## Nick Flanigan

**MAJOR:** Business Administration

**ACADEMIC ADVISOR:** Prof. Jim Buddie



**SPORTS PLAYED (YEARS AND LETTERS WON):** As a senior in 2010-2011, Nick Flanigan is playing his fourth season of baseball and will earn his second varsity letter.

**GENERAL BASEBALL INFORMATION:** As a freshman in 2007-2008, Nick played in his first season of baseball and earned his first varsity letter. He made nine appearances, mostly as a relief pitcher. He had an 0-2 record with a 9.24 earned run average in 25 and one-third innings pitched. Nick also had a save and 14 strikeouts. B-W finished 19-19-1 overall. As a sophomore in 2008-2009, Nick played in his second season of baseball, but did not letter due to an arm injury which cut his season short following the spring break trip. Nick made three appearances, including one start, and posted a 5.91 earned run average with no decisions in 10 and two-third innings pitched. He recorded 10 strikeouts against seven walks. B-W finished 19-19 overall. As a junior in 2009-2010, Nick played his third season of baseball and made three appearances on the mound, all in relief. He pitched four innings and posted a 6.75 ERA with three strikeouts. Again, his season was limited due to his arm injury. As a senior in 2010-2011, Nick is having his finest season as a collegian. He has appeared in five games, including three starting assignments, and although he has a 0-2 record, he has a sparkling 3.12 earned run average. Two of his starts came against the current No.1-ranked team in NCAA Division III, Marietta (a 5-1 loss), and versus No.7-ranked Heidelberg (a 6-5 loss). In both outings, Flanigan threw extremely well but did not gain a victory.

**SPORTS PLAYED (YEARS AND LETTERS WON):** As a senior in 2010-2011, Ryan is playing his second year of baseball at B-W. As a sophomore transfer in 2008-09, he earned his first varsity letter.

**GENERAL BASEBALL INFORMATION:** As a freshman in 2007-2008, Ryan attended Ohio Dominican University. As a sophomore in 2008-2009, Ryan played in his first season of baseball and earned his first varsity letter. Ryan made 25 varsity appearances, including 19 starts at catcher. At the plate, Ryan hit .235 (12-of-51) with four doubles, a triple, six runs batted-in and 14 runs scored. Behind the plate, he had a .973 fielding percentage. B-W finished 19-19 overall. As a junior in 2009-2010, Ryan did not play baseball. As a senior in 2010-2011, Ryan is playing his second season of baseball and is splitting time behind the plate with a number of other catchers. He has appeared in 11 games, including four starts, and is batting .235 with a double and two RBI. He also has a .952 fielding average.

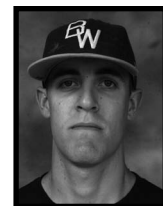
**GENERAL BASEBALL INFORMATION:** John played his first two years of baseball at Ashland University. As a freshman, he played on an Ashland squad that advanced to the NCAA Division II College World Series. As a sophomore, he played on an Ashland team that won a conference and regional championship. He transferred to Baldwin-Wallace after his sophomore year. As a junior in 2009-2010, John played in his first season of Yellow Jacket baseball and earned a varsity letter as a catcher. He saw action in 25 games, including 17 starts, and hit .339 (20-for-59) with three doubles, two triples, 10 runs batted in and 13 runs scored. He also had a .458 slugging average and a team-leading .474 on-base percentage. In addition, John had a good season defensively and had a .989 fielding average. As a senior in 2010-2011, John is playing his second season of baseball at B-W and is splitting time between catcher, leftfield and designated hitter. He is batting .306 (30-for-98) with 17 runs scored, four doubles, two triples and a team-leading 23 RBI. He is tied for second with 11 stolen bases and has a .388 slugging and .383 on-base average.
