Reminders: Each student-athlete will be required to complete a consent release and express assumption of risk form prior to participating in the tournament.

The Baldwin-Wallace College football tournament conforms with all high school rules. However, we still recommend that each coach check with his athletic director about his players' eligibility and OHSAA regulations.

Baldwin-Wallace College does not provide medical insurance for high school student-athletes. In the event of illness or injury requiring treatment hospitalization or surgery, the camper's family medical insurance must be used.

Eligibility: To participate in 2009 7-on-7 Tournament, a student-athlete must be a member of a high school football team.

Games: Your players will have a minimum of four games against quality competition, depending on how many teams enter.

The Mission: Our 7-on-7 team tournament is designed to improve the individual techniques of your players as well as the development of your offensive and defensive systems.

CAMP RULES

- One referee per game - high school rules
- Games take approximately 45 minutes
- Each team gets six plays from +40, six plays from +25, four plays from +10
- Teams start -- 1st and 10
- Tackling -- One hand touch
- Helmets and mouthpiece are required
- Four seconds for a sack
- Coaches may be behind offensive huddle, however, not in the secondary
- Sportsmanship will be emphasized, flagrant fouls may result in disqualification from the tournament

DON'T FORGET

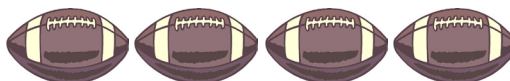
Coaches: Jerseys for athletes, medical information, consent release waivers, footballs.
