The Pre-Game Setup -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team will look to get back on the winning track when it hosts Cleveland cross-town rival Case Western Reserve University in its second home game of the season.

The Yellow Jackets enter this game with a 2-1 record following a 59-45 loss to host Manchester College last Saturday, November 19 in the Championship Game of the MC Bankers Classic in North Manchester, Indiana. B-W opened the tournament with a 54-53 win against Denison University on Nov. 18 and opened its season last Tuesday in Berea with a 56-53 win against traditional rival Wittenberg University.

CWRU enters this game with a 2-1 overall record after posting a 1-1 record at last weekend's Doubletree Classic hosted by Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and beating Elmira (N.Y.) College, 66-46, in the consolation game on Nov. 19. In the first round on Nov. 18, the Spartans lost to the University of Mount Union, 55-49. The Spartans opened their season with a strong, 59-33 win at Washington & Jefferson College on Nov. 15 in Washington, Pa.

The B-W versus Case Western Reserve University All-Time Series -- This is the 33rd time that Baldwin-Wallace and CWRU have met in women's basketball. The Yellow Jackets lead the all-time series, 21-11, including the win a year ago at University Circle, 69-62. *See more on last year's game below.* The last CWRU win came on November 24, 2009 when the Spartans beat the Yellow Jackets, 80-78 in overtime, in Berea. The first-ever meeting between the two schools occurred in 1966-67 with B-W winning by a 17-6 score.

In the Last B-W versus CWRU Game on November 23, 2010 at University Circle, Ohio: Baldwin-Wallace -- 69, CWRU -- 62 -- In the last meeting between B-W and CWRU, on November 23, 2010, the Yellow Jackets defeated the Spartans, 69-62, in the first game of a women's and women's doubleheader in University Circle. Leading the way for the Yellow Jackets was current 5'7" All-Ohio Athletic Conference guard **Jessica Carpenter (North Canton/ Hoover)** with 13 points and three assists. In addition, graduated 2010-11 OAC *Player of the Year* Amanda Schroeder had 12 points and eight rebounds. CWRU was led by current 5'8" sophomore guard Evy Iacono with 20 points and six rebounds and current 5'5" junior guard Erica Iafelice had 13 points.

B-W Information and Probable Starters -- The Yellow Jackets return 10 letterwinners and four starters. B-W is scoring 51.7 points-per-game and allowed 55.0 ppg. for a minus 3.3 ppg. differential. B-W grabs 38.3 rebounds-per-game and allows 31.0 for a plus 7.3 rpg. differential. The Yellow Jackets shoot .355 percent from the field (55-of-155 attempts), including 27.3% from three-point range (9-of-33), and 69.2% from the foul line (36-of-52).

Look for **Head Coach Cheri Harrer** to start 5'10" senior **Catherine Spisak**, 6'0" junior **Nancy Coulter (Washington Court House/ Miami Trace)** and **Jessica Carpenter** on the inside and 5'9" sophomore **Jessica Larison (Louisville/ Senior)** and 5'6" junior **Rachel Rossman (Olmsted Falls)** in the backcourt. **Larison** tops the team with 16.0 ppg, grabs 4.0 rpg., has three assists and four steals. **Carpenter** is second with 6.0 ppg, grabs 2.7 rpg. and has three steals. **Coulter** scores 5.7 ppg., grabs 3.0 rpg. and has three blocks. **Rossman** scores 5.0 ppg. and leads the team in assists and steals with 11 and seven, respectively. **Spisak** scores 4.3 ppg. and leads the team in rebounding with 9.0 rpg.

In addition look for **Harrer** to utilize 5'11" sophomore forward **Lexi Rohrbach (Tiffin/ Columbian)**, 5'7" junior guard **Megan Frisina (Corry, Pa./ Corry Area)** and 6'1" sophomore forward **Natalia Simovic (Seven Hills/ Normandy)**. The Yellow Jackets roster includes eight freshmen that **Harrer** will look to contribute in the 2011-2012 season. **Rohrbach** scores 4.7 ppg. and grabs 2.0 rpg and **Simovic** scores 4.0 ppg and grabs 4.7 rpg. to lead the "bench bunch".

