Two Yellow Jackets Receive Multiple Postseason Accolades

BEREA, OHIO -- Two Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball players, senior setter **Angie Camp** and junior outside hitter **Kelsey Hills**, each earned postseason awards from the Ohio Athletic Conference and the American Volleyball Coaches Association for their efforts both on and off the court.

In the voting by the coaches, **Camp** and **Hills** were named to the 2006 All-OAC teams. **Camp** earned first-team All-OAC honor and **Hills** was a second-team All-OAC selection. This was the second selection to the All-OAC first-team for **Camp**. **Hills** earned All-Conference accolades for the third time in her career, having earned honorable mention honors as a freshman and second-team selection as a sophomore. In addition to being named All-OAC, **Camp** was also named the OAC Sheila Wallace-Kovalchick *Player of the Year*.

Hills, an accounting major, was named Academic All-OAC. This is the second selection to the Academic All-OAC team for her.

The AVCA recognized **Camp** for her individual performance this season. She earned honorable mention AVCA, All-American honors for the second straight year and was a first-team All-Great Lakes Region pick.

Yellow Jacket Volleyball Team Completes Another Successful Season in 2006

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team completed its season on Tuesday, October 31 in the 2006 Ohio Athletic Conference Tournament at the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in the Lou Higgins Center in Berea.

B-W completed the season with a 26-7 overall record and did so with a fairly young team. The Yellow Jackets, 8-1 in the OAC finished as the co-champions of the OAC regular season with Ohio Northern University. By virtue of a 3-2 win in the two teams' regular season match, Ohio Northern earned the No. 1 seed in the conference tournament and B-W received the No. 2 seed.

Angie Camp was the lone Yellow Jacket senior was a key contributor to B-W's success this season. **Camp** served as a team captain and provided leadership for the younger student-athletes. **Camp** led the team in hitting at .286 and set-assists with 1,176 (10.23 per game) and was third on the team in digs with 362. Her 2,571 career assists and 10.76 career assists per game each ranks third all-time in school history.

This year, B-W continued the tradition of playing some of the top competition in Division III. The Yellow Jackets faced seven opponents (University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, College of Mount St. Joseph, Wittenberg University, Ohio Northern, Washington (Mo.) University and Calvin (Mich.) College) that were ranked in the AVCA (American Volleyball Coaches Association) Top-25 when they played each other. B-W picked up a win over No. 20 Mount St. Joseph and No. 21 Ohio Northern on the same day to win the College of Mount St. Joseph Classic. Other highlights of the season included being ranked as high as 19th in the AVCA and winning the Ninth Annual Marcia French Tournament at B-W.

"I am so proud of this team," said Head Coach Vicki Brault, now 323-197 in her career and 253-147 in 12 years at B-W. "Our women played their hearts out and left it all out on the court."

"Vicki has built our volleyball program into one of the best in the Ohio Athletic Conference and region," said B-W Athletic Director Steve Bankson, who oversees Brault and the volleyball program. "She is a hard worker and very detailed oriented."

Coach Brault and the entire Yellow Jacket team never lost focus during the season while earning an OAC regular season co-championship.

"We had a very good season when you consider the type of competition that we played," continued Brault. "We did not shy away from anyone. Our players can walk away from the court with their heads held high. They have made a great contribution to B-W and its volleyball program."

In 33 matches, B-W's junior All-OAC outside hitter **Kelsey Hills** led the team in kills with 378 (3.29 per game) and finished second in defensive digs with 454. Sophomore middle hitter **Maria DePeters** was second on the team in kills with 311 (2.73 per game), service aces with 45 and total blocks with 119 (33 solo and 86 assists). Junior libero **Meggie Marten** had a team-high 49 service aces and 679 digs. Sophomore outside hitter **Rachel Selgo** was third on the team in kills with 303 and ranked fourth in digs with 329.
