Between the second and third games of tonight's match, B-W Head Coach Vicki Brault will be honored for her 200th win at B-W. Brault got her 200th win in a 3-0 victory over Marietta College on October 16. Brault is 201-123 in 10 years at B-W and 271-173 overall in her 14-year career.



## Yellow Jackets Host Heidelberg on Seniors' Night; B-W will end regular season at Wisconsin-Whitewater Tournament

**BEREA, OHIO --** The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team hosts Ohio Athletic Conference rival Heidelberg College on Seniors' and Parents' night at the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium.

B-W enters tonight's game with a 18-9 overall record and 6-2 in the OAC following a 3-0 win against Muskingum College last Saturday.

In the win versus Muskingum, senior two-time All-OAC middle hitter **Laura Leach** recorded 18 kills in the game making her the team leader and also giving her a .457 hitting percentage. Following **Leach** in kills was junior **Emily Albanese** with 12 and freshman **Kelsey Hills** with 11. **Hills** recorded a .550 hitting percent for the game. Sophomore setter **Kristin Habegger** played a strong game and recorded 44 set assests, three kills, 12 digs and hit .400 percent.

Sophomore libero **Kim Stoll** led the team with 28 digs followed by **Albanese** with 21 **Albanese** also recorded four solo blocks followed by **Hills** with two.

After 27 matches, **Leach** leads the offense with 474 kills (4.99/ game) and has the most blocks with 69, including 53 solo blocks. In addition, **Leach** tops the team in hitting at .350 and has 143 digs and 24 service aces. **Hills** is second with 285 kills, is hitting .268 and has 45 blocks to rank second.

She also has 290 digs and 34 aces. **Igarashi** tops the team with 1,007 assists (11.44/ game), is fourth with 324 digs. **Stoll** tops the team with 663 digs and also has 32 aces to rank fourth. **Kari Kuhn** is third with 428 digs and second with 41 aces. Freshman MH **Betsy Gilbert** is fourth in blocks with 31.
