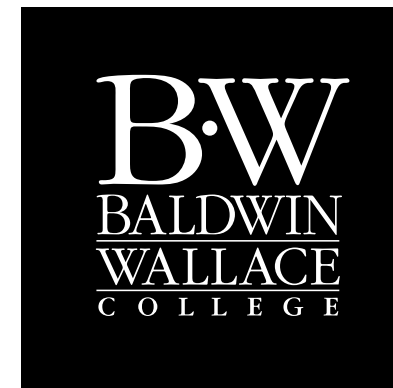
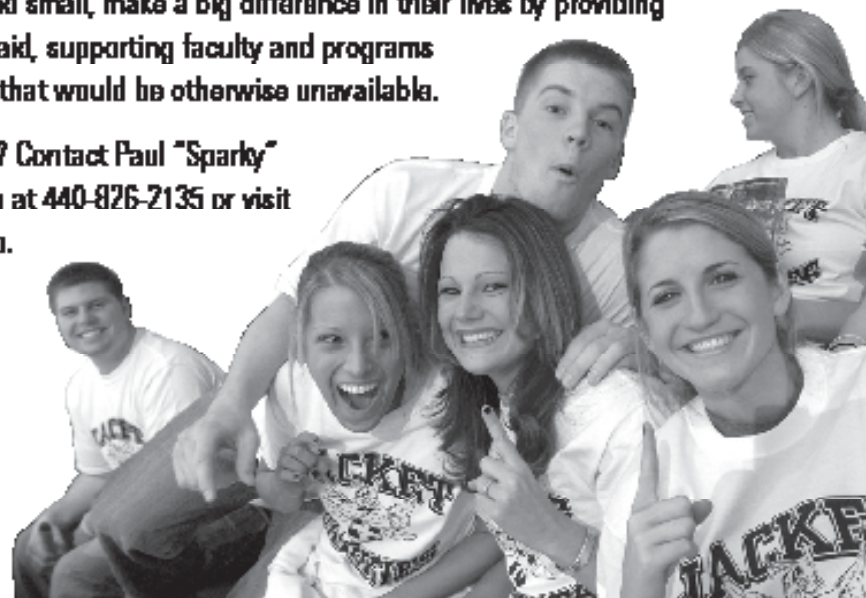

The Yellow Jackets Host John Carroll in their OAC Opener Today

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College softball team, 11-4 overall and 2-2 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, hosts OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University, 13-7 overall and 3-1 in the OAC, today in a key doubleheader at the Cuyahoga County Fairgrounds Field.

The Yellow Jackets last played on Thursday (April 7) when it shut out traditional rival Hiram College, 8-0, in Berea. In that game, freshman pitcher **Justina Wise** improved to 6-2 overall and she allowed just three base hits in the five-inning, eight-run "mercy rule" contest. She struck out three and did not walk a batter for her fourth complete game of the season. At the plate, senior first baseman **Katrina Resek**, freshman leftfielder **Ashley Elber** and junior second baseman **Katie Finley** each had a pair of base hits. Senior CF **Tanya Davis** had a two-run triple in a four-run first inning and freshman shortstop **Lauren Feciuch's** first career homerun, a three-run shot in the bottom for the fifth, ended the game.

To date **Resek** leads the team in batting with a .444 average, 24 base hits, 10-for-10 in stolen bases and with a perfect 1.000 fielding average in 96 total attempts. Freshman 3B **Kaity Mullen** ranks second with a .439 batting average with three doubles and 11 runs batted-in. **Elber** is third at .438, is second with 21 hits and is first with 15 runs scored and six doubles. **Davis** is fourth at .370 with a team-leading 16 RBI. Feciuch is fifth at .368 and has a team-leading three triples. Freshman RF/P **Tabitha Murray** rounds out the above-.300 hitters at .340 with three doubles, a team-leading two homers and nine RBI.

On the mound **Wise** and junior **Sarah Baker** are the top two pitchers. **Wise** is 6-2 with a 2.23 earned run average in appearances, including seven starts. She has a team-leading 31 strikeouts in a team-leading 37 and two-third innings pitched. **Baker**, who also is a solid hitter, is 4-2 with a 3.27 ERA and 16 whiffs in 30 innings pitched. At the plate, she is hitting .268 with a double and seven RBI. **Murray** is 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA in nine and one-thrd innings of work and senior **Mackenzie Rohrbacher** is 0-0 with a 5.25 ERA in 12 innings pitched.

