The Pre-Game Setup -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team will look to get back on the winning track and sweep the season series versus rival Mount Union College on Wednesday, February 10 in Berea.

The Yellow Jackets enter this game at 16-5 overall and 12-2 in the OAC following a 76-59 loss against Capital University on February 6 in Berea. B-W has won 11 of the last 12 games and is tied for first place in the OAC with Capital.

The Purple Raiders enter this game at 18-3 overall and 11-3 in the OAC following a 61-51 win against Ohio Northern on Feb. 6 in Alliance. Mount Union has won two straight games and six of its last seven and is just one game back of B-W and Capital for first place.

The B-W versus Mount Union All-Time Series -- This is the 71st meeting in women's basketball between B-W and Mount Union. B-W leads the all-time series, 38-33, including wins in the last five games. Earlier this season B-W defeated Mount Union, 65-53, on January 6, 2010 in Alliance. The last Mt. Union win was a 65-61 triumph on February 20, 2007 in the quarterfinal round of the OAC Tournament in Berea. The first-ever meeting was during the 1982-83 season and Mount Union won, 103-50, in Columbus.

In this Year's First B-W versus Mount Union Game on Jan. 6, 2010 in Alliance: B-W -- 65, MUC -- 53 -- In this season's first B-W versus Mount Union game on Wednesday, January 6, 2010 in Alliance, the Yellow Jackets defeated the previously unbeaten Purple Raiders, 65-53 at the MacPherson Athletic and Academic Complex. B-W was led by 5'11" junior All-OAC forward **Amanda Schroeder (Columbus Grove)** with a game-high 22 points and seven rebounds and 6'0" sophomore forward **Nancy Coulter (Washington Court House/ Miami Trace)** with 15 points and six rebounds. Mount was led off the bench by 5'5" junior Katie Crider with 12 points.

B-W Information and Probable Starters -- B-W is scoring 67.0 points-per-game and have allowed 58.9 ppg. for a plus 8.1 ppg. differential. B-W grabs 40.4 rebounds-per-game and allow 33.8 for a plus 6.6 rpg. differential. The Yellow Jackets shoot 42.6 percent from the field (501-of-1175 attempts), including 29.4% from three-point range (69-of-235), and 75.8% from the foul line (336-of-443).

Look for **Cheri Harrer** to start **Amanda Schroeder**, 6'2" senior All-OAC center **Ariel Brough (Powell/Olentangy Liberty)** and **Nancy Coulter** on the inside, and 5'8" sophomore **Monica Gustin (Bexley)** and 5'6" freshman **Rachel Rossman (Olmsted Falls)** in the backcourt.

In addition look for **Harrer** to utilize for 5'6" junior point guard **Ali Stack (Vermilion/ Firelands)**, 5'4" freshman guard **Olivia French (Bucyrus/ Colonel Crawford)**, 5'5" freshman guard **JoBeth Roll (Bucyrus/ Senior)**, 5'9" sophomore forward **Katie Heinlen (Bucyrus/ Wynford)** and 5'11" sophomore forward **Catherine Spisak (Sandusky/ St. Mary Central Catholic)**.

Schroeder has started all 21 games and tops the team in scoring with 13.7 points-per-game and adds 5.0 rebounds-per-game. She has also made a team-best 22 three pointers and has 26 steals. **Brough** also has started all 21 contests and is second at 10.3 ppg. and first with 7.0 rpg. She also has blocked a team and OAC-leading 50 shots. **French** comes off the bench and adds 6.6 ppg. with 39 assists, 19 steals and 10 treys. **Coulter** has started all 21 games and scores 7.1 ppg. and grabs 4.3 rpg. **Spisak** scores 6.5 ppg. and is second on the team with 6.8 rpg. **Rossman** has started all 21 games and scores 3.3 ppg., grabs 2.2 rpg. and leads the team with 54 assists. **Heinlen** scores 4.0 ppg., grabs 4.3 rpg. and has 25 steals. **Stack** has started three times and scores 3.8 ppg. **Gustin**, who has started 18 straight games, scores 1.8 ppg., grabs 1.4 rpg. and ranks second with 50 assists.

In B-W's Last Game versus Capital University on Saturday, February 6 in Berea: Capital -- 76, Baldwin-Wallace -- 59 --- In B-W's last game, a 76-59 loss against Capital University on Saturday, February 6, 2010 in Berea, the Yellow Jackets were led by **Amanda Schroeder** with 17 points including nine-of-nine from the free throw line. Capital broke from a tie late in the first half and never looked back. The Crusaders had several leads of 20 points in the second half. The key to the Crusader victory was forcing 26 Yellow Jacket turnovers, including 17 in the first half.

