## Yellow Jackets Host Wilmington Today for Homecoming; B-W Travels to Cleveland Cross-Town Rival John Carroll on Tuesday

**BEREA, OHIO --** The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team hosts Ohio Athletic Conference rival Wilmington College today on Homecoming Saturday at the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium.

The Yellow Jackets enter today's game with a 15-7 overall record and 3-0 in the OAC. Earlier this week, B-W defeated Mount Union College, 3-0, to remain undefeated in conference play.

Senior **Laura Leach** led the way with 13 kills. She also had six total blocks (five solo, one assist). In addition, junior **Emily Albanese** was second on the team with 11 kills, followed by freshman **Kelsey Hills** with 10. Freshman setter **Nicole Igarashi** set up the offense and recorded 37 set assists.

Defensively, **Albanese** led the team with 29 digs followed by sophomore libero **Kim Stoll** who added 27. **Igarashi** rounded out the top three with 20 digs of her own.

After 22 matches, **Leach** leads the offense with 382 kills (4.84/game) and has the most blocks with 53. In addition, **Leach** tops the team in hitting at .336 and has 118 digs, 20 service aces and seven assists. **Hills** is second with 233 kills, is hitting .249 and has 36 blocks and 76 digs. **Albanese** is first on the team with 40 aces, third with 34 set assists, second in digs with 376 digs and a .244 hitting percentage and third with
