SPORTS PLAYED AT B-W (YEARS AND LETTERS WON): Dave played four years of football and earned three varsity letters. He also played baseball in the spring of 2000, but did not letter.

ATHLETIC HONORS AT B-W: As a junior in 2001, Dave was selected as B-W's Most Outstanding Receiver. As a senior in 2002, he was named as the OAC Co-Offensive Player of the Week for a four-touchdown performance in a 48-41 win against Ohio Northern. He was also named first-team All-OAC and as the B-W Most Outstanding Receiver.

ACADEMIC HONORS AT B-W: Dave is a solid student who carries a 3.08 grade point average. He earned second-team Academic All-OAC honors in 2002.

GENERAL FOOTBALL INFORMATION: Dave LaBahn was B-W's top receiver in 2001 and 2002. As a freshman in 1999-2000, Dave was a member of the junior varsity squad in both football and baseball. As a sophomore in football in 2000, he earned his first letter as a punter and wide receiver. Dave caught 13 passes for 209 yards and had a team-leading four touchdowns. As a junior in 2001, Dave was B-W's Most Outstanding Receiver award winner as he caught 30 passes for a team-leading 518 yards and team-leading six TDs. His 30 catches ranked second on the team and his 36 points ranked third. As a senior in 2002, Dave caught a team-leading 38 passes for a team-leading 619 yards and a team-leading eight TD. He was named as a first-team All-OAC and second-team Academic All-OAC player and was selected to play in the Division III Aztec Bowl in Torrwon, Mexico (Dec. 14, 2002). He was the OAC Co-Offensive Player of the Week for a four-touchdown performance in a 48-41 win against Ohio Northern. The four TD tied both a Finnie Stadium and B-W single-game record TD catches. His 18 TD catches rank third all-time in school history. He was named as the B-W Most Outstanding Receiver for the second straight year.

GENERAL BASEBALL INFORMATION: Dave played his only season of baseball as a freshman outfielder in the spring of 2000. He did not letter. He decided to give up baseball to concentrate on football.
