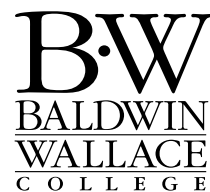

Yellow Jackets Host Otterbein on Saturday

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's volleyball team will next play on Saturday, September 21 when it hosts Ohio Athletic Conference rival Otterbein College at 1:00 p.m. It is the OAC opener for both schools.

Last year, the Yellow Jackets easily defeated Otterbein, 30-19, 30-20 and 30-23 during the regular season on October 13. B-W then defeated the Cardinals, 30-19, 30-28 and 30-26 in the quarterfinals of the 2001 OAC Tournament. Both matches were here in the Ursprung Gymnasium.

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team hosts non-conference rival Case Western Reserve University tonight at the Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea. The Yellow Jackets enter the match with a 10-2 overall record.

The Yellow Jackets ran their winning streak to nine straight matches as they captured the tournament championship last Friday-Saturday in the Case Western Reserve University bracket of the CWRU/ John Carroll University Tournament in University Circle. On Friday, B-W defeated Grove City (Pa.) College, 3-0, and host CWRU, 3-0. On Saturday, the Yellow Jackets completed the sweep as they beat Kenyon College, 3-0, and Denison University, 3-0.

Leading the Yellow Jacket attack at CWRU was junior right side player **Emily Bowen** with a team-high 46 kills. She was followed by junior two-time All-Ohio Athletic Conference middle hitter **Cassie Palmer** with 44 and senior Academic All-OAC outside hitter **Sarah Gordon** with 41. Palmer had the top hitting percentage at .432. Sophomore outside hitter
