The **BALDWIN-WALLACE COLLEGE YELLOW JACKET** men's basketball team travels to Ohio Athletic Conference rival Capital University on Saturday, January 7, 2012 for an OAC contest in the Capital Center in Bexley. B-W will be looking to win its third straight game against the Crusaders. This is the 13th game of the regular season for the Yellow Jackets.

**RADIO** -- Baldwin-Wallace College campus radio station WBWC, 88.3 FM, broadcasts all Yellow Jacket men's and women's games, home and away. The games also can be heard via the WBWC's Internet Web site at [www.wbwc.com](http://www.wbwc.com). The pregame show begins 15 minutes prior to tipoff.

**Pre-game Setup** -- The Yellow Jackets enter this game at 8-4 overall and 3-2 in the OAC following a hard-fought, 89-85 loss at OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University on Wednesday, January 4 in University Heights. B-W has won two of its last three contests.

The Crusaders enter this game at 6-6 overall and 3-2 in the OAC following a 76-67 victory at Otterbein University on January 4 in Westerville. Capital has won three of its last five contests.

**The All-Time Series Between B-W and Capital** -- This is the 94th all-time meeting in men's basketball between B-W and Capital. The Crusaders lead the all-time series, 51-42, but the Yellow Jackets have won the last two meetings, including a 64-61 victory in the last meeting on February 12, 2011 in Bexley. The last Capital win was an 84-73 victory on February 24, 2010 in Columbus in the quarterfinals of the 2009-10 OAC Tournament.

**The Baldwin-Wallace College Starters and Information** -- B-W likes to run with the basketball and will play aggressive man-to-man defense. B-W scores 76.3 ppg. and allows 66.1 ppg. for a plus 10.2 ppg. differential. The Yellow Jackets grab 37.8 rpg. and allow 36.0 rpg. for a plus 1.8 rpg. differential. B-W shoots 44.4 percent from the floor on 323-of-727 attempts, including 32.5 percent from three-point range on 89-of-274 attempts, and 69.1 percent from the foul line on 181-of-262 attempts.

Look for Head Coach Duane Sheldon to give 10-to-12 players court time. He will start **Kyle Payne**, 6'2" junior **Ben Umbel (Poland/ Seminary via Div. I Youngstown State University)** and 6'7" sophomore **Tyler Ferrell (Brunswick)** at the forward positions. In the backcourt, look for senior All-OAC point guard **Promis Cabbil (Elyria/ Senior)** and 6'4" sophomore **Kevin Krakowiak (Valley City/ Parma Heights Holy Name)** to start. **Payne** leads the team in scoring with 13.9 points-per-game and in rebounding with 6.0 rpg. **Krakowiak** is second with 12.7 ppg., grabs 2.8 rpg. and is second with 21 three-pointers. **Farrell** scores 6.9 ppg., grabs 4.8 rpg. and is tied for first with eight blocked shots. **Cabbil** scores 4.0 ppg., grabs 2.1 rpg. and has 31 assists. **Umbel** scores 6.6 ppg., grabs 5.2 rpg., and leads the team with 36 assists and 29 steals.

Off the bench, Sheldon has played 6'0" red-shirt freshman guard **Jaron Crowe (Mentor)**, 6'6" junior forward **Chris Ameen (Broadview Heights/ Walsh Jesuit)**, 6'8" sophomore center **Aaron Selmek (Delaware/ Columbus St. Francis DeSales)**, 6'1" sophomore guard **Grant Fairhurst (Ashland)**, 6'3" junior guard **Brandon Schmidt (Wellington)**, 6'3" junior forward **Scott Branchick (Mentor)** and 6'5" junior forward **Sean Rothermel (Delaware/ Hayes)**. **Ameen** is tied for third in scoring at 8.8 ppg., grabs 4.3 rpg. and has 12 three-pointers and eight blocked shots. **Crowe** scores 6.4 ppg., grabs 1.4 rpg., is second with 35 assists and third with 16 treys. **Fairhurst** is tied with Ameen for third at 8.8 ppg., has a team-leading 27 triples and is second with 18 steals. **Selmek** scores 4.6 ppg., grabs 3.1 rpg. and shoots 60.5% from the floor on 26-of-43 attempts.

**In B-W's Last Game: John Carroll -- 89, Baldwin-Wallace -- 85 on Jan. 4 in University Heights, Ohio** -- In B-W's last game, an 89-85 loss at OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University on January 4, the Yellow Jackets were led by **Chris Ameen** with 14 points. In addition, **Kevin Krakowiak** had 13 and **Jaron Crowe** added 12. B-W led by as many as 17 in the first half and by 14 points (49-35) at halftime. The keys to the loss were being outrebounded, 46-35 and outscoring B-W at the foul line, 40-17. In the game, there were 56 fouls and 79 foul shots.

**Scouting the Crusaders of Capital University** -- Head Coach Damon Goodwin likes to play 10-to-12 student-athletes per game and 10 have played in all 12 contests. Capital scores 71.6 points-per-game and allows 70.9 ppg. for a plus 0.7 ppg. differential. The Crusaders grab 34.2 rebounds per game and allow 35.8 rpg. for a minus 1.6 rpg. differential. CU shoots 43.7% from the floor (296-of-678 attempts), including 34.6% from three-point range (82-of-237), and 74.9% from the foul line (185-of-247).

Look for Goodwin to start 6'6" junior Spencer Niekamp and 6'5" sophomore Ben Danhoff at the forward positions, and 6'1" senior Kelly Winter, 6'3" junior Michael Sommer and 6'0" freshman Adam Blake in the backcourt.

Neikamp leads the Crusaders in scoring with 14.6 ppg., grabs 4.4 rpg., is second with 20 three-pointers and 12 steals. Sommer is second at 13.5 ppg., grabs 3.9 rpg., tops the team with 28 treys and is second with 23 assists and 12 steals. Winter is third at 11.9 ppg., grabs a team-high 5.0 rpg. and leads the team with 37 assists and 15 steals. Danhoff has started five times and scores 2.7 ppg. and grabs 2.8 rpg. Blake scores 1.8 ppg. and has 22 assists.

Off the bench, look for 6'4" junior forward Ben Jackson, 6'4" senior guard Tyler Munro, 6'0" junior guard Mitch Westerheide, 6'0" junior guard Tim Congrove, 6'8" sophomore center Jared Cashen, 6'0" junior guard Tim Cammon and 5'10" junior guard Damon Dillard to all see action. Jackson is fourth in scoring at 6.3 ppg., grabs 3.3 rpg. and shoots 54.2% from the floor on 32-of-59 attempts. Westerheide scores 5.3 ppg., grabs 2.5 rpg. and has 22 assists. Muro scores 5.1 ppg. and is third with 13 triples.

**In Capital's Last Game: Capital -- 76, Otterbein -- 67 on January 4 in Westerville, Ohio --** In Capital's last game, a 76-67 victory at Otterbein University on January 4 in Westerville, the Capital were led by Michael Sommer with 22 points on 9-of-12 shooting from the floor, and Spencer Niekamp with 20 points and five rebounds. The keys to the win included shooting 51.1% from the floor on 23-of-45 attempts and outscoring Otterbein at the free throw line, 25-14.
