Yellow Jackets Host Conference Rival Mount Union; B-W will host Wilmington on Saturday as part of Homecoming Weekend



BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team hosts Ohio Athletic Conference rival Mount Union College tonight at the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's game with a 14-7 overall record and 2-0 in the OAC. Earlier last week, B-W defeated Otterbein College, 3-0, to remain undefeated in conference play. This past weekend, B-W competed at the Mount St. Joseph Tournament and finished with a 1-3 record. On Friday at MSJ, B-W lost to Capital, 3-0, and MSJ, 3-0. On Saturday, B-W beat Franklin (Ind.), 3-0, but lost to Dubuque (Iowa), 3-2.

Against Otterbein, freshman **Kelsey Hills** led the offense with 11 kills and tied junior **Emily Albanese** for the most blocks with three each. Freshman setter **Nicole Igarashi** had 30 assists and sophomore libero **Kim Stoll** topped the defense with 24 digs.

At Mount St. Joseph, senior middle hitter **Laura Leach** led the offense with 66 kills and 12 blocks. **Igarashi**, who played in three of four matches, had 106 set assists and **Kim Stoll**, who also played in three of four matches, had the most digs with 80.

369 kills (4.86/game) and has the most blocks with 47. In addition, **Leach** tops the team in hitting at .341 and has 113 digs, 20 service aces and seven assists. **Kelsey Hills** is second with 223 kills, is hitting .253 and has 34 blocks and 71 digs. **Emily Albanese** is first on the team with 40 aces, third with 33 set assists, 347 digs and a .235 hitting percentage and third with 29 blocks and 207 kills. Freshman outside hitter **Meggie Marten** is fourth on the squad with 125 kills. She also has 229 digs, 28 aces and 13 blocks. **Nicole Igarashi** tops the team with 826 assists (11.32/game), is fifth with 240 digs and fifth with 24 aces. **Kim Stoll** tops the team with 517 digs and also has 28 aces to tie **Marten** for third. **Kari Kuhn** is third with 339 digs and second with 36 aces.

The Yellow Jackets will end a short two-game home stand this Saturday, Oct. 9 against Wilmington College as part of Homecoming weekend. B-W will then travel to University Heights to face Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll on Oct. 12.
