FACILITIES

LOU HIGGINS CENTER: The newly renovated Lou Higgins Center is the centerpiece of the B-W athletic facilities. The 170,000 square-foot complex houses the Ursprung Gymnasium, Harrison Dillard Track, Natatorium, updated workout spaces, a state-of-the-art athletic training facility, classroom space, and offices for coaches and faculty.

RUDOLPH URSPRUNG GYMNASIUM: This facility is home to the Yellow Jackets basketball, volleyball and wrestling teams. The completely renovated gymnasium has housed B-W basketball since 1949.

THE HARRISON DILLARD TRACK: Along three multi-purpose courts are home to the B-W indoor track teams, the John Summa Invitational Wrestling Tournament, the Ohio Sports Festival (basketball and wrestling venues) and local high school track meets.

B-W NATATORIUM: Home to the Yellow Jacket swimming and diving teams. The facility includes a 25-yard, six-lane pool with a one-meter diving board. The movable pool bottom has adaptive physical therapy applications and can be used by the handicapped.

THE GEORGE FINNIE STADIUM: Finnie Stadium and Tressel Field is one of the nation's best small college stadiums for football, soccer, and track and field.

HERITAGE FIELD: The field is located on the campus within walking distance of the student's residence halls. The facility has a manicured playing surface and seating for approximately 200 fans. Heritage Field has been the host site for four OAC Baseball Tournaments and is home to the Yellow Jacket baseball squad.

THE "POP" COLLINS: Tennis Complex is named in honor of former B-W tennis coach and teacher Arthur Worth Collins, the father of nationally-renowned sports-writer and television tennis analyst, Arthur "Bud" Collins '51. The facility is on campus and includes six courts which are lighted for night play.

CUYAHOGA COUNTY FAIR GROUNDS SOFTBALL FIELD: Is located off campus and is the home to the Yellow Jacket softball team.
