The **BALDWIN-WALLACE COLLEGE YELLOW JACKET** men's basketball team travels to Columbus, Ohio to open 2010 Ohio Athletic Conference Tournament play in the first round against Capital University on Wednesday, February 24, 2010 in the Capital Center at 7:30 p.m. This is the third meeting this season between B-W and Capital. The winner advances to the OAC Final Four.

Pre-game Setup -- The sixth-seeded Baldwin-Wallace College men's basketball team opens 2010 Ohio Athletic Conference Tournament play versus third-seeded Capital University in the Capital Center in Columbus. The winner of this game advances to the OAC Final Four on Friday and Saturday, Feb. 26-27 at the site of the highest remaining seeded team. The 2010 OAC Championship Game is on Saturday, Feb. 27 at 7:30 p.m.

The Yellow Jackets enter this game at 14-11 overall following a 67-62 loss to Otterbein College on Saturday, February 20 in Berea. B-W has won 10 of its last 16 contests.

The Crusaders enter this game at 15-10 overall following a 65-58 win versus Mount Union College on Saturday in Columbus. After a 1-5 start to the season, Capital has won 14 of its last 19 contests.

The 2010 OAC Tournament First Round Schedule -- In other first round games, number one-seeded John Carroll University hosts No.8-seed Marietta College in University Heights at 7:30 p.m., No.2-seed Wilmington College hosts No.7-seed Mount Union in Wilmington at 7:30 p.m., and No.4-seed Ohio Northern University hosts No.5-seed Heidelberg University in Ada at 7:30 p.m.

The All-Time Series Between B-W and Capital -- This is the 89th all-time meeting between B-W and Capital in men's basketball. The Crusaders lead the all-time series, 49-39. Earlier this season, the two teams split the season series as Capital won, 74-60, in Bexley on February 6, 2010, and B-W beat the Crusaders, 87-73, in Berea December 12, 2009.

In the First B-W versus Capital Game on Dec. 12, 2009 in Berea: Baldwin-Wallace -- 87, Capital -- 73 -- In the first B-W versus Capital game this season, an 87-73 Yellow Jacket victory in Berea on December 12, B-W was led by 6'6" freshman center **Chris Ameen (Broadview Heights/ Walsh Jesuit)** with 15 points and a team-high eight rebounds. Also, 5'9" sophomore point guard **Promis Cabbil (Elyria/ Senior)** scored 13 points, dished out five assists and had three blocked shots, and 5'11" junior guard **Zane Meeder (Erie, Pa./ Fairview)** added 12 points and six rebounds. Keys to the win were B-W jumping out to a 41-17 halftime, holding to Capital to just 20 percent shooting (five-of-25) in the first half. B-W also made 30 free throws in a foul-ridden contest that saw a combined 62 fouls. Capital was led by Ben McGrath with 17 points.

In the Second B-W versus Capital Game on Feb. 6 in Bexley: Capital -- 74, Baldwin-Wallace- 60 -- In second B-W versus Capital game this season, a 74-60 Crusader win in the Capital Center in Bexley on February 6, the Yellow Jackets were led by **Zane Meeder** with 11 points and four rebounds. The keys to the Capital win were outrebounding B-W, 42-37, holding the Yellow Jackets to 35.9% shooting on 23-of-64 attempts, outscoring B-W from the foul line, 19-10, and creating 20 assists for 24 made baskets of its own. Capital was led by 6'2" junior guard DJ Frazier with a game-high 24 points and 6'6" junior forward Scott Robertson with 14 points and eight rebounds.

The Baldwin-Wallace College Starters and Information -- B-W scores 75.5 points per game and allows 74.3 ppg. for a plus 1.2 ppg. differential. B-W grabs 35 rebounds per game and allows 34.1 rpg. for a plus 0.9 rpg. differential. The Yellow Jackets shoot 46 percent from the floor (670-of-1446 attempts), including 35% from three-point range (134-of-382), and 72% from the foul line (413-of-575).

Look for **Head Coach Duane Sheldon** to start 6'5" All-OAC forward **Kyle Brown (Strongsville)**, 6'2" senior **Paul Glass** and **Chris Ameen** at the forward positions. In the backcourt, look for **Promis Cabbil** and **Zane Meeder** to start. **Cabbil** tops the team in scoring at 11.4 ppg., grabs 2.6 rpg. and leads the team with 122 assists, 45 steals and 9 blocked shots. **Brown** scores 13.0 ppg., grabs 4.0 rpg., and has a team-leading 61 three-pointers. **Meeder** is third in scoring at 10.4 ppg., grabs 4.0 rpg. and has 65 assists and 31 steals. **Ameen** scores 10.1 ppg., grabs a team-leading 5.8 rpg., shoots 54% from the floor on 99-of-183 attempts and has 11 blocked shots. **Glass** scores 7.5 ppg., grabs 3.7 rpg. and has 28 assists and 23 steals.

