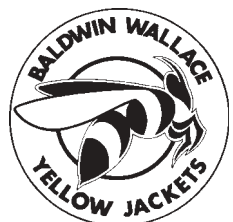

## Yellow Jackets Host Rival Hiram Tonight; B-W hosts Annual Marcia French Tournament this Weekend

**BEREA, OHIO --** The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team hosts traditional rival Hiram College tonight at the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's game with a 3-1 record following a strong performance at the Boxer Kickoff Invitational Tournament hosted by Pacific (Ore.) University in Forest Grove, Ore. On Friday, the Yellow Jackets won a pair of matches defeating Williamette (Ore.) College, 3-0 and also beating Gustavus Adolphus (Minn.) College, 3-1. On the final day, B-W split its matches, opening with a loss to Linfield (Ore.) College, 3-2, but rallying to defeat host school Pacific (Ore.) University in straight sets, 3-0.

After four matches, **Rachel Selgo** leads the offense with 44 kills (2.93/ game) and is third in digs with 54. **Kelsey Hills** is second with 42 kills and is hitting .210 overall. She also is tied for the team lead in solo blocks with four. **Emily Albanese** is third with 36 kills, is hitting .120 with nine blocks, is second with 66 digs and is tied for the team lead in service aces with seven. **Maria DePeters** is fourth with 34 kills. She also has a team-leading 17 blocks including four solo blocks and seven service aces. **Angie Camp** tops the team with 150 assists (10.00/ game), is fourth with 52 digs and tied for second with

**B-W Picked to Finish Third in OAC Preseason Poll --** The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team has been picked to finish third in this season's OAC preseason poll as selected by the coaches. In 2004, the Yellow Jackets made their second straight appearance in the OAC Tournament Championship game. Ohio Northern and Capital were tied to finish first with ONU receiving six first place votes and Capital receiving four.
