Paul Winters, Wayne State University

Winters, currently the Head Coach at Wayne State University has made an impact on the football programs at each of the colleges he has coached. Most recently, he concluded his seventh season at WSU as head football coach, leading the winningest team in college history with a record overall wins (9), conference wins (8), points in a season (347). The success of his winning season earned Winters the AFCA Division II Regional Coach of the Year Award.

Prior to his time at WSU, Winters was listed as one of the top 10 African-American head coaching candidates in the nation by the Black Coaches Association. Winters was very successful during his time working with University of Akron offense, leading to a nomination for the Broyles Award, a national honor recognizing the nation's top Division I-A assistant coach. He also served as an assistant at University of Wisconsin and the University of Toledo.

Winters has made an impact on the Warriors leading them to success from the time he arrived. WSU football moved up five places in the GLIAC standings from 2004 to 2005, and improved another four places in 2006 – a first winning season in more than a decade. Currently the WSU team is looking to excel yet again by improving on a 9-2 record from their 2010 season.

Greg Dempsey- Toledo Central Catholic High School As Head Coach, Dempsey has totaled 71 victories and a .744 winning percentage.

Mike Elder- Avon High School Head Coach Elder led the Eagles in 2010 to successful 10-0 season. Also known for his successes as Head Coach at both Ravenna South East and Perry High School.

Matt Duffy- Willoughby South High School As Lake County Coach of the Year, Duffy led his team to a successful season with a record of 9-2.

Rick Finotti- St. Edward High School: Successfully Led the St. Edward Eagles to victory as State Champions in their 2010 season. Prior to St. Edward, Finotti led one of the states top defenses at Mayfield High School

Keith Boedicker- Massillon Perry High School: In 11 years as Nordonias head coach, Boedicker was 92-32 with five playoff appearances. He made it to the final four twice, and was recently inducted into the Nordonias Hall of Fame. He has also coached at Gibsonburg, Akron Hoban, Akron Springfield, Rootstown, Wapakoneta, Stow and Baldwin-Wallace College prior to his current position as Head Football Coach. With a 7-3 record for their 2010 season, Perry High School looks for another successful season from Boedicker in his second year at Perry.

Larry Laird- Avon Lake High School/ Medina High School- Currently Offensive Coordinator at Avon Lake High School has aided in taking the Shoremen to the playoffs 7 times in his 8 seasons of coaching. Prior to this year Laird spent a year at Medina High School leading the Bees to a 9-3 season. Laird has also coached Kenton and Goshen High Schools.

Tim Brediger- North Olmsted High School Alumnus of Mercyhurst College, Brediger is currently the Defensive Coordinator at his Alma Mater.
