Yellow Jackets Host Rival John Carroll Tonight B-W Looks for a Win Tonight to Stay Atop the OAC Standings

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team hosts Ohio Athletic Conference and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University tonight in the Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's match with a 13-7 overall record and 2-0 OAC record and trail Capital (3-0 OAC) by half a game for the lead in the conference standings. The Yellow Jackets enter this game after posting a 2-2 record at the Washington (Mo.) University Invitational in St. Louis with a pair of three-set wins against Fontbonne (Mo.) and Westminster (Mo.). John Carroll has a 7-16 overall record and a 1-2 conference record following a 3-1 loss to Muskingum.

After 20 matches, B-W's freshman outside hitter Rachel Selgo leads the team in kills with 232 (3.18 per game) and is second in defensive digs with 273. Sophomore All-OAC and outside hitter Kelsey Hills is second on the team in kills with 209 (2.86 per game). Senior All-OAC right-side player Emily Albanese is third in kills with 157 (2.15 per game) and leads the team in service aces with 34 and third in digs with 271. Junior setter Angie Camp has a team-high 804 set assists (11.01 per game) and is third in total blocks with 49 (12 solo and 37 assists). Freshman middle hitter Maria DePeters leads
