## Yellow Jackets Continued Its Climb To The Top of OAC



**BEREA, OHIO --** The 2011 Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team continued its climb to become one of the top teams in the Ohio Athletic Conference.

The Yellow Jackets finished the season with a record of 18-13 overall and 5-4 in the OAC, which was good for fourth place. The fourth place was the best season finish in the OAC since the 2007 season when B-W also finished fourth. The Yellow Jackets also advanced to the semifinals of the OAC Tournament for the first time since the 2005 season.

"I am very pleased with the progress and success of this team," said Head Coach Vicki Brault. "Our goal for next season and for future seasons is to win the OAC and compete in the NCAA Division III Tournament."

Offensively, **Amanda Sawicki** led the team and was second in the OAC with 377 kills. She was also second on the squad with a .256 hitting percentage and was third on the team with 34 total blocks. **Rachel Switalski** led the squad with a .265 hitting percentage and was second with 43 total blocks and 256 kills. In addition, she was third on the team with 33 service aces. **Shannon Deleur** finished third on the team with 131 kills and was third with 28 service aces. **Nicole Christner** led the team with 47 total blocks and had 110 kills to finish fourth on the team. **Taylor Burns** recorded 38 kills and led the team with 54 service aces.

**Jessica Stitts** paced the offense and was fifth in the OAC with 877 set assists. She finished second on the team with 35 service aces and had 83 kills. **Katie Primeau** also saw action at setter and totaled 163 assists and 13 kills.

Defensively, **Natalie Emmons** led the team with 590 digs and was fourth in the OAC. **Shannon Deleur** was second with 391 digs and **Taylor Burns** was third with 351. Stitts was fourth with 284 and **Amanda Mass** had career-best 206 digs to finish fifth on the team.

This season, the Yellow Jackets fielded a junior varsity team that posted an impressive 6-1 record. Setters **Emily Nagle**, **Sarah Waiwood** and **Katie Primeau** ran the offense. Dominating the middle were hitters **Colleen Bonacci**, **Kayla Harris** and **Nicole Christner**. Rounding things out were outside hitters **Kayse Schmucker** and **Danielle Torrence**, along with right side hitters **Alayna Chlad** and **Markema Winters**. Anchoring the defense was libero **Paige Pileski**.

"The experience and success these student-athletes achieved this fall with the J.V. team will play a major role on our contention for future OAC titles," commented Coach Brault.

With the success of this year's team, the future looks bright for the Yellow Jackets with a good core returning for next season.

### Four Yellow Jackets Receive Postseason Conference Honors



**BEREA, OHIO --** Four Baldwin-Wallace volleyball student-athletes have been selected as recipients of Ohio Athletic Conference postseason accolades.

Senior **Chelsea Nissen**, juniors **Amanda Sawicki** and **Rachel Switalski** and sophomore **Colleen Bonacci** have been selected to represent the Yellow Jackets on this season's All-OAC and Academic All-OAC teams.

**Nissen** earned her second Academic All-OAC accolade this fall after being selected as honorable mention in 2010. **Nissen** ends her Yellow Jacket career with 639 kills, 778 digs and 87 blocks. She also excels academically with a 3.71 grade point average in biology, is a member of the Chi Alpha Sigma and Alpha Lambda honor societies and is a Jacket Scholar.

**Sawicki** was selected second-team All-OAC. She was an honorable mention All-OAC pick as a freshman at Marietta.

**Switalski** was the lone Yellow Jacket to earn both All-OAC and Academic All-OAC honors. She earned her second straight honorable mention All-OAC accolade and her first Academic All-OAC award. In three seasons, she has tallied 600 kills, 313 digs, 95 blocks, 72 service aces, 28 set assists and has a .216 career hitting percentage. **Switalski** excels academically with a 3.636 grade point average in business administration and marketing and is a member of the Chi Alpha Sigma and Alpha Lambda honor societies and is a Jacket Scholar.

**Bonacci**, who carries a 3.92 grade point average in sports medicine and exercise major, earned her first Academic All-OAC honor after being tabbed to the honorable mention squad. In two seasons, she has tallied 327 kills, 49 digs, 73 blocks and has a .200 career hitting percentage.
