



## Three Yellow Jacket Seniors to Play Their Last Regular Season Home Match

**BEREA, OHIO** -- The Baldwin-Wallace College athletic department would like to recognize our three senior volleyball players that will play in their final regular season home match tonight, middle hitter Betsy Gilbert, outside hitter Kelsey Hills and libero Meggie Marten. These three ladies have helped win a share of the Ohio Athletic Conference regular season title during the 2006-2007 campaign and enter tonight's match with a 86-43 record over the last four season.



**Betsy Gilbert** is playing in her fourth season of volleyball for the Yellow Jackets. Gilbert has been a solid player for the Yellow Jackets since she started playing her freshman year. She has provided leadership throughout her four year career both on and off the court and has been a valuable member of the Baldwin-Wallace community. As a freshman, Gilbert earned her first varsity letter playing in 122 games as a middle hitter and recored 92 kills, 62 digs and was fourth on the team in blocks with 38 (21 solo and 17assists). As a sophomore , Betsy earned her second letter and named "Most Inspirational" after playing in 44 games, tallying 36 kills, 28 blcoks and 12 digs. As a junior, she played in 96 games as she recorded 80 kills, 72 digs, 36 blocks and 38 set assists, which was good for second highest on the team. Through 27 games this season, Gilbert is fourth on the team with 153 kills, has 52 blocks and 16 digs. For her career she has played in 360 games and has recorded 361 kills, 154 blocks and 162 digs

**Kelsey Hills** is playing in her fourth sesaon of volleyball for B-W in 2007. As a freshman Hills made an immediate impact playing in 122 games as an outside hitter. She was second on the team with 384 kills, third in hitting percentage (.261), second in blocks with 57 and had 131 digs while earning honorable mention All-OAC honors and being named OAC "Co-Freshman of the Year," the team "Rookie of the Year" and all-tournament at the B-W Marcia French Memorial Tournament. As a sophomore, she was named to th all-tournament team at the B-W Marcia French Memorial Tournament and the Wittenberg University Tournament while being named the OAC Player of the Week after the Wittenberg Tournament. Hills was also named the team's Co-Most Valuable Player during her sophomore season. Kelsey was named second team All-OAC, third team All-Great Lakes Region and Academic All-OAC choice after recording 365 kills, 300 digs and 72 blocks during her sophomore year. As a junior, Hills recorded 378 kills, 454 digs and 72 blocks and was named to the College of Mount St. Joseph and B-W Marcia French Memorial Tournament all-tournament teams and was a second team All-OAC and Academic All-OAC selection. Through

**Meggie Marten** is playing her fourth season of volleyball as a Yellow Jacket. As a freshman, Marten won the team's Coach's Award played in 122 games and was fourth on the team in kills with 182, third in service aces with 42 and fourth in digs with 402. As a sophomore, Meggie played in 124 games posting 20 kills and 733 digs while earning her second varsity letter. During her junior season, she played in 112 games and recored 32 service aces and 244 digs while being named the team's Most Improved Player and named to the B-W Marcia French Memorial Tournament all-tournament team. Through 27 matches this season, Meggie is first on the team with 565 digs and in service aces with 53 and was named to the all-tournament team at the B-W Marcia French Memorial Tournament. For her career Marten has played in 461 games and has recorded 2,379 digs and 190 service aces.

Meggie, a physical education major, is joined tonight by her parents Dennis and Kay Marten of Bowling Green, Ohio.
