Yellow Jackets Host Case Tonight in the 2006 Home Opener;

B-W Opens Ohio Athletic Conference plays this Saturday versus Muskingum

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College volleyball team hosts Greater Cleveland cross-town and nonleague rival Case tonight at Ursprung Gymnasium of the Lou Higgins Center in Berea.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's match with a 7-1 overall record and seven straight victories.

Last weekend, B-W won all four of its matches as it captured the championship at the Ninth Annual Marcia French Memorial Tournament, including beating St. Mary's (Ind.), 3-1, in the championship match. The only loss this season was to seventh-ranked and defending NCAA Division III National Champion the University of Wisconsin Whitewater.

In addition to beating St. Mary's in the championship match, B-W defeated Kalamazoo (Mich.), Allegheny (Pa.) and Ohio Athletic Conference rival Heidelberg College all by 3-0 scores in pool play.

Leading the way at the Marcia French tourney were three all-tournament team selections. They were senior All-American setter Angie Camp, junior two-time All-OAC outside hitter Kelsey Hills and junior two-year starting libero Meggie Marten.

Tonight, look for Camp, Hills and Marten to start along with sophomore All-OAC outside hitter Rachel Selgo, sophomore middle hitters Maria DePeters and Brooke Hinkle and sophomore rightside player Betsy Gilbert. Also seeing action are junior rightside player Jenny Cawrse and freshmen defensive specialists Kenzie Martin and Vicky Benedejcic.

After eight matches, Selgo tops the team with 73 kills and a .280 hitting percentage. Hills is second with 72 kills, 88 defensive digs, 24 blocks and is third in hitting at .239. DePeters is third in kills with 70 and blocks with 23 and second in hitting at .273. Hinkle is fourth with 53 kills and first with 25 blocks. Camp sets the offense and is first with 270 set assists (10.4 per game), second with eight service aces, third with 61 digs and fourth with 13 blocks. Marten is first with 175 digs (6.73/ game) and 11 aces.

Off the bench, juniors Jenny Cawrse and Betsy Gilbert have contributed on the front row 11 and 13 kills, respectively. Cawrse also has eight blocks. Martin and Benedejcic have helped in the back row and have 41 and 59 digs, respectively.

Following tonight's match, B-W will remain at home and play a key Ohio Athletic Conference opener this Saturday, Sept. 16 against Muskingum College at 1:00 p.m.
