Four Yellow Jackets Receive Multiple Postseason Accolades

BEREA, OHIO -- Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball players, freshman outside hitter **Rachel Selgo**, junior setter **Angie Camp**, sophomore outside hitter **Kelsey Hills** and senior right-side player **Emily Albanese**, have earned multiple postseason awards from the Ohio Athletic Conference and the American Volleyball Coaches Association.

In the voting by the coaches, **Selgo**, **Hills** and **Camp** were all named to the 2005 All-OAC teams. **Selgo** and **Hills** earned second-team, All-OAC honors and **Camp** was a first-team, All-OAC selection. This was the first selection to the All-OAC team for **Selgo** and **Camp**. **Hills** earned All-Conference accolades for the second time in her career, having earned honorable mention honors as a freshman. In addition to being named All-OAC, **Selgo** was also named OAC *Freshman of the Year*.

Albanese and **Hills** were named Academic All-OAC. This is the first selection to the Academic All-OAC team for both players.

The AVCA recognized **Selgo** and **Camp** for their individual performances this season. **Selgo** was named honorable mention, All-Great Lakes Region and was the All-Great Lakes Region *Freshman of the Year*. **Camp** earned honorable mention AVCA, All-American honors and was a first-team, All-Great Lakes Region pick.

Yellow Jacket Volleyball Team Completes Another Successful Season in 2005

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team completed its season Saturday (Nov. 5) when it placed second at the 2005 Ohio Athletic Conference Tournament held on the campus of Ohio Northern University.

B-W completed the season with a 22-12 overall record and did so with a very young team. The Yellow Jackets finished in a three-way tie for second with Capital University and Otterbein College in the 2005 OAC regular-season title chase. B-W earned the second seed ahead of Capital and Otterbein by virtue of a tie-breaker. The Yellow Jackets defeated both the Crusaders and Cardinals earlier in the regular season to claim the season series and the number-two spot in the tournament. In addition, the Jackets made it to the OAC Final Four for the ninth straight time and were tournament runners-up for the third consecutive season.

Emily Albanese was the lone Yellow Jacket senior and was a key contributor to B-W's success this season. **Albanese** served as a team captain and provided much needed leadership for the younger players. **Albanese** led the team in service aces with 57 and moved into a tie for fourth all-time in school history for most service aces in a career with 140. She also ranks fifth in career digs (1,385), seventh in solo blocks (80) and tenth in career kills (891).

This year, B-W continued the tradition of playing some of the top competition in Division III. The Yellow Jackets faced six teams ranked in the AVCA (American Volleyball Coaches Association) Top-25 including OAC-rivals Ohio Northern and Capital.

"I am so proud of this team," said Brault, now 297-190 in her career and 227-140 in 11 years at B-W. "Our women played their hearts out and let it all out on the court. We gave it a great run and played our best volleyball toward the end of the season."

"Vicki has built our volleyball program into one of the best in the Ohio Athletic Conference and region," said B-W Athletic Director Steve Bankson, who oversees Brault and the volleyball program. "She is a hard worker and very detail oriented."

Coach Brault and the entire Yellow Jacket team never lost focus during the season while getting to the OAC Tournament.

"We had a very good season when you consider the type of competition that we played," continued Brault. "We did not shy away from anyone. Our players can walk away from the court with their heads held high. They have made a great contribution to B-W and its volleyball program."

In 34 matches, B-W's freshman outside hitter **Rachel Selgo** led the team in kills with 413 (3.33 per game) and finished second in defensive digs with 488. Sophomore All-OAC and outside hitter **Kelsey Hills** was second on the team in kills with 395 (3.19 per game). **Albanese** finished the season third in kills with 272 (2.19 per game), third in digs with 451 and recorded a team-leading 57 service aces. Junior setter **Angie Camp** had a team-high 1,395 set assists (11.25 per game) and was third in total blocks with 96 (28 solo and 68 assists). Freshman middle hitter **Maria DePeters** led the team in total blocks with 133 (35 solo and 98 assists) and had the second highest num-

Sophomore libero **Meggie Marten** had a team-leading 733, averaging 5.91 per game. She was third on the team in service aces with 46. Her 733 digs rank third all-time in B-W history in a single season.
