

Yellow Jacket Winter Sports Report

Men's Basketball

The Yellow Jacket men's basketball team was 4-4 overall and 2-2 in the Ohio Athletic Conference prior to playing at Wilmington College on December 22. Through eight games this season, B-W was led by sophomore point guard **Promis Cabbil (Elyria/ Senior)** at 13.8 points and 4.8 assists per game. Senior forward **Kyle Brown (Strongsville)** was second in scoring at 12.6 ppg. and junior guard **Zane Meeder (Erie, Pa./ Fairview)** was third at 10.4 ppg. The Jackets also played in the Thomas More (Ky.) College Coach Connor Classic on Sunday and Monday, December 27-28 in Crestview Hills, Kentucky. The team is back in action this Sunday, January 3 at Alma (Mich.) College in Alma, Michigan at 2:00 p.m. Fans can listen to the game **LIVE** on campus radio station WBWC (88.3 FM) or via the Web at www.wbwc.com.

Swimming and Diving

The swimming and diving teams next compete in Florida in early January during their annual Florida Winter Break Training in Cocoa Beach from Dec. 30 through Jan. 10. To date, the men are 3-5 overall and are led by junior four-time NCAA Division III All-American diver **Todd Richert (North Royalton)** and senior multiple All-OAC competitor **Vince Colwell (Parma/ Normandy)**. The women are 0-8 overall.

Last weekend at the Fredonia State (N.Y.) Invitational, the B-W men placed second of 10 schools while the women were seventh. **Richert** highlighted the meet by setting a meet and pool record in the one-meter diving event and qualified for his third straight trip to the NCAA Division III national meet in March.

The next home meet is Jan. 23 versus Ohio Northern University in the B-W Natatorium in the Lou Higgins Center at 1:00 p.m.

Wrestling

The wrestling team, 2-5 overall, is idle until Jan. 5 when it hosts OAC foe Wilmington College in its OAC dual match opener at 7:30 p.m. in the Ursprung Gymnasium. In addition on Jan. 7, B-W hosts perennial Division III power Central College of Iowa in a 1:00 p.m. matinee in Berea.

B-W last competed on Saturday, Dec. 5, at the annual Rochester (N.Y.) Institute of Technology Tournament and placed seventh of 10 schools. Leading the way for the Jackets was sophomore 197-pounder **Tristan Stoll (Milan/ Edison)** who placed third in

his weight class with a 4-1 record.

After four weeks of competition, **Stoll** and junior 174-pound defending OAC champ and 2009 NCAA Division III national qualifier **Andrew Scavuzzo (Cuyahoga Falls/ Woodridge)** top the squad with eight wins each. **Stoll** is 8-1 overall with three pins and **Scavuzzo** is 8-2 with two pins. Junior 133-pounder **Phillip Payne (Orange Village/ Orange)** leads the team in takedowns with 14, and freshman 133-pounder **Danny Huffman (Maple Heights)** leads the way with four pins.

Yellow Jacket Chatter

*** On Dec. 5, 2009, Yellow Jacket **Head Coach Cheri Harrer** won her 400th career game at the College and became just the third women's coach in Ohio Athletic Conference history to achieve that feat.

*** **Harrer** enters the Holiday Invitational Tournament with 401 career wins, is 401-141 for her career and stands two wins shy of second place on the all-time OAC win list.

*** Thirteen of the last 14 B-W teams have won 20 or more games in a season. The only season it didn't happen, the Jackets won 19 contests.

*** Eleven of the past 14 seasons, **Cheri Harrer's** team has participated in the NCAA Division III National Tournament, including advancing to the second round the past two seasons.

*** Three times since the 1999-2000 season, the Yellow Jackets have advanced to the "Elite Eight" of the NCAA tourney.

*** Senior All-OAC and two-time **ESPN THE MAGAZINE** Academic All-District IV center **Ariel Brough** owns the school career-record with 192 blocked shots and ranks ninth all-time with 539 rebounds.

Welcome to the 2009 Baldwin-Wallace College Invitational Tournament on December 29-30 in Berea, Ohio

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team hosts Manchester College of Indiana, Albion College of Michigan and Loras College of Iowa in the 2009 B-W Invitational Tournament. In the first round on December 29, host B-W plays Manchester and Albion plays Loras. The consolation and championship games are on Dec. 30 at 2:00 and 4:00 p.m., respectively.