Scouting the Purple Raiders of Mount Union College -The Raiders score 70.6 ppg. and allow 60.6 ppg. for a plus 10.0 ppg. differential. Mount Union grabs 40.8 rpg. and allows its opponents to grab 37.1 rpg. for a plus 3.7 rpg. differential. Mount also shoots 39 percent from the field (499-of-1278 attempts), including 35% from three-point range (138-of-394), and 66.3% from the foul line (346-of-522).

Look for Head Coach Suzy Venet to start 5'6" freshman Rosa LaMattina, 5'6" senior Tessa Pohovey and 5'8" sophomore Kori Wiedt to start at the guard spots. In the frontcourt, Venet will start 5'10" sophomore Amanda Rose at the forward spot and 5'10" senior Lauren Foquer at center. Pohovey leads the team in scoring with 11.3 ppg., grabs 4.7 rpg. and has 30 assists, 27 three-pointers and 24 steals. Wiedt is second in scoring at 10.1 ppg., grabs 3.6 rpg., tops the team with 35 treys and has 24 assists and 26 steals. LaMattina is third at 10.0 ppg., grabs 2.8 rpg., is second with 34 triples and tops the team with 57 assists and 46 steals. Rose scores 9.5 ppg., tops the team with 6.1 rpg. and has 30 assists and 30 steals. Foquer scores 7.7 ppg., grabs 5.3 rpg. and tops the team with five blocked shots

Off the bench, look for Venet to utilize 5'7" freshman forward Nicole Plant, 5'5" sophomore guard Kelly Evans, 5'6" junior guard Taylor Hartung, 5'8" sophomore guard Erin Schmidt, Katie Crider, 5'10" freshman center Brittany Kilgore and 5'11" junior center Kelsey Wartluft. Crider tops off the bench in scoring at 6.1 ppg. and is tied for third with 27 three-pointers.

In Mount Union's Last Game on Wednesday, February 6 versus Ohio Northern University in Alliance: Mount Union -- 61, Ohio Northern -- 51 -- In Mount Union's last game, a 61-51 win against Ohio Northern University in Alliance, the Raiders were led by Rose LaMattina's 11 points and Tessa Pohovey added 10. The keys to beating the Polar Bears were holding ONU to 32.8% shooting on 21-of-64 attempts, including just one-of-11 from three-point range, and forcing 20 turnovers.

Yellow Jacket Chatter

B-W is Ranked Sixth in the Great Lakes Region Coaches Poll -- Prior to last Saturday's game versus Capital, B-W is ranked sixth in the NCAA Division III Great Lakes Region poll. This is the poll that helps to determine who makes the NCAA Tournament field.

Ariel Brough Among All-Time Leaders -- **Ariel Brough** enters this game with 220 career blocked shots and is the school's all-time leader in that category. Last season, **Brough** had a school single-season record and an OAC-leading 80 blocked shots in 29 games (2.76 bpg.). She broke her own school record set two seasons ago with 59. On December 6, 2008 versus Capital University, **Brough** registered a career-high nine deflections, just one shy of the B-W single-game record. **Brough** also has 622 career rebounds to rank eighth all-time in B-W history. Seventh place belongs to Anjee Beard with 644 career rebounds.

A year ago, **Brough** also was named to the *ESPN THE MAGAZINE* Academic All-District IV first-team, Academic All-OAC team for the second straight year and as an honorable mention All-OAC choice. She is a candidate for all three honors again this season.

Cheri Harrer is Second All-Time in OAC History -- On December 5, 2009, Yellow Jacket veteran Head Coach Cheri Harrer became just the third women's basket coach in OAC history to win 400 games when the B-W defeated Kenyon College, 57-44. On Saturday, Jan. 2 when her team defeated Marietta College, she became the second winningest women's basketball coach in the 105-year history of the OAC when she won her 404th career game. **Harrer** is now 412-142 overall in 20 seasons in Berea. She has led B-W to five OAC Tournament and seven OAC regular season titles in the past 11 years. Eleven of her last 14 teams have advanced to the NCAA Division III National Tournament and three times her teams have advanced to the "Elite 8". She has also been the OAC *Coach of the Year* four times.

Yellow Jacket 20-Win Seasons -- **Cheri Harrer's** Yellow Jackets have won 20 or more games in 12 of the past 13 seasons. The school-record for wins in a season is 28, set in 1999-2000. B-W also won 27 contests during the 2000-2001, 2005-2006 and 2007-2008 seasons.
