **Natalia Simovic (Seven Hills/ Normandy)**, 5'9" freshman guard **Audrey Smolik (Strongsville)**, 5'6" freshman guard **Shari Mangas (Leipsic)**, 5'8" sophomore guard **Autumn Williams (Cleveland/ Laurel Academy)** and 5'10" freshman forward **Sharlee Bailey (Wadsworth)**. **Smolik** scores 7.5 ppg. and grabs 2.3 rpg. **Rohrbach** scores 4.5 ppg. and grabs 2.5 rpg. **Simovic** scores 3.8 ppg., and grabs 3.2 rpg.

**In B-W's Last Game: Otterbein -- 64, Baldwin-Wallace -- 59 in Westerville on December 20** -- In B-W's last game, a 64-59 loss to Otterbein University on December 20 in the Rike Center in Westerville, the Yellow Jackets were led by **Jessica Lairson** with 15 points. In addition, **Audrey Smolik** came off the bench to score 12 points, **Jessica Carpenter** had 11 and **Catherine Spisak** had 10 points and a game-high 12 rebounds. The keys to the loss included being outscored from three-point range by nine points, from the foul line by four and committing four more turnovers than the Cardinals (16-12).

**Scouting the Comets of Olivet College** -- Olivet scores 50.6 ppg. and allows 62.0 ppg. for a minus 11.4 ppg. differential. The Comets grab 42.4 rpg. and allow 39.3 rpg. for a plus 3.1 rpg. differential. Olivet shoots 31 percent from the floor (190-of-613 attempts), including 20.9 percent from three-point range (37-of-177), and 64 percent from the foul line (89-of-139).

Look for Head Coach Nicole Burford to start 6'2" junior Sydney Raddle and 5'10" junior SoQuitta DeShazor at the forward positions and 5'7" sophomore Kelsey Campbell, 5'7" junior Mellissa Bageris and 5'8" sophomore Heather Lauwers at the guard spots. Raddle tops the team in scoring at 10.7 ppg. and rebounding with 7.7 rpg. and in blocked shots with 11. DeShazor is second in scoring at 8.2 ppg. and rebounding at 5.6 rpg. Campbell is third at 7.8 ppg., grabs 3.6 rpg. and is first with 13 three-pointers and 50 assists and third with 18 steals. Bageris scores 4.5 ppg. and grabs 3.1 rpg. Lauwers scores 2.1 ppg. and grabs 5.2 rpg.

Off the bench, look for Burford to play 5'10" junior forward Kaleigh Hill, 5'7" sophomore guard Rachael Wagner, 5'8" junior guard Brittany Brown, 5'9" sophomore guard Elizabeth Bailey and 5'8" sophomore guard Lindsey Winters. Hill tops the "bench bunch" at 6.2 ppg. and grabs 3.5 rpg.

**In Olivet's Last Game: Olivet -66, Rochester (Mich.) -- 54 --** In Olivet's last game, a 66-54 victory against Rochester (Mich.) College on December 20, SoQuitta DeShazor led the Comets in scoring with a career-high 20 points. In addition, Sydney Raddle had 17 points and a career-high 21 rebounds and Kelsey Campbell nearly had a triple-double with 13 points, nine rebounds and nine assists. The keys to the Olivet win included outscoring Rochester by nine points from the foul line, outrebounding it by eight and committing five less turnovers.

## Yellow Jacket Chatter

**Harrer's 439 Career Wins are Second All-Time in OAC History--** Cheri Harrer has 439 career victories and a 439-157 career record and is second all-time in Ohio Athletic Conference history.

**B-W in NCAA Tourney 11 of the Last 16 Years --** The Yellow Jackets have advanced to 11 of the last 16 NCAA Division III national tournaments.

**Two Doubleheaders to be Televised by SportsTime Ohio --** Two B-W women's and men's basketball doubleheaders will be televised this winter on regional cable television giant SportsTime Ohio. The two DHs are a Saturday, January 28 doubleheader versus Wilmington College and a Saturday, February 18 Seniors' Day doubleheader versus Ohio Northern University.

The Saturday, Jan. 28 DH also is the annual women's basketball "Take a Kid to the Game" Day. All children from eighth grade and lower will be admitted for free when accompanied by a parent or adult. Prior to the game, children can have their faces painted and play games with the Yellow Jacket cheerleaders and "Stinger", the B-W mascot. Following the game, the B-W student-athletes and coaching staff will be available for autographs.

**B-W Picked to Finish Second by the OAC Coaches in its Preseason Poll --** B-W is picked to finish second this season by the Ohio Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Coaches in its preseason poll.

**Yellow Jacket OAC Tournament Titles --** B-W has captured five OAC Tournament titles with Cheri Harrer as coach. The titles were in 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2000-2001, 2004-2005 and 2007-2008.
