**Pre-game Setup** -- The Baldwin-Wallace College men's basketball team will look to sweep the season series versus Ohio Athletic Conference rival Mount Union College when it travels to Alliance to play the Purple Raiders in the McPherson Academic and Athletic Complex.

The Yellow Jackets enter this game at 12-9 overall and 7-7 in the OAC following a 74-60 loss against Capital University on Saturday, February 6 in Columbus. The loss ended a two-game winning streak. B-W has won eight of its past 12 games.

The Purple Raiders enter the contest at 9-12 overall and tied with B-W at 7-7 in the OAC following a 67-63 win at Ohio Northern University in Ada on Sunday, Feb. 7 in a game that was rescheduled due to weather. Mount Union has won two of its last three and four of its last six games.

**The All-Time Series Between B-W and Mount Union** -- This is the 123rd all-time meeting between B-W and Mount Union in men's basketball. The Yellow Jackets lead the series, 77-45. In the first meeting this season, on January 6 in Berea, the Yellow Jackets defeated the Purple Raiders, 82-61. Mount Union swept the series a season ago with a 73-71 overtime win on Jan. 29, 2009 in Berea, and a 72-63 win in Alliance on Dec 17, 2008. This would be B-W's first season sweep since the 2007-2008 season.

**In this Year's First B-W versus Mount Union Game on January 6, 2010 -- Baldwin-Wallace -- 82, Mount Union -- 61** -- In the first meeting this season between B-W and Mount Union, the Yellow Jackets a 82-61 victory against OAC rival Mount Union in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea on January 6, 2010, the Yellow Jackets were led by 6'1" junior guard **Zane Meeder (Erie, Pa./ Fairview)** who scored a game-high 19 points. In addition, 5'9" sophomore point guard **Promis Cabbil (Elyria/Senior)** and 6'5" senior All-OAC forward **Kyle Brown (Strongsville)** each scored 14 points, and 6'5" junior forward **Kevin Gall (Middleburg Heights/ Midpark)** came off the bench to score 10 points. Mt. Union was led by 6'4" junior forward Dave Pellerite and 6'6" sophomore forward Matt Wier each with 16 points.

**The Baldwin-Wallace College Starters and Information** -- B-W scores 75.1 points per game and allows 74.3 ppg. for a plus 0.9 ppg. differential. B-W grabs 35.0 rebounds per game and allows 34.7 rpg. for a plus 0.4 rpg. differential. The Yellow Jackets shoot 46.2 percent from the floor (559-of-1211 attempts), including 33.8% from three-point range (105-of-311), and 71.6% from the foul line (355-of-496).

Look for **Head Coach Duane Sheldon** to start **Kyle Brown**, 6'2 senior **Paul Glass (Medina/ Senior)** and 6'6" freshman forward **Chris Ameen** at the forward positions. In the backcourt, look for **Promis Cabbil** and **Zane Meeder** to start. **Cabbil** is tied for the team lead in scoring at 11.3 points per game, grabs 2.5 rebounds per game and tops the team with 97 assists, 33 steals and nine blocked shots. **Brown** scores 11.0 ppg., grabs 4.0 rpg., and has a team-leading 41 three-pointers. **Meeder** is tied for first in scoring at 11.3 ppg., grabs 4.2 rpg. and has 50 assists and 28 steals. **Ameen** scores 10.0 ppg., grabs a team-high 5.5 rpg., shoots 54.4% from the floor on 81-of-149 attempts and has 17 steals. **Glass** scores 7.7 ppg., grabs 3.4 rpg. and has 22 assists and 20 steals.

Also look for Sheldon to play **Kevin Gall**, 6'3" freshman guard **Brandon Schmidt (Wellington)**, 6'3" sophomore guard **Scott Voiers (Westlake/ Lutheran West)**, 5'9" sophomore guard **Matt Triana (North East, Pa./ North East)**, 6'5" freshman forward **Sean Rothermel (Delaware/ Hayes)** and 6'7" freshman forward **Ed Householder (North Jackson/ Tallmadge)**. **Gall** scores 6.7 ppg., grabs 2.9 rpg. and shoots 54% from the floor. **Voiers** scores 5.9 ppg., and has 13 treys. **Schmidt** scores 4.4 ppg. and is second with 16 triples.

**In B-W's Last Game on Feb. 6 in Bexley versus Capital University: Baldwin-Wallace -- 74, Capital -- 60 --** In B-W's last game, a 74-60 loss versus Capital University at the Capital Center in Bexley on February 6, the Yellow Jackets were led by **Zane Meeder** with 11 points and four rebounds. The keys to the Capital win were outrebounding B-W, 42-37, holding the Yellow Jackets to 35.9% shooting on 23-of-64 attempts, outscoring B-W from the foul line, 19-10, and creating 20 assists for 24 made baskets of its own.

**Mount Union College Information and Probable Starters --** Mount Union scores 66.9 points per game and allows 70.4 ppg. for a minus 3.5 ppg. differential. The Purple Raiders grab 30.8 rebounds per game and allow 31.9 rpg. for a minus 1.1 rpg. differential. MUC shoots 45.8 percent from the floor (484-of-1056 attempts), including 36.3% from three-point range (115-of-317), and 73.5% from the foul line (321-of-437).

Look for Head Coach Leed Hood to start 5'8" junior Ben Hodkinson and 6'0" senior Sam King in the backcourt. Hood will also start Dave Pellerite, 6'5" sophomore Jimmy Wood and Matt Wier at the forward positions. In addition, expect 6'1" freshman guard Jordan Tozzi, 6'2" senior forward LaRon Marshall, 6'7" sophomore center Wes Kavel and 6'5" junior forward Matt Kiger to all see playing time off the bench.

The versatile Pellerite leads the Purple Raiders in scoring at 13.6 ppg., rebounding at 7.0 rpg. and with 56 assists. He also has 26 three-pointers and 17 steals. Wood is second at 12.6 ppg., grabs 3.5 rpg., shoots 53.6% from the floor on 103-of-192 attempts and tops the team with eight blocked shots. Hodkinson is third at 9.3 ppg., grabs 2.1 rpg., tops the team with 36 treys, is third with 51 assists and second with 19 steals. Sam Wier scores is fourth at 8.8 ppg. and grabs 3.3 rpg. King scores 6.6 ppg., grabs 2.7 rpg., is second with 55 assists and tops the team with 20 steals. Off the bench, Kavel has played in 14 games and scores 6.6 ppg. and grabs 3.8 rpg. Kiger has played in 19 contests, scores 5.9 ppg. and grabs 3.3 rpg. Marshall has played in all 21 games and scores 4.0 ppg., and Tozzi has played in all 21 games and scores 2.9 ppg. with 10 triples.

**In Mount Union's Last Game on February 6 versus Ohio Northern in Ada: Mount Union -- 67, Ohio Northern -- 63 --** In Mount Union's last game, a 67-63 win at Ohio Northern in Ada, the Raiders were led by Dave Pellerite's game-high 27 points and eight rebounds. Wes Kavel came off the bench to score 12 points and grab five rebounds. The key to the Purple Raider win was outscoring the Polar Bears at the foul line, 18-11.
