The History of Yellow Jacket Football by Bill Nichols

BEREA, OHIO -- The history of the Baldwin-Wallace College football program dates from 1893 to the present. The Yellow Jackets are playing their 106th year of college football in 2010.

In the summer of 2001, work was completed by 1963 B-W graduate and former sportswriter at *The Plain Dealer*, **Bill Nichols** on the history of football at the College. It is now available to you.

The book contains virtually every scoring play from 1893 through 2000. It describes the events of the game, history of that era and include features and side bar stories on some of the great people that have helped to make Yellow Jacket football special. The book is also dedicated to the late Eloise Tressel '72.

"It is not a book that you will be able to read in one night or in a few sittings," said Nichols. "It is not intended to be that type of book. It is a book that is approximately 400 pages in length. It details each and every game and each and every scoring drive and play. More importantly, it mentions people and names. The book includes events that are happening at that time and in that era. It mentions the price of a movie or the price of a piece of candy. What

type of clothes were people wearing in that era. What was happening in our nation's history. Was it World War I or II, the Korean Conflict of the Vietnam Era. What was going on during the Great Depression.

"The book is intended to be about football," said Nichols. "It is a history book. Yes, the history of B-W football. But also about the history of what was going on at B-W, in Berea, in Cleveland, in the United States and around the World. We want people to get a feeling for the era, the people, the place (B-W) and what was happening in our society at the time. I hope you enjoy the book. I know I enjoyed doing the research and writing it. I enjoyed talking with people and developing relationships that will last the rest of my life. It was a great experience."