Also look for **Sheldon** to play **Kevin Gall**, 6'3" freshman guard **Brandon Schmidt (Wellington)**, 6'3" sophomore guard **Scott Voiers**, 5'9" sophomore guard **Matt Triana (North East, Pa./ North East)** and 6'7" freshman forward **Ed Householder (North Jackson/ Tallmadge)**. **Gall** scores 6.1 ppg., grabs 2.7 rpg. and shoots 52% from the floor. **Voiers** scores 5.7 ppg., and is third with 16 treys. **Schmidt** scores 3.9 ppg. and is second with 17 triples.

In B-W's Last Game on February 20 in Berea versus Otterbein College: Otterbein -- 67, Baldwin-Wallace -- 62 -- In B-W's last game, a 67-62 loss to Otterbein College on Saturday, February 20 in Berea, the Yellow Jackets were led by **Promis Cabbil** with 16 points with three assists and **Kyle Brown** had 14 points and three rebounds. The keys in the loss were being outscored at the free throw line, 18-12, and committing 13 turnovers compared to just seven for Otterbein.

Capital University Information and Probable Starters -- Capital scores 74.0 points per game and allows 67.3 ppg. for a plus 6.7 ppg. differential. The Crusaders shoot 46.5 percent from the floor (648-of-1394 attempts), including 38% from three-point range (161-of-425), and 69% from the foul line (393-of-569). Capital grabs 35.4 rebounds per game and allows 33.1 rpg. for a plus 2.3rpg. differential.

Look for Head Coach Damon Goodwin to start DJ Frazier, 6'1" senior Ben McGrath and 6'2" freshman Anthony Bell in the backcourt, and 6'6" freshman Spencer Niekamp and 6'6" junior Scott Roberston on the inside. In addition, expect 6'3" freshman Michael Sommer, 6'3" junior transfer Donnie Curtis (Ohio State), 6'2" sophomore transfer guard Kelly Winter (Tennessee), 6'3" junior wing Scott Steinman and 6'7" freshman center Colin Geaney to see playing time.

Frazier leads the team with 13.0 ppg., 6.7 rpg., 53 steals and 25 blocked shots. He also is second with 76 assists. McGrath is second in scoring with 12.0 ppg., grabs 4.2 rpg. and leads the team with 105 assists and 54 three-pointers. Roberston scores 10.9 ppg., is second with 5.7 rpg., tops the team in field goal shooting at 61.9% on 99-of-160 attempts and has 15 blocks. Niekamp scores 8.8 ppg., grabs 3.3 rpg., shoots 52.4% from the floor on 75-of-143 attempts and is second with 33 treys. Bell, who has started 12 games, scores 5.1 ppg., grabs 2.7 rpg. and has 46 assists and 34 steals.

Off the bench, Johns scores 8.2 ppg., grabs 3.1 rpg. and has 33 assists. Munro averages 7.7 ppg. and is second with 38 triples. Geaney averages 3.2 ppg. and grabs 2.1 rpg.

In Capital's Last Game on February 20 versus Mount Union in Columbus: Capital -- 65, Mount Union -- 58 -- In Capital's last game, a 65-58 win versus Mount Union College last Saturday, February 20 in Columbus, the Crusader's were led by Ben McGrath with a team-high 12 points and 10 assists. In addition, Adam Johns came off the bench to score 11 points and grab a team-high eight rebounds and Michael Sommer had 10 points.

Yellow Jacket Chatter

OAC Tournament Titles -- Baldwin-Wallace College has won four OAC Tournament titles. The titles came in 1996, 1998, 2005 and 2006. Two years ago, current Yellow Jacket Head Coach Duane Sheldon led OACrival Heidelberg College (now Heidelberg UNiversity) to the OAC tourney title.

Brown Also Approaching the 1,000-Point Mark -- **Kyle Brown** enters this game with 960 career points at B-W and needs 40 more to reach 1,000 for his Yellow Jacket career.

Paul Glass Named to Academic All-District IV Team -- **Paul Glass**, who carries a 3.69 grade point average in pre-physical therapy, was named as a second-team *ESPN THE MAGAZINE* Academic All-District IV student-athlete. He and **Kevin Gall** are candidates for Academic All-OAC honors.
