The **BALDWIN-WALLACE COLLEGE YELLOW JACKET** men's basketball team travels to Lexington, Kentucky on Tuesday, December 20, 2011 to play unbeaten and No.17-ranked Wabash (Ind.) College in the first round of the Transylvania University Don Lane Classic in the Beck Recreation and Athletic Center at 5:30 p.m. The winner of this game will play the winner of the host Transylvania versus Henrix (Ark.) College in the championship game on December 21 at 7:00 p.m. The consolation game is at 5:00 p.m. This is the ninth game of the regular season for the Yellow Jackets.

RADIO -- Baldwin-Wallace College campus radio station WBWC, 88.3 FM, broadcasts all Yellow Jacket men's and women's games, home and away. The games also can be heard via the WBWC's Internet Web site at www.wbwc.com. The pregame show begins 15 minutes prior to tipoff.

Pre-game Setup -- The Yellow Jackets enter this game at 6-2 overall following a 68-63 victory on Saturday, December 17 at Muskingum University in New Concord, Ohio. B-W has won four of its past five contests.

The Little Giants enter this game at 8-0 overall following a 72-58 win against then No.4-ranked The College of Wooster in its last game on December 10 in Crawfordsville, Indiana. The Little Giants have not played in 10 days.

The All-Time Series Between B-W and Wabash -- This is the third all time meeting between B-W and Wabash in men's basketball. The Little Giants lead the all-time series, 2-0. No other information is available at this time.

The Baldwin-Wallace College Starters and Information -- B-W likes to run with the basketball and will play aggressive man-to-man defense. B-W scores 75.2 ppg. and allows 62.1 ppg. for a plus 13.1 ppg. differential. The Yellow Jackets grab 39.4 rpg. and allow 35.0 rpg. for a plus 4.4 rpg. differential. B-W shoots 43.8 percent from the floor on 213-of-486 attempts, including 31.0 percent from three-point range on 58-of-187 attempts, and 70.2 percent from the foul line on 118-of-168 attempts.

Look for Head Coach Duane Sheldon to give 10-to-12 players court time. He will start **Kyle Payne**, 6'2" junior **Ben Umbel (Poland/ Seminary via Div. I Youngstown State University)** and 6'7" sophomore **Tyler Ferrell (Brunswick)** at the forward positions. In the backcourt, look for senior All-OAC point guard **Promis Cabbil (Elyria/ Senior)** and 6'4" sophomore **Kevin Krakowiak (Valley City/ Parma Heights Holy Name)** to start. **Payne** leads the team in scoring with 13.3 points-per-game and in rebounding with 6.9 rpg. **Krakowiak** is second with 13.0 ppg., grabs 2.4 rpg. and has 15 three-pointers. **Farrell** scores 8.0 ppg. and grabs 5.9 rpg. **Cabbil** scores 3.8 ppg., grabs 1.9 rpg. and leads team with 24 assists. **Umbel** scores 5.5 ppg., grabs 4.3 rpg., has 20 assists and tops the team with 22 steals.

Off the bench, Sheldon has played 6'0" red-shirt freshman guard **Jaron Crowe (Mentor)**, 6'6" junior forward **Chris Ameen (Broadview Heights/ Walsh Jesuit)**, 6'8" sophomore center **Aaron Selmek (Delaware/ Columbus St. Francis DeSales)**, 6'1" sophomore guard **Grant Fairhurst (Ashland)**, 6'3" junior guard **Brandon Schmidt (Wellington)**, 6'3" junior forward **Scott Branchick (Mentor)** and 6'5" junior forward **Sean Rothermel (Delaware/ Hayes)**. **Ameen** scores 8.6 ppg. and grabs 4.5 rpg. **Crowe** scores 5.9 ppg., grabs 1.7 rpg. and has 22 assists. **Fairhurst** scores 8.0ppg. and has a team-leading 18 triples.

In B-W's Last Game: Baldwin-Wallace -- 68, Muskingum -- 63 in New Concord on December 17 -- In B-W's last game, a 68-63 win against Muskingum University on December 17 in New Concord, the Yellow Jackets were led by Payne with a game-high 24 points and grabbed a team-high 11 rebounds. In addition to Payne, Ferrell scored in double digits with 11 and grabbed nine rebounds.

Scouting the Little Giants of Wabash (Ind.) College -- Head Coach Antione Carpenter has played 11 student-athletes in four or more games with eight players having played in at least seven contests. WC scores 66.9 ppg. and allows 53.8 ppg. for a plus 13.1 ppg. differential. The Little Giants grab 31.6 rpg. and allow 27.3 rpg. for a plus 4.3 rpg. differential. Wabash shoots 45.5 percent from the floor (177-of-389 attempts), including 42 percent from three-point range (58-of-138), and 74.1 percent from the foul line (123-of-166).

Carpenter has utilized the same starting lineup in all eight contests this season. On the inside, look for 6'5" senior Derek Bailey, 6'7" freshman Casey Oetting and 6'7" senior Nick Curosh to start. In the backcourt, the starters are 6'2" senior Aaron Zinnerman and 6'3" senior Brian Shelbourne. Bailey tops the team in scoring at 15.5 ppg., grabs 2.4 rpg. and leads the team with 21 three-pointers (21-of-43 for 48.8%). Zinnerman is second at 15.3 ppg., grabs 5.3 rpg. to rank second and is second with 11 triples and 22 assists. Shelbourne is third at 9.6 ppg., grabs 4.9 rpg. and tops the squad with 23 assists and 15 steals. Oetting scores 8.8 ppg., grabs 2.1 rpg. and is third with nine treys. Curosh scores 5.6 ppg., tops the team with 7.5 rpg. and shoots 71.4% from the floor on 20-of-28 attempts.

Off the bench, Carpenter has played 6'3" junior guard Jordan Surenkamp, 6'7" sophomore forward Pete Nicksic, 6'7" junior center Colten Craigin, 6'0" freshman guard Austin Hawn, 6'4" freshman forward Lawrence Milton and 5'10" junior guard Evan Johnson. Surenkamp scores 5.9 ppg., grabs 2.4 rpg. and is fourth with eight three-pointers. I five games, Hawn averages 4.2 ppg. Nicksic scores 2.0 ppg. and grabs 2.6 rpg.

In Wabash's Last Game: Wabash -- 72, Wooster -- 58 in Crawfordsville, Indiana on December 10 -- In Wabash's last game, a 72-58 victory against then No.4-ranked The College of Wooster, Aaron Zinnerman led the way with a game-high 25 points and game-high-tying eight rebounds. In addition, Brian Shelbourne had 18 points and Jordan Surenkamp came off the bench to add 10 points. The keys to the Little Giants' win were outscoring Wooster from the foul line, 22-8, making 22-of-25 free throws for 88% compared to just 8-of-13 for the Fighting Scots and forcing 14 Wooster turnovers.
