Twinsburg, OH - Capital will host the 2004 Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) Women's Golf Championships on April 29-30. The Crusaders will host the 36-hole event at the Little Turtle Country Club in Westerville.

Otterbein will look to repeat as champions this year after capturing the 2003 OAC Championship by 95 strokes.
