GAME SETUP -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team travels to North Manchester, Indiana on Friday and Saturday, November 18-19, 2011 to participate in the Manchester College MC Bankers Classic in the Stauffer-Wolfe Arena. The Yellow Jackets face Denison University in its first game on Nov. 18 at 6:00 p.m. The consolation and championship games are the next day at 1:00 and 3:00 p.m., respectively. This is the second game of the regular season.

The Pre-Game Setup -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team competes in the Manchester College of Indiana MC Bankers Classic and plays Denison University in its first game at 6:00 p.m. In the nightcap, host Manchester plays nationally-ranked St. Mary's (Ind.) College at 8:00 p.m. This is the first time that B-W has played Denison since it lost to the Big Red in the first round of the 2004-2005 NCAA Division III National Tournament.

The Yellow Jackets enter this game with a 1-0 record following a 56-53 victory against traditional rival Wittenberg University in their season-opener on Tuesday, November 15 in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in the Lou Higgins Center in Berea. B-W returns 10 letterwinners and four starters. B-W finished last season with an 18-8 overall record. The Ohio Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Coaches picked B-W to finish second in the conference.

The Big Red enter this game at 1-0 overall following a 69-61 victory at Bethany (W.Va.) College on Tuesday, Nov. 15. The Big Red finished the 2010-11 season with an impressive 28-1 record, won both the regular season and tournament titles in the North Coast Athletic Conference, but lost by 16 points in its first round NCAA Division III National Tournament game. The Big Red was picked second in the NCAC preseason poll.

The B-W versus Denison College All-Time Series -- This is the sixth meeting in women's basketball between B-W and Denison. B-W leads the all-time series, 3-2. The last time the two schools met was in the first round of the NCAA Division III tournament in the 2004-05 season. B-W lost to Denison, 51-46, in Berea. B-W won the first-ever meeting between the two teams during the 1965-66 season by a score of 50-34. The last B-W victory came during the 1986-1987 season when the Yellow Jackets beat the Big Red, 78-47.

In the Last B-W versus Denison Game on March 2, 2005 in Berea: B-W -- 46, DC -- 51 -- In a 2004-2005 postseason matchup, Denison won, 51-46. B-W was led by forwards Cara Shiplett and Jessica Latimer with 11 and 10 points, respectively. Denison was led by Emma Woodward with a game-high 17 points and forward Jessica Sheffield had 11 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. The key to the loss was Denison holding B-W to just 33.3% shooting from the field (18-of-54) and outrebounding the Yellow Jackets, 38-23.

B-W Information and Probable Starters -- Baldwin-Wallace returns 10 letterwinners and four starters from its 2010-11 team that finished 18-8 overall. **Head Coach Cheri Harrer** loves to play at least 10-to-12 student-athletes in her rotation.

Look for **Harrer** to start 5'10 senior **Catherine Spisak**, 6'0" junior **Nancy Coulter (Washington Court House/ Miami Trace)** and 5'7" junior All-OAC player **Jessica Carpenter (North Canton/ Hoover)** at the forward positions, and 5'9" sophomore **Jessica Larison (Louisville/ Senior)** and 5'6" junior **Rachel Rossman (Olmsted Falls)** in the backcourt. In the season-opening 56-53 win versus Wittenberg in Berea, **Larison** led the team in scoring with 19 points, including two three-pointers. In addition, **Rossman** had nine points, six assists and four steals, **Coulter** had seven points and four rebounds, **Spisak** had six points and a team-high eight rebounds and **Carpenter** had a pair of points and four caroms.

Off the bench, look for **Harrer** to utilize 5'9" freshman guard **Audrey Smolik (Strongsville)**, 5'11" sophomore forward **Lexi Rohrbach (Tiffin/ Columbian)**, 6'1" sophomore center **Natalia Simovic (Parma/ Normandy)**, 5'7" junior guard **Megan Frisina (Corry, Pa./ Corry Area)**, 5'6" freshman guard **Shari Mangas (Leipsic)** and 5'10" freshman forward **Sharlee Bailey (Wadsworth)** among others. **Smolik** and **Rohrbach** each had four points in the win versus Wittenberg.

Scouting the Big Red of Denison College -- Denison returns a veteran cast, including four starters in 2011-12.

Look for Head Coach Sara Lee to start 5'7" junior Serafina Nuzzo at the point guard, 5'7" junior Nicole Coggins and 5'5" junior Kyli Parker at the guards and 6'0" sophomore Gretchen Staubach and 6'0" sophomore Jane Windler on the inside. In its 69-61 season-opening win versus Bethany W.Va.), the Big Red was led by Nuzzo with 17 points, three rebounds and three steals. In addition, Parker had eight points and four rebounds and steals, Windler had six points and three rebounds, Staubach had five points and five rebounds and Coggins had four points.

Off the bench, look for Lee to play 5'10" senior forward Christina Myers, 5'7" freshman point guard Alyx Ingram, 5'8" senior forward Jessica Grzybowski and 5'8" sophomore guard Mikeala Freundlich. Myers led the way as she scored 12 points, Ingram had eight and Grzybowski had six.

Yellow Jackets Heading to Florida in December -- The Yellow Jackets travel to Florida in the last week of December, 2011 to participate in the RDV Tournament in Orlando, Fla. B-W plays Olivet (Mich.) on Dec. 28 at 6:00 p.m and then play Hope (Mich.) on Dec. 29 at 8:00 p.m.

Harrer's 434 Career Wins -- Cheri Harrer has 434 career victories and is second all-time in Ohio Athletic Conference history.

11 of Last 16 -- The Yellow Jackets have advanced to 11 of the last 16 NCAA Division III national tournaments.

Two Doubleheaders to be Televised by SportsTime Ohio -- Two B-W women's and men's basketball doubleheaders will be televised this winter on regional cable television giant SportsTime Ohio. The two DHs are the Saturday, January 28 doubleheader versus Wilmington College and the Saturday, February 18 Seniors' Day doubleheader versus Ohio Northern University.

B-W Picked to finish second in OAC -- B-W is picked by the Ohio Athletic Conference Women's Basketball to finish second this season.

OAC Tourney Titles -- B-W has captured five OAC Tournament titles with Cheri Harrer as coach. The titles were in 1999, 2000, 2001, 2005 and 2008.
