B-W Again Has Excellent Tournament Success

BEREA, OHIO -- The Yellow Jackets captured the National Invitational Tournament at Wittenberg last weekend with a 4-0 record. Enroute to the tourney title, B-W beat 12th-ranked and host Wittenberg and 23rd-ranked Nazareth (N.Y.) for the second time this season. For their efforts, juniors **Cassie Palmer** and **Emily Bowen** were named to the all-tournament team.



The 18th-Ranked Yellow Jackets Host Heidelberg Tonight in Another Key Ohio Athletic Conference Match at Ursprung

BEREA, OHIO -- The 18th-ranked Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team will put its 21-4 overall and 3-1 Ohio Athletic Conference record on the line tonight when it faces OAC rival Heidelberg College in the Ursprung Gymnasium.

The 2002 season has been another success story for the Yellow Jacket volleyball program. Under the direction of veteran Head Coach Vicki Brault, the B-W spikers are regarded as one of the best teams in the OAC, Great Lakes Region and in all of Division III.

Last week, B-W had a 5-0 record as it beat OAC rival Mount Union College in Berea, 3-0, on Tuesday and then traveled to Springfield and won the National Invitational Tournament sponsored by Wittenberg University. At Wittenberg, B-W beat Rochester (N.Y.) Institute of Technology, 3-0, 12th-ranked Wittenberg, 3-1, Thomas More (Ky.) College, 3-0, and 23rd-ranked Nazareth (N.Y.), 3-2. The wins again both Wittenberg and Nazareth gives the Yellow Jackets a 3-4 record this year against Top 25-ranked teams and a 3-1 mark versus those same teams in their last four matches.

Who are the stars for B-W? There are many.

Let's start with the front row play of seniors **Sarah Gordon** and **Lauren Harris**, juniors **Cassie Palmer** and **Emily Bowen** and sophomore **Laura Leach**. All five have been outstanding and have the Yellow Jackets ranked nationally in terms of blocks.

Palmer, Gordon and **Bowen** are three of the top offensive players in the OAC. **Palmer** is a two-time All-OAC player and was the OAC "Rookie of the Year" two seasons ago. They are all set up by All-OAC setter, junior **Kerry Helm**. **Helm** recently became just the fourth player in school history to pass the 2,000-assist plateau.

On defense, senior libero **Kate Kost** is B-W's all-time and seasonal leader in terms of defensive digs. She may very well be one of the best in Division III this year. But again, the help is multiple. Add **Gordon, Bowen, Helm** and freshman **Emily Albanese** to the group.

Overall, B-W enters the final three weeks of its regular season playing its best volleyball of the season. Oh yeah, we better not forget **Head Coach Vicki Brault**, who has done a marvelous job of coaching these young women.
