The Following is a listing of the rules to be used at the 2011 Yellow Jacket tournament.

Rules subject to change

Two referees per game– High School rules.

RULES:

Approximately 45 minute games.

Each team gets ball on +40-6 plays, +25-6 plays, +10-4 plays

Tackling= One hand touch

Helmets and mouth piece are required.

4 seconds for a sack

Coaches may be on field behind offensive huddle but not in secondary.

Sportsmanship will be emphasized, flagrant fouls may result in disqualification from the tournament.

Tournament winner is determined by W-L record in games played. Tie breakers are determined by total points scored.

This game format allows you to know going in how many reps you have to work with to decide on playing time and script plays for different areas of the field