In B-W's Last Game: Manchester (Ind.) -- 59, Baldwin-Wallace -- 45 -- In its last game, a 59-45 loss in the Championship Game of the MC Bankers Classic at Manchester College, the Yellow Jackets were led by **Jessica Larison** with 11 points. B-W trailed by just two points, 28-26, at halftime, but were outscored by 18 points in the first 13 minutes of the second half and never recovered.

Scouting the Spartans of Case Western Reserve University - The Spartans score 58.0 ppg. and allow 44.7 ppg. for a plus 13.3 ppg. differential. CWRU grabs 42.0 rpg. and allows 31.7 rpg. for a plus 10.3 rpg. differential. Case shoots 40.6 percent from the field (69-of-170 attempts), including 22.2% from three-point range (12-of-54), and 72.7% from the foul line (24-of-33).

Look for Head Coach Jennifer Reimer to start Evy Iacono and Erica Iafelice in the backcourt and 5'10" senior Cheslea Peck , 6'0" senior **CAPITAL ONE** Academic All-American Erin Hollinger and 5'11" Marissa Miles on the inside. The quintet have started all three games so far this season. Iacono tops the team in scoring at 11.3 ppg., grabs 3.7 rpg., has made 33.3% of her field goals on 11-of-33 shots, including 5-of-17 from three-point range. She also leads the team with 10 assists. Hollinger is second at 11.0 ppg., grabs 3.3 rpg. and leads the team with eight steals. Peck is third at 5.3 ppg., grabs 2.7 rpg. and is 4-of-4 from the charity stripe. Iafelice scores 4.0 ppg. and has five steals and six assists. Miles scores 2.0 ppg. and grabs 2.3 rpg.

In addition, look for Reimer to play 6'1" sophomore forward Sarah Milligan, 6'2" sophomore center Emily Mueller, 5'11" freshman guard Julie Mooney and 5'10" freshman forward Lauren Elkin. Mueller leads the "bench bunch" with 5.0 ppg. and leads the team in rebounding with 6.0 rpg.

In CWRU's Last Game: CWRU -- 66, Elmira (N.Y.) -- 46 -- In CWRU's last game, a 66-46 victory against Elmira (N.Y.) College in the Consolation Game of the Carnegie-Mellon University DoubleTree Classic in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Spartan Coach Jen Reimer received the luxury of playing 16 student-athletes in the win. Erin Hollinger and Evy Iacono led CWRU with 11 points each and Chelsea Peck had 10 points. Keys to the CWRU win were outrebounding Elmira, 45-29, and forcing 21 turnovers.

Yellow Jackets Heading to Florida in December -- The Yellow Jackets travel to Florida in the last week of December, 2011 to participate in the RDV Tournament in Orlando, Fla. B-W plays Olivet (Mich.) on Dec. 28 at 6:00 p.m and then play Hope (Mich.) on Dec. 29 at 8:00 p.m.

Harrer's 435 Career Wins -- Cheri Harrer has 435 career victories and is second all-time in Ohio Athletic Conference history.

The NCAA Division III National Tournament: 11 of Last 16 Years -- The Yellow Jackets have advanced to 11 of the last 16 NCAA Division III national tournaments.

Two Doubleheaders to be Televised by SportsTime Ohio -- Two B-W women's and men's basketball doubleheaders will be televised this winter on regional cable television giant SportsTime Ohio. The two DHs are the Saturday, January 28 doubleheader versus Wilmington College and the Saturday, February 18 Seniors' Day doubleheader versus Ohio Northern University.

B-W Picked to finish second in OAC -- B-W was picked by the Ohio Athletic Conference Women's Basketball to finish second this season.

OAC Tourney Titles -- B-W has captured five OAC Tournament titles with Cheri Harrer as coach. The titles were in 1999, 2000, 2001, 2005 and 2008.
