## Yellow Jackets Host Rival Otterbein Tonight; B-W Opens Ohio Athletic Conference Play Against the Cardinals

**BEREA, OHIO --** The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team hosts Ohio Athletic Conference rival Otterbein College in the conference opener for both teams tonight at Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's match with a 7-3 overall record and have not played since September 14 when they defeated Cleveland cross-town rival Case University, 3-1. Otterbein has a 5-8 overall record and are coming off a 3-2 victory against Ohio Dominican last Friday.

B-W has won its last two matches including a 3-0 win against Mount Union in the championship game of the annual Marcia French Memorial Tournament on Sept. 10.

After 10 matches, freshman Rachel Selgo leads the team in kills with 110 and is averaging 2.97 kills per game. She is also third in defensive digs with 133 and has 17 total blocks (three solo, 14 assists). Sophomore Kelsey Hills is second on the team in kills with 102. Defensively, Hills has eight solo blocks and 17 assists. Freshman Maria DePeters is third with 92 kills and has a .217 attack percentage. She also has a team-leading 14 service aces. Senior Emily Albanese is fourth in kills with 85 and is second in digs with 152 for a 4.11 digs per game average. Junior Angie Camp has accumulated a team-