Tanya Davis enters today's games among the all-time leaders in a number of offensive categories, including games played (135/4th), at-bats (442/3rd), hits (177/2nd), runs scored (121/2nd), doubles (45/first), triples (6/tied for 10th), homeruns (16/3rd), RBI (133/1st) and stolen bases (31/6th). **Katrina Resek** also is among the career leaders in games played (135/4th), at-bats (436/4th), hits (141/9th), runs scored (83/8th), triples (7/tied for 6th) and steals (36/tied for 3rd). **Sarah Baker** enters the game among the all-time leaders in several pitching categories, including appearances (61/6th), innings pitched (348.2/5th), wins (35/3rd), strikeouts (169/6th), complete games (40/5th) and ERA (2.41/8th).

Yellow Jacket Spring Sports Update

Baseball

*** The baseball team, 11-8 overall and 1-3 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, is playing an OAC doubleheader today at Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University at 1:00 p.m. To date, junior shortstop **Anthony Longhitano (Cuyahoga Falls)** leads the team in batting at .333 overall. Junior pitchers **Josh Scott (Strongsville)** and sophomore **Pat Havens (Twinsburg)** lead the team with three wins each. **Havens** is 3-0 with a 2.96 earned run average and **Scott** is 3-1 with a 2.54 ERA. Next week, B-W plays six home games as it hosts Walsh University on April 12 at 4:00 p.m., the University of Mount Union on April 13 at 1:00 p.m., The College of Wooster on April 15 at 4:00 p.m. and Ohio Northern University on April 16 at 1:00 p.m.

Women's Tennis

*** The defending OAC-champion women's tennis team, 9-6 overall and 2-0 in the league, hosts OAC and Cleveland rival JCU today on "**Coach Jack Bethlenfalvy Day**" on the "Pop" Collins Courts in Berea at 1:00 p.m. Prior to the match, **Coach Bethlenfalvy** will be presented a plaque to honor his 300th career win. To date, junior number three singles player **Jenny Greene (Worthington/ Thomas Worthington)** has the best singles mark at 14-6, and the No.1 doubles tandem of senior No.1 player **Caitlin Pecinovsky (Whitehall/ Columbus Bishop Hartley)** and sophomore No.3 player **Rebecca Mittler (Elyria/ Catholic)** have the best doubles mark at 15-6. The Yellow Jacket women have won 48 of their past 50 OAC matches.

Men's Tennis

*** The men's tennis team is 16-1 overall and 4-0 in the OAC after shutting out Marietta, 9-0, last Saturday in Berea. Today, B-W is at JCU at 1:00 p.m. To date, senior No.5 player **Sam Burris (Wooster)** and senior No.4 player Matt Lachman (**Cleveland Hts./St. Edward**) have the best singles marks each at 17-2 overall. The No.3 doubles duo of junior **Alex Kearney (North Olmsted)** and junior Taylor Long (**Ashland**) are 14-1 and the No.2 tandem of junior **Alex Trzeciak (Avon Lake)** and freshman **Brad Minrovic (Akron/ Ellet)** are 14-2.

Men's and Women's Track

*** The women's track teams won last Saturday's OAC Split Squad Meet and the men placed second. This Saturday, both teams compete at the annual Marv Frye Meet at Ohio Wesleyan University at 11:00 a.m. To date, senior 4-time All-American **Kevin Phipps (Patsakala/ Watkins Memorial)** has led the way as he broke school records in the discus and hammer and automatically qualified for the 2011 NCAA National Championship Meet. At the OAC Split Squad Meet, sophomore **Mitch Supan (Medina/ Walsh Jesuit)** won the shot put, discus and hammer throws and provisionally qualified for the national meet in all three events. Senior **Kim Chinn (Zanesville)** led the ladies to the team title and won the 800 and 1500-meter runs and on the winning 4x800-meter relay team. **Supan** and **Chinn** are this week's OAC *Track Athletes of the Week*.

Women's Golf

*** The women's golf team, 71-16 overall, placed third of 12 teams two weekends ago at the Capital University Purple & White Tournament and are now idle until the Heidelberg University Invitational on April 21-22. The women were led by freshman **Emilee Woolf (Ravenna)** who placed seventh individually with rounds of a career-high-tying 77 and an 87 for a two-day and 36-hole total of 164 strokes. To date, **Woolf** leads the team with an 84.0 stroke average in three events and five total rounds of 18 holes.

Men's Golf

*** The men's golf team, 33-31, played two weeks ago at the Muskingum University Tournament and plays this weekend at the April 9-10 Denison University Tournament. At Muskingum, sophomore **Stephen Spalding (Medina/ Walsh Jesuit)** led the way with rounds of 76 and 76 for a 36-hole total of 152 strokes. On its spring break trip to the PGA West facility in San Jacinto, California, B-W beat San Jacinto J.C. in a dual match. This fall, senior **Brian Routhieaux (Gibsonia, Pa./ Mars Area)** had the low stroke average at 77.63 overall. In California, freshman and Kent State University transfer **Augie Ward (Medina/Walsh Jesuit)** had the low score with an 80.