The Yellow Jackets enter the tourney at 5-4 overall and last played on December 21 when they lost to perennial NCAA Division III national power DePauw (Ind.) University, 69-42, in Berea. Through nine games this season, B-W is scoring 65.2 points per game and allowing 63.3 ppg. to its opponents. The Jackets shot 40.1 percent from the field, 32.7% from three-point range and 77.0% from the free throw line. B-W out-rebounds its opponents by a +2.6 margin and has a -1.9 turnover differential. Junior All-Ohio Athletic Conference guard **Amanda Schroeder** leads the team in scoring at 14.8 ppg. Freshman guard **Olivia French** is second on the squad in scoring at 9.7 ppg. and senior center **Ariel Brough** is third at 8.2 ppg. **Brough** also is the team's top rebounder at 7.2 rebounds per game.

The Manchester College Spartans of the Heartland Athletic Conference enter the tournament with an overall mark of 1-9. Manchester last played on Saturday, Dec. 19 and lost 55-41 to St. Mary's (Ind.) College despite a game-high 10 points and eight rebounds from **Kailey Honn**. Through 10 games this season, the Spartans are averaging 51.7 ppg. and allowing 62.1 ppg. to their opponents. The Spartans shoot 38.9% from the field, 30.7% from three-point range and 62.6% from the free throw line. Manchester out-rebounds its opponents by a +0.7 margin and has a -8.4 turnover differential. **Honn** leads the Spartans in scoring at 13.7 ppg. **Libby Pattison** is the squad's top rebounder at 6.8 rpg. and is second in scoring at 7.4 ppg. Manchester **Head Coach Josh Dzurick** is in his fifth year as the leader of the Spartan program and 13th overall as a head coach. **Dzurick** has a 76-45 overall record at Manchester and has led the Spartans to three NCAA Tournament appearances in just four seasons. He has twice been named HCAC Coach of the Year.

The Albion College Brittons of the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association enter the tournament at 4-5 overall. Albion last competed on Saturday, Dec. 19 and lost 67-64 to Mount Vernon Nazarene University. Through nine games this season, the Brittons are averaging 54.7 ppg. and allowing 57.3 ppg. to their opponents. Albion shoots 35.7% from the field, 29.5% from three-point range and 69.4% from the free throw line. The Brittons out-rebound their opponents by a +4.5 margin and have a +0.7 turnover differential. Albion is led in scoring by **Melissa Shaw** at 14.7 ppg. and rebounding by **Patricia Rewa** at 6.2 rpg. Albion **Head Coach Doreen Carden** is in her ninth season at the helm of the Britton program and has compiled a fine 153-73 overall mark and a .677 winning percentage. Under **Carden's** tutelage, the Brittons have had eight consecutive winning seasons and made two trips to the NCAA Tournament.

The Loras College Duhawks of the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference enter the tournament at 5-4 overall with four wins in their last six contests. Most recently, the Duhawks defeated North Central (Ill.) College, 92-76, on Saturday, Dec. 12 behind a game-high 24 points and seven rebounds from **Sarah Pillon**. Through nine games this season, Loras is averaging 76.7 ppg. and allowing its opponents to score 67.2 ppg. The Duhawks shoot 45.0% from the field, 36.0% from three-point range and 75.6% from the free throw line. Loras out-rebounds its opponents by a +3.2 margin and has a +0.9 turnover differential. The Duhawks are led in scoring by **Lindsay Bava** at 16.3 ppg. **Pillon** is second in scoring at 13.8 ppg. and rebounding at 5.0 rpg. **Alex Hudson** leads the team in rebounding at 5.6 rpg. and is third in scoring at 9.8 ppg. Loras Head Coach **Justin Heinzen** is in his third season as the leader of the Duhawk program and has an overall record of 38-24. His squads have made two consecutive trips to the IIAC Tournament and finished the 2007-08 season with the seventh best record (23-3) in Division III.

Following Wednesday's title game, a championship trophy will be presented to the winning team and the five-person All Tournament Team and most valuable player will be announced.
