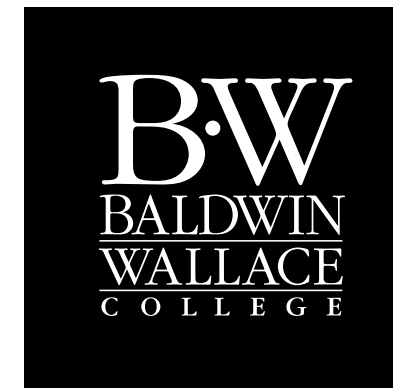
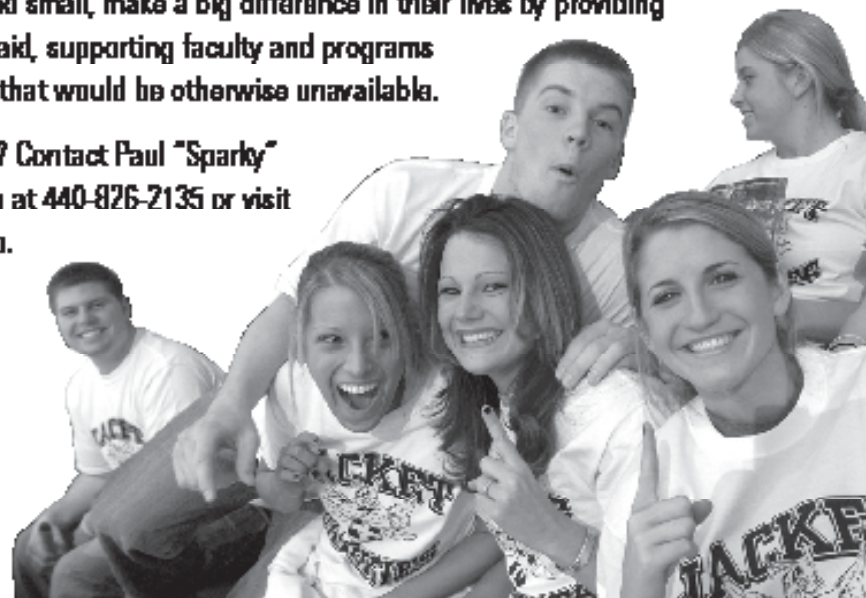

# Yellow Jacket Spring Sports Update

## Overall

\*\*\* Entering today's events, the Baldwin-Wallace College spring sport teams have combined to compile an impressive 156-50 record and a .757 winning percentage. Seven of the eight Yellow Jacket teams have winning records.

## Baseball

\*\*\* The baseball team, 15-13 overall and 3-7 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, is playing an OAC doubleheader today at Heidelberg University at 1:00 p.m. To date, sophomore centerfielder **Nolan Neuschaefer (Elyria)** tops the team in batting average at .333 overall. Sophomore **Pat Havens (Twinsburg)** tops the pitching staff at 4-0 with a 3.79 earned run average. The diamondmen also play at Wilmington College on Friday at 1:00 p.m.

## Women's Tennis

\*\*\* The defending OAC-champion women's tennis team, 11-7 overall and 4-1 in the league, hosts Heidelberg on the "Pop" Collins Courts in Berea at 3:30 p.m. To date, junior number three singles player **Jenny Greene (Worthington/ Thomas Worthington)** has the best singles mark at 16-6, and the No.1 doubles tandem of senior No.1 player **Caitlin Pecinovsky (Whitehall/ Columbus Bishop Hartley)** and sophomore No.3 player **Rebecca Mittler (Elyria/ Catholic)** have the best doubles mark at 16-8. The Yellow Jacket women have won 51 of their past 54 OAC matches, including three OAC regular season and three OAC Tournament titles. The women also host Wilmington this Friday at 1:00 p.m.

## Men's Tennis

\*\*\* The men's tennis team is 17-3 overall and 3-2 in the OAC and plays today at Heidelberg at 3:30 p.m. To date, senior No.5 player **Sam Burris (Wooster)** and senior No.4 player **Matt Lachman (Cleveland Hts./St. Edward)** have the best singles marks each at 18-4 overall. The No.3 doubles duo of junior **Alex Kearney (North Olmsted)** and junior **Taylor Long (Ashland)** are 15-3 and the No.2 tandem of junior **Alex Trzeciak (Avon Lake)** and freshman **Brad Minrovic (Akron/ Ellet)** are 15-4. The men also play at Wilmington on Friday at 1:00 p.m.

