Athletics This Week/ Coming Up**

**BEREA, OHIO --** There is plenty of athletic activity on campus this week, highlighted by the 19th Annual John Summa Tournament on Saturday as well as a pair of basketball games.

In addition to tonight's wrestling match, the women's basketball team, 14-5 overall and 10-2 in the OAC, is playing at Heidelberg in a 7:30 p.m. game.

Tomorrow night in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium, the 15th-ranked Yellow Jacket men's basketball team, 16-3 overall and 9-3 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, will host Heidelberg at 7:30 p.m.

On Friday, the men's and women's indoor track and field teams travel to University Circle to compete at the annual Case Western Reserve University Meet at 5:00 p.m.

On Saturday, in addition to the Summa tourney, the women's basketball team hosts OAC-rival Otterbein College at 3:00 p.m. while the men's basketball team is in Westerville to face Otterbein at 7:30 p.m.

The women's game on Tuesday and men's games on Wednesday and Saturday can be heard locally on campus radio station WBWC, and via the College internet web site.

**The Yellow Jacket Wrestling Team Faces OAC-Rival  
Muskingum College Tonight in an OAC Dual in Berea**

**BEREA, OHIO --** The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team faces Ohio Athletic Conference rival Muskingum College tonight in an OAC dual match in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium.

The Yellow Jackets enter this match with a 6-14 overall and 2-1 OAC record after compiling a 2-1 mark last week. During the week, B-W defeated OAC-rival Wilmington College, 25-15, at Ursprung last Tuesday and then split a pair of matches at Thiel College of Pennsylvania last Saturday. At Thiel, B-W beat the Rochester (N.Y.) Institute of Technology, 23-18, but lost to the host school, 27-12.

In its win against Wilmington, B-W received wins from junior 133-pounder Chris Harrold, freshman 141-pounder Scott Haber, senior 149-pounder Scott Conrath, senior 165-pounder Joe Heiland, junior 174-pounder T. Terry, senior 184-pounder Sterling Sebek and junior 197-pounder Devin Carman.

Leading the way at Thiel were Carman and freshman 125-pounder Brett Thomas who both had 2-0 marks. One of Carman's wins was via a pin.

After five weeks of competition, Carman tops the team with a 19-2 record and a .905 winning percentage. He also is first on the team with 51 takedowns. Carman also has 22 near falls and four total falls. Junior 285-pounder Bryan Kmetz is second on the team with 15 wins and a 15-4 overall record and a .789 winning percentage. Kmetz also is first with seven reversals, first with 24 near falls and five total falls. In addition, Russo has a 9-6 mark at 157 pounds. He is fourth in takedowns with 24. Terry is third on the team with 11 wins and third with 28 takedowns. Sebek is 7-4 overall with a .636 winning percentage.

Fans are reminded that the Yellow Jackets are home again this Saturday for the 19th Annual John Summa Tournament (10:00 a.m. start) and again next Tuesday against Heidelberg College (7:30 p.m.)



**Junior 197-Pounder Devin Carman Named OAC Wrestler  
of the Week for Second Time This Year and Third in Career**

**BEREA, OHIO --** Baldwin-Wallace College junior 197-pounder Devin Carman (Ashtabula/ Geneva High School) has been named as the Ohio Athletic Conference Wrestler of the Week for the second time this year and the third time in his career.

Carman earned the honor for his efforts last week in an OAC dual match win against Muskingum College and then winning both of his matches at last Saturday's tri-match against Thiel (Pa.) College.

For the week, Carman finished 3-0 with a major decision, a pin and another decision to improve his seasonal record to 19-2 overall. He is currently ranked seventh in the last Adidas-Brute Division III poll conducted by the National Wrestling Coaches Association.
