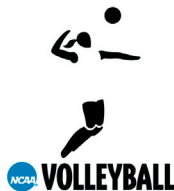

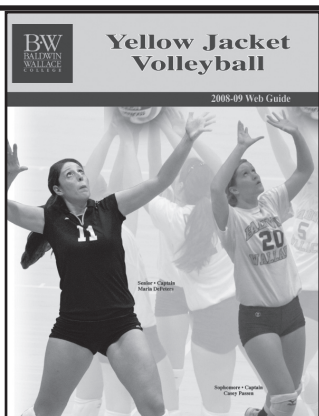

Yellow Jackets Host Heidelberg in an OAC Showdown Tonight;

B-W Travels to Marietta This Weekend

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team hosts OAC opponent Heidelberg College tonight in Ursprung Gymnasium in the Lou Higgins Center in Berea.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's match with a 9-15 overall record and an 0-4 mark in the OAC. The Student Princes stand at 21-4 and 5-1 in the conference.

This past weekend, the Yellow Jackets competed at the Washington (Mo.) University Tournament in St. Louis, Missouri. B-W posted a 1-3 mark over four contests that included a come from behind victory over Endicott (Mass.). Senior middle-hitter **Maria DePeters** (Buffalo, N.Y./Mt. St. Mary Academy) led the Yellow Jackets on day one of the tournament with a combined 30 kills and three solo blocks versus 23rd-ranked Christopher Newport (Va.) and Illinois Wesleyan. Junior setter **Kayli Tyson** (Olmsted Township/Olmsted Falls) totaled 38 set assists and junior libero **Lissy Grame** (Berea) paced the Yellow Jacket defense with a combined 23 digs.

On day two of the tournament, freshman outside-hitter **Nicole Shoen** (Bellevue) totaled a team-high 12 kills in B-W's victory over Endicott (Mass.) and Tyson picked up 19 set assists. **Grame** was once again the leader on defense with 15 digs. **DePeters** picked up another 12 kills against Williams (Mass.) in game two while **Grame** racked up 18 digs

and **Tyson** and sophomore setter **Casey Passen** (Ashville/Teays Valley) each recorded 16 assists.

For the year, **DePeters** has a team-high 298 kills with **Schoen** not far behind at 248. **Passen** has 573 assists and is already sixth on the B-W all-time list with 1,935 for her career. Defensively, **Grame** leads the squad with 212 digs and **Nissen** has 170. **DePeters** has totaled 48 solo blocks.

Coming Up for the Jackets...

This Saturday, B-W will travel to Marietta to play the Pioneers at 1:00 p.m. The Yellow Jackets will close out the regular season next week with a pair of home games versus Otterbein and Muskingum. The Jackets entertain Otterbein at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 21 and Muskingum at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 25.
