The Pre-Game Setup -- The third-seeded Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team hosts Cleveland cross-town rival and sixth-seeded John Carroll University in the first round of the 2010 Ohio Athletic Conference Tournament in Berea. The winner advances to the OAC Final Four on Friday and Saturday, February 26-27 at the site of the highest remaining seeded team.

The Yellow Jackets enter this game at 18-7 overall following a 74-70 loss at Otterbein College on Saturday, February 20, 2010 in the final regular season game. B-W has won 13 of its last 16 contests, but have lost three of its past five games.

The Blue Streaks enter this game at 11-13 overall following a 73-68 loss at Ohio Northern University on Feb. 20 in Ada. JCU has lost its last three games and six of its past eight.

In Other 2010 Women's OAC Tournament Games -- Capital University is the number-one seed and hosts No.8-seed Heidelberg University in Bexley at 7:30 p.m., No.2-seed Mount Union College hosts No.7-seed Otterbein College in Alliance at 7:30 p.m. and No.4-seed Wilmington College hosts No.5-seed Ohio Northern University in Wilmington at 7:30 p.m. The Final Four takes place on Feb. 26-27 at the site of the highest remaining seeded team. Semifinal games are on FRiday, Feb. 26-27 at 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. The 2010 OAC Championship Game takes place on Saturday, Feb. 27 at 3:00 p.m.

The B-W versus John Carroll All-Time Series -- B-W and JCU have met 58 times previously in women's basketball with the Yellow Jackets holding a 39-19 series advantage, including five consecutive wins spanning the past three seasons. Earlier this season, B-W defeated JCU, 75-61, on December 2, 2009 in University Heights, and the Yellow Jackets beat the Blue Streaks, 74-62, on January 27, 2010 in Berea. The last JCU win came on January 16, 2008 by an 80-73 score in Berea. The first meeting was in 1975-76 when JCU won, 57-56.

In this Year's First B-W versus JCU Game on Dec. 2, 2009 in University Heights-- B-W -- 75, JCU -- 61 -- In the first B-W versus JCU game this season, a 75-61 B-W win at the Tony DeCarlo Varsity Center in University Heights on December 2, 2009, the Yellow Jackets were led by 5'11" All-OAC forward **Amanda Schroeder (Columbus Grove)** with a team-high 23 points and game-highs of eight rebounds and three steals. 5'7" freshman guard **Jess Carpenter (North Canton/ Hoover)** came off the bench to score 13 points to lead a 36-6 Yellow Jacket advantage in bench scoring. Also, 6'2" senior All-OAC and Academic All-OAC center **Ariel Brough (Powell/ Olentangy-Liberty)** also scored 10 points, grabbed six rebounds and blocked three shots. The keys to the win were making 21-of-26 foul shots for 80.8% and outrebounding JCU, 49-35. JCU was led by 5'8" junior guard Le Jennings with a game-high 26 points, eight assists, six rebounds and three steals.

In this Year's Second B-W vs. JCU Game on Jan. 27, 2010 in Berea: B-W -- 74, JCU -- 62 -- In the second B-W versus JCU game this season, a 74-62 B-W win in the Ursprung Gymnasium of the Lou Higgins Center in Berea on Jan. 27, 2010, the Yellow Jackets were led by **Amanda Schroeder** with 21 points and seven rebounds. **Ariel Brough** had a double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds, and 5'6" freshman point guard **Rachel Rossman (Olmsted Falls)** had a career-high 10 points. Keys to the Yellow Jacket victory were outrebounding the the Blue Streaks, 44-25, including 11 on the offensive end of the court. Lee Jennings led JCU with 18 points.

B-W Information and Probable Starters -- B-W is scoring 67.6 points-per-game and allows 60.2 ppg. for a plus 7.3 ppg. differential. B-W grabs 39.4 rebounds-per-game and allows 33.5 for a plus 5.8 rpg. differential. The Yellow Jackets shoot 43.1 percent from the field (596-of-1384 attempts), including 30.4% from three-point range (83-of-273), and 76.7% from the foul line (414-of-540).

Look for **Head Coach Cheri Harrer** to start **Amanda Schroeder**, **Ariel Brough** and 6'0" sophomore **Nancy Coulter (Washington Court House/ Miami Trace)** on the inside, and 5'6" junior **Ali Stack (Vermilion/ Firelands)** and **Rachel Rossman** in the backcourt. In addition look for **Harrer** to utilize for **Jess Carpenter**, 5'8" sophomore guard **Monica Gustin (Bexley)**, 5'4" freshman guard **Olivia French (Bucyrus/ Colonel Crawford)**, 5'5" freshman guard **JoBeth Roll (Bucyrus/ Senior)**, 5'9" sophomore forward **Katie Heinlen (Bucyrus/ Wynford)** and 5'11" sophomore forward **Catherine Spisak (Sandusky/ St. Mary Central Catholic)**.

