Darrell Hazell, Kent State University

Head Coach Darrell Hazell has a long history at developing and maintaining successful football programs. On December 10, 2010, Coach Hazell was named Head coach of the Kent State Golden Flashes, and has begun the development of a successful team.

Prior to his leadership at Kent State, Hazell spent seven seasons as a member of OSU's coaching staff, adding to his total of 25 years of experience at the collegiate level of coaching. Tressel said of Hazell during an interview "He is an excellent technician, a very talented instructor and teacher, and has great knowledge and insights on the game, especially on the offensive side of the ball. Those qualities take a back seat to the care and leadership he gives to the young men who play for him."

Hazell made an impact at OSU by developing many men into All-Big Ten players, six of whom currently play in the NFL. Before KSU and OSU, Hazell coached at Rutgers, West Virginia, Army, Western Michigan, Penn, Eastern Illinois and Oberlin. His dedication and love for football not only played an integral part in his job as a coach, but it also paid off at his alma mater, Muskingum University. Hazell was named a three time all-conference honoree, an All-American, and a team captain. This drive for success carried on into his career as a coach, and it is the same dedication and drive that will aid him in the development of Kent State University's football program.

Chuck Kyle- St. Ignatius High School - Head Coach Kyle has served as a teacher and football coach at St. Ignatius high school, leading to 11 state titles, three national titles and his 302-69-1 career record over 30 seasons.

Mike Passerello- Firelands High School - Head Coach Passerello turned a consecutive season with no more than three wins for the Firelands Falcons, into a team with a record of 10-1 during his second season as their head coach.

Greg Dennison- Wadsworth High School - Coach Dennison has successfully led the Grizzlies to seven playoff showings during his 17 season career, with an overall career record of 123-59.

Ben Malbasa- Benedictine High School- Coach Malbasa, a recent addition to the Benedictine coaching staff, led the 2011 Bengals to the first winning season in seven years.

Joe Harbour- Norwayne High School- Coach Harbour, a Baldwin-Wallace Alumnus and All-American, led the Bobcats to a 14-1 season and ultimately the State playoff, gaining the title of State Champions.

Tim Willis- Madison High School- Coach Willis, also a Baldwin-Wallace Alumnus, has been coaching the Blue Streaks for 8 years, and in 2011 he led his team to a 8-3 season.
