BEREA, OHIO -- This is a pretty light week for Yellow Jacket sports action on campus. Following tonight's wrestling match, there are just two home events the rest of the week for B-W winter sport teams.

Tomorrow night, in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium, the 22nd-ranked Yellow Jacket women's basketball team, 12-5 overall and 8-2 in the OAC, will host Ohio Athletic Conference and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University at 7:30 p.m.

On Saturday, the 19th-ranked men's basketball team, 14-3 overall and 7-3 in the OAC, hosts OAC-rival Marietta College in Ursprung at 3:00 p.m. At halftime of that game, B-W will honor the members of its 1993-94 NCAA Tournament "Sweet 16" team.

In addition to the wrestlers competing at Thiel (Pa.) this Saturday, the men's basketball team plays at OAC and Cleveland coss-town rival JCU tomorrow night, the track teams are at Capital on Saturday for the OAC Relay Meet at 5:30 p.m., the swimmers (men are 7-3 overall and 3-0 in the OAC and the women are 5-5 overall and 3-0 in the OAC) are divers will face Westminster (Pa.) on Saturday at 1:00 p.m. and the women's basketball team is at Marietta on Saturday for a 3:00 p.m. tipoff.

Injuries Have Played a Large Role in How the Yellow Jackets Have Fared So Far in 2004-2005

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team had three key starters go down in the preseason, another was injured during the fall in an automobile accident, and most recently, one of its top two grapplers was injured at the Division III National Duals at Lycoming (Pa.) College. All of these factors have played a large role in B-W's current 4-13 overall record.

"Injuries are a part of the sport and we have to overcome them," said veteran Yellow Jacket Head Coach Rich Fleming. "It is tough to lose some of the quality people that are part of this program. We have had to change our strategy and refocus our energies toward the end of the season. Right now, we are continuing to work hard, staying focused and trying to do the best we can with the folks who are healthy."

Junior 141-pound All-American Jared Selover was the first key grappler to go down. He was injured in a car accident in the fall and will not compete this year. Then senior 2003 national qualifier and OAC 165-pound champion Joe Heiland, freshman 125-pounder Brett Thomas and senior 184-pounder Sterling Sebek were all hurt before the season. All three returned to the lineup and wrestled for the first time at the Div. III Duals two weeks ago. Then, on his last match at the Duals, junior 285-pounder Bryan Kmetz, the OAC runnerup a year ago, was injured.

"Once we can get everyone healthy and ready to wrestle, we will have a pretty solid lineup, but we just aren't sure when that will be," said Fleming. "Our focus right now is on wrestling Wilmington tonight and getting ready for a tri-match at Thiel this weekend. We can't let this rash of injuries detour us from our goal -- an OAC title."

To date, the Yellow Jackets are led by junior 197-pounder Devin Carman, who is ranked seventh nationally in Division III in the latest Adidas-Brute National Wrestling Coaches Association poll, with 16 wins, a 16-2 record with an .889 winning percentage and 37 takedowns. He also is second with three total falls. Kmetz is second with 15 wins, a 15-3 record and an .833 winning percentage. He is first with 26 near falls and five total falls.



The Yellow Jackets Face OAC-Rival Wilmington College Tonight in an OAC Dual Match at Ursprung

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team, 4-13 overall and 1-1 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, hosts OAC-rival Wilmington College tonight in an OAC dual match in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium.

B-W enters this match coming off of an 0-3 mark at last weekend's National Wrestling Coaches Association National Dual Match Championships at Cleveland State University. At the duals, B-W lost to No.1-ranked Augsburg (Minn.), nationally-ranked Simpson (Iowa) College and to OAC-rival Heidelberg College. To date, injuries have played a large role in how B-W has fared in dual match competition.