Schroeder has started all 25 games and tops the team in scoring with 14.4 points-per-game and adds 5.2 rebounds-per-game. She has also made a team-best 27 three-pointers and has 29 steals. **Brough** also has started all 25 contests and is second at 10.7 ppg. and first with 6.7 rpg. She also has blocked a team-leading 59 shots. **French** comes off the bench and adds 6.8 ppg. with 43 assists, 26 steals and 12 treys. **Coulter** has started all 25 games and scores 7.5 ppg. and grabs 4.3 rpg. **Spisak** scores 6.3 ppg. and is second on the team with 6.6 rpg. **Rossman** has started all 25 games and scores 3.3 ppg., grabs 2.3 rpg. and leads the team with 75 assists. **Heinlen** scores 3.8 ppg., grabs 4.1 rpg. and has 26 steals. **Stack** has started five times and scores 4.4 ppg. **Gustin**, who has started 19 games, scores 1.6 ppg., grabs 1.3 rpg. and ranks second with 52 assists.

In B-W's Last Game versus Otterbein College on February 20, 2010 in Westerville: Otterbein -- 74, Baldwin-Wallace -- 70 --- In B-W's last game, a 74-70 loss at Otterbein College on Saturday, February 20, 2010 in Westerville, the Yellow Jackets were led by **Ariel Brough** with a game-high 15 points and nine rebounds. In addition, **Amanda Schroeder** had 12 points and eight rebounds. Keys to the Otterbein win was forcing the Yellow Jackets into 27 turnovers. The B-W loss cost it a share of the 2010 OAC regular season title.

Scouting the Blue Streaks of John Carroll University -- The Blue Streaks score 70.6 ppg. and allow 70.1 ppg. for a plus 0.5 ppg. differential. JCU grabs 40.2 rpg. and allows its opponents to grab 45.3 rpg. for a minus 5.1 rpg. differential. JCU also shoots 41 percent from the field (656-of-1600 attempts), including 29.6% from three-point range (110-of-371), and 65% from the foul line (273-of-420).

Look for Head Coach Kristi Maravalli to start Lee Jennings and 5'7" senior Whitney Hamilton in the backcourt and play 5'10" junior Sadie Zander, 5'10" senior Laura Gruber and 5'10" senior Caitlin Sureck on the inside. In addition, look for Maravalli to play 6'0" junior Katie Knox and 5'6" sophomore Kate Mahoney the most off the bench. Also expected to see floor time are 5'11" sophomore forward Katherine O'Brien, 5'4" sophomore guard Taylor Christner and 5'5" sophomore guar Emily Day.

Jennings leads JCU and the OAC in scoring at 22.2 ppg. She also grabs 7.3 rpg., has passed for 134 assists, made 46 steals and blocked 20 shots. She has shot an amazing 225 foul shots this season, but has connected on just 65.8% (148-of-225 attempts). Sureck scores 13.9 ppg., grabs a team-leading 8.2 rpg. and has 58 blocked shots. Hamilton rounds out the double-digit scorers at 10.3 ppg., grabs 3.8 rpg., tops JCU with 36 three-pointers and has passed for 29 assists. Zander, who missed three games earlier this season due to injury, scores 9.0 ppg., grabs 3.1 rpg. and is second with 30 treys, 56 assists and 26 steals. Gruber scores 5.4 ppg., grabs 4.2 rpg. and has 16 steals. Off the bench, Knox scores 4.1 ppg. and grabs 6.8 rpg. Mahoney scores 3.6 ppg. and is third with 17 triples.

In John Carroll's Last Game on Saturday, February 20 versus Ohio Northern University in Ada: John Carroll -- 68, Ohio Northern -- 73 -- In John Carroll's last game, a 73-68 loss at Ohio Northern University in Ada, the Blue Streaks were led by Caitlin Sureck with 22 points and nine rebounds and Whitney Hamilton with 18 points and three rebounds.

Yellow Jacket Chatter

Ariel Brough is Among All-Time Leaders -- **Ariel Brough** enters this game with 229 career blocked shots and is the school's all-time leader in that category. Last season, **Brough** had a school single-season record and an OAC-leading 80 blocked shots and broke her own school record set two seasons ago with 59. She also enters the game with 642 career rebounds and needs three more to move into seventh place all-time.

Brough Earns ESPN THE MAGAZINE Honors for Third Straight Year -- On February 4, **Ariel Brough** was named to the *ESPN THE MAGAZINE* Academic All-District IV first-team for the third straight season and is on the current *ESPN THE MAGAZINE* National Academic All-America ballot (voting ended last Thursday, so we should know the result soon...). A year ago, **Brough** earned Academic All-OAC team for the second straight year and was an honorable mention All-OAC choice.

Amanda Schroeder Approaching 1,000-Point Plateau -- **Amanda Schroeder** enters this game with 948 career points and needs 52 more to become the 12th woman in B-W history to score 1,000 or more points. **Schroeder** also has 325 rebounds, 123 assists, 83 three-pointers, 80 steals and 31 blocked shots. She was a first-team All-OAC pick a year ago.

Brough, Stack and Schroeder Are Academic All-OAC Candidates -- **Ariel Brough** (3.98 grade average in political science), **Ali Stack** (3.532 GPA in middle childhood education) and **Amanda Schroeder** (3.299 GPA In pre-physical therapy) are current candidates for Academic All-OAC accolades.

Yellow Jacket 20-Win Seasons -- **Cheri Harrer's** Yellow Jackets have won 20 or more games in 12 of the past 13 seasons. The school-record for wins in a season is 28, set in 1999-2000. B-W also won 27 contests during the 2000-2001, 2005-2006 and 2007-2008 seasons.

OAC Tourney Titles -- B-W has captured five OAC Tournament titles with Cheri Harrer as its coach. The titles were in 1999, 2000, 2001, 2005 and 2008.