## Men's and Women's Track

\*\*\* The men's (33-1 overall) and women's (33-2 overall) track and field teams host the annual Paul "Sparky" Adams Invitational Meet this Saturday, April 23 at The George Finnie Stadium. The field events begin at 8:00 a.m. and running events start at 11:00 a.m. Last Saturday, the B-W men won a team title at the annual All-Ohio Division III Championship Meet in Columbus and the women placed second. The men were led by senior 4-time All-American **Kevin Phipps (Patsakala/ Watkins Memorial)** who won the shot put and hammer and placed third in the discus. Senior 3-time All-American **Kim Chinn (Zanesville/ West Muskingum)** led the women as she won the 3,000-meter steeplechase and placed third in the 800-meter run.

## Women's Golf

\*\*\* The women's golf team, 71-16 overall, plays at the Heidelberg University Invitational on April 21-22. The women were led by freshman **Emilee Woolf (Ravenna)** who leads the team with an 84.0 stroke average in three events and five total rounds of 18 holes.

## Men's Golf

\*\*\* The men's golf team played yesterday in the final day of the annual OAC Spring Invitational Tournament and will play again later this week. To date this spring, sophomore **Stephen Spalding (Akron/ Walsh Jesuit)** tops the team with a 76.40 stroke average and classmate and transfer **Augie Ward (Cuyahoga Falls/ Walsh Jesuit)** is second at 77.60.

## Yellow Jackets Host Heidelberg in Key Ohio Athletic Conference Twinbill Today

**BEREA, OHIO --** The Baldwin-Wallace College softball team, 17-8 overall and 5-5 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, hosts OAC-rival Heidelberg University, 21-9 overall and 3-7 in the OAC, today in a key doubleheader at the Cuyahoga County Fairgrounds Field. B-W needs two wins to better its positioning both in the current OAC Standings (*see the back outside cover for the current OAC Standings and today's OAC schedule*) and for the upcoming OAC Tournament.

The Yellow Jackets last played on Sunday (April 17) when it split an OAC doubleheader with rival Ohio Northern University in Ada. ONU rallied for seven runs in the final two innings, including a game-winning, walkoff three-run homerun, to win the opener, 10-8. B-W utilized the fine pitching of freshman **Tabiltha Murray** and homers by seniors **Katrina Resek** and *Capital One Academic All-American* **Tanya Davis** and **Murray** to win the nightcap, 6-4. Despite the loss in the opener, **Murray** and freshman third baseman **Kaity Mullen** each hit homers.

To date freshman leftfielder **Ashley Elber** leads the team in batting with a .413 batting average, a team-leading nine doubles, two homers and 13 runs batted-in. **Mullen** is second at .380 with five doubles, two homers and 20 RBI. **Resek**, the first baseman, is third at .378 with one double, one homer, 11 RBI and a team-leading 14 steals in 16 attempts. She also has a perfect, 1,000 fielding percentage in 186 total attempts. **Murray** is fourth at .359 with three doubles, a team-leading five homers and 16 RBI. **Davis**, who starts in CF, is this year's OAC *Clyde Lamb Award* winner who carries a 3.93 grade average in athletic training, is hitting .354 with seven doubles, two triples, two homers and a team-leading 22 RBI. Freshman shortstop **Lauren Feciuch** rounds out the .300 hitters at .308 with six doubles, a team-leading three triples, one homer and 14 RBI. Also, junior 2B **Katie Finley** is hitting .295 with two doubles and five RBI.

On the mound, freshman **Justina Wise**, classmate **Murray** and junior **Sarah Baker** are B-W's top three pitchers. **Wise** tops the team in victories with nine, is 9-4 with a 2.99 earned run average and a team-high 54 strikeouts in ateam-leading 72 and two-third innings pitched. She also has the most starts (13), complete games (8) and shutouts (2). **Murray** is 3-0 with a team-leading 1.64 ERA and 13 whiffs in 21 and one-third innings of work. **Baker**, who also hits .290 with four doubles and eight RBI when she plays RF, has a 5-4 record with a 2.96 ERA and 21 strikeouts in 45 innings pitched.

Following today's games, B-W is idle until Friday when it hosts OAC-foe Wilmington College in an OAC twinbill at 1:00 p.m.
