**The Pre-Game Setup --** The Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team will look to get back on the winning track when it hosts Manchester (Ind.) College in the first game of the 2009 B-W Holiday Invitational Tournament in Berea. The winner of this game advances to tomorrow's championship game at 4:00 p.m. versus the winner of tonight's second game featuring Loras College of Iowa and Albion College of Michigan.

The Yellow Jackets enter this game at 5-4 overall and 3-1 in the Ohio Athletic Conference and last played on December 21 against DePauw University and lost to the Tigers, 69-42. B-W has won four of its last six contests overall.

The Spartans enter this game at 1-9 overall and 1-2 in the HCAC and last played on December 19, at St. Mary's College in Notre Dame, Indiana where they lost by a score of 55-41. Manchester has lost three straight.

**Cheri Harrer Wins No. 400 --** Yellow Jacket veteran **Head Coach Cheri Harrer** became just the third women's basketball coach in OAC history to win 400 games when the B-W defeated Kenyon College, 57-44, on December 5 in Gambier. Harrer, now 401-141 overall in 20 seasons in Berea, is just two wins behind former Muskingum University Coach Donna Newberry (403 wins) for second place all-time in the OAC.

Harrer has led B-W to five OAC Tournament and seven OAC regular season titles in the past 11 years. Eleven of her last 14 teams have advanced to the NCAA Division III National Tournament and three times her teams have advanced to the "Elite 8". She also has been named the OAC *Coach of the Year* four times.

**The B-W versus Manchester (Ind.) All-Time Series --** This is the first-ever meeting between the two schools in women's basketball.

**B-W Information and Probable Starters** -- After nine games this season, B-W is scoring 65.2 points-per-game and are allowing 63.3 ppg. for a plus 1.9 ppg. differential. B-W grabs 39.8 rebounds-per-game and allows 37.2 for a plus 2.6 rpg. differential. The Yellow Jackets shoot 40.1 percent (202-of-504) from the field, 32.7% (36-of-110) from three-point range and 77.0% (147-of-191) from the foul line.

The Yellow Jackets have seven returning letterwinners but a young roster with only one senior and two juniors. Look for **Harrer** to play as many as 12 players in her rotation which will be led by 5'11" All-OAC junior guard **Amanda Schroeder (Columbus Grove)** and 6'2" All-OAC senior center **Ariel Brough (Powell/Olentangy Liberty)**. Joining **Schroeder** and **Brough** in the starting lineup are 5'8" sophomore forward **Monica Gustin (Bexley)**, 6'0" sophomore forward **Nancy Coulter (Washington Court House/Miami Trace)** and 5'6" freshman guard **Rachel Rossman (Olmsted Falls)**.

In addition look for **Harrer** to utilize 5'6" junior point guard **Ali Stack (Vermilion/Firelands)**, 5'4" freshman guard **Olivia French (Bucyrus/Colonel Crawford)**, 5'5" freshman guard **JoBeth Roll (Bucyrus/ Senior)**, 5'9" sophomore forward **Katie Heinlen (Bucyrus/ Wynford)**, 5'7" freshman guard **Jessica Carpenter (North Canton/ Hoover)** and 5'11" sophomore forward **Catherine Spisak (Sandusky/ St. Mary Central Catholic)**.

After nine games, **Schroeder** tops the team in scoring at 14.8. ppg and adds 5.3 rpg. She also has made a team-best 11 three pointers. **French** is second at 9.7 ppg., has passed for 18 assists and shoots 47.1% from three point range (eight-of-17). **Brough** scores 8.2 ppg., grabs a team-high 7.2 rpg. and has blocked a team-leading 22 shots. **Carpenter** is fourth at 8.1 ppg. and also has seven treys. **Spisak** scores 6.2 ppg. and is second in rebounding at 7.0 rpg. **Coulter** scores 5.8 ppg. and grabs 4.1 rpg. **Gustin** scores 2.6 ppg. **Stack** scores 2.3 ppg. **Rossman** scores 2.8 ppg.

**In B-W's Last Game versus DePauw (Ind.) on Dec. 21 in Berea -- DePauw -- 69, B-W -- 42:** In B-W's last game on Monday, December 21, the Yellow Jackets fell to non-league foe DePauw College, 69-42, in Ursprung Gynasium. B-W was led by **Amanda Schroeder** with 10 points. The Tigers out-rebounded B-W, 49-22, including 19-4 on the offensive glass and outscored B-W in second chance points, 15-2. The Tigers were led by Katie Aldrich with 17 points off the bench.

**Scouting the Spartans of Manchester College** -- The Spartans score 51.7 ppg. and allow 62.1 ppg. for a minus 10.4 ppg. differential. Manchester grabs 37.4 rpg. and allows its opponents to grab 36.7 rpg. for a plus 0.7 rpg. differential. MC also shoots 38.9 percent from the field (193-of-496 attempts), 30.7% from three-point range (39-of-127) and 62.6% from the foul line (92-of-147).

Look for veteran Head Coach Josh Dzurick to start to start two guards in the backcourt in 5'7" senior Lauren Kalis, and 5'6" freshman Hayley Weagant. Up front, expect to see 6'1" junior Kailey Honn, 5'11" sophomore Laine Mello, and 5'10" junior Kelsey DeMott to start. Honn leads the Spartans at 13.7 ppg., shoots 48.2%, and leads the team with 17 blocks. DeMott scores 6.8 ppg. and has a team-high 14 steals. Kalis averages 5.8 ppg. while adding 2.6 rpg. and 1.6 apg. Mello contributes 5.6 rpg. while scoring 5.1 ppg. Weagant rounds out the starters with 2.1 ppg. and has passed for 15 assists.

Off the bench, look for Dzurick to utilize 5'9" sophomore gaurd Brittani Bush, 5'8" sophomore gaurd Alexandra Starkey, 5'11" sophomore forward Becki Lowden, and 6'0" sophomore forward Sarah Lowther. Bush averages 6.0 ppg. while adding 12 steals and Lowther averages 6.3 ppg and 3.0 rpg.

**In Manchester's Last Game on Dec. 19 versus St. Mary's College in Notre Dame, Indiana: St. Mary's -- 55, Manchester -- 41** -- In Manchester's last game on Saturday, Dec. 19, the Spartans fell to St. Mary's College, 55-41. The Spartans were led by Kailey Honn with 10 points and eight rebounds. Keys to the St. Mary's victory were forcing 38 Spartan turnovers and holding MC to 35.7% from the floor (15-of-42).

## Yellow Jacket Chatter

**Yellow Jacket 20-Win Seasons** -- **Cheri Harrer's** Yellow Jackets have won 20 or more games in 12 of the past 13 seasons. The school-record for wins in a season is 28, set in 1999-2000. B-W also won 27 contests during the 2000-2001, 2005-2006 and 2007-2008 seasons.

**Ariel Brough's Blocks** -- 6'2" senior center **Ariel Brough** enters this game with 192 career blocked shots and is the school's all-time leader in that category. Last season, **Brough** had a school single-season record and an OAC-leading 80 blocked shots in 29 games (2.76 bpg.). She broke her own school record set two seasons ago with 59. On December 6, 2008 versus Capital University, **Brough** registered a career-high nine deflections, just one shy of the B-W single-game record. A year ago, **Brough** also was named to the *ESPN THE MAGAZINE* Academic All-District IV first-team, Academic All-OAC team for the second straight year and was an honorable mention All-OAC choice.
