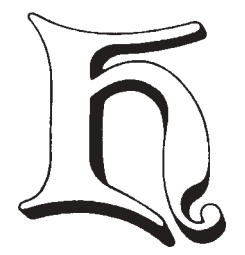

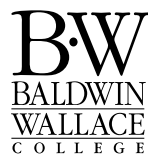

The Yellow Jackets Hosted and the 19th Annual John Summa Tournament Last Weekend, Kmetz Wins MVP

BEREA, OHIO — Brockport State (N.Y.) College won the 19th Annual Baldwin-Wallace College John Summa Wrestling Tournament today (Saturday, February 5, 2005) in the B-W Recreation Center Fieldhouse in Berea, Ohio. The title by SUNY/ Brockport was its ninth straight Summa title. Host B-W finished third of seven school and junior 285-pounder **Bryan Kmetz** highlighted the event for B-W by winning an individual title and the John Summa Most valuable Wrestler Award. In addition, B-W had two other grapplers, junior 197-pounder **Devin Carman** and junior 133-pounder **Chris Harrold** advance to the championship match at their respective weight class. Brockport had four champions and advanced six wrestlers to the championship round. Second place Olivet (Mich.) College had a pair of champions. The Fastest Pin Award was won by Greg Hudie of Olivet, and Brandon Clark of Brockport State College earned the Most Pins Award with three. **Kmetz** won both of his matches in the tourney as beat Duncan Ianucci of Brockport State, 5-2, and then defeated fifth-ranked Patrick Bennett of Brockport State in the finals, 9-3. With his two wins, Kmetz is now 17-4 overall. **Carman**, who is currently ranked seventh in Division III in the latest Adidas-Brute National Wrestling Coaches Association rankings, split a pair of matches to finish second and is now 21-3 overall. He received a first round bye, won his semifinal match due to a medical default early in the first period and then lost in the championship match, 8-4, to Brockport's sixth-ranked Will Weiss. **Harrold** won twice to advance to the championship round before being pinned. John Summa coached wrestling at both Berea High School and Baldwin-Wallace College from 1948 through 1980 and is the winningest wrestling coach in B-W history and led the Yellow Jackets to their only six Ohio Athletic Conference titles in school history.

BEREA, OHIO -- Tomorrow night, both the men's and women's basketball teams will be in action against Mount Union College. The men's team will travel to Alliance for a 7:30 pm showdown with the Purple Raiders which can be heard locally on campus radio station WBWC, and via the College internet web site. The women's team will host the Purple Raiders right here in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium at 7:30 p.m.

On Thursday, the men's and women's swimming and diving teams will be competing in the Ohio Athletic Conference Championships on the campus of John Carroll University. Preliminary action each day begins at 11:00 a.m. and the finals each evening will be at 7:00 p.m.

On Friday, the men's and women's indoor track teams will host the Sparky Adams Invitational on the Harrison Dillard Track in the Baldwin-Wallace Rec Center. Both teams will then travel to Ohio Northern University for the All-Ohio Division III meet on Saturday.

On Saturday, the women's basketball team travel to New Concord, Ohio to face the Muskies of Muskingum College at 3:00 pm. That game can also be heard on radio station WBWC. The men's basketball team will host the Muskies, also at 3:00 pm, here in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium.

The Yellow Jackets Seek Their Fourth Straight OAC Dual Match Victory When They Face Heidelberg Tonight

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team will seek its fourth straight Ohio Athletic Conference dual match victory tonight when it hosts OAC-rival Heidelberg College in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's dual match at 7-14 overall and 3-1 in the OAC. The past three weeks, B-W has defeated Mount Union College (26-15), Wilmington College (25-15) and Muskingum College (26-15). B-W opened its OAC dual match schedule by losing to Ohio Northern University. Overall, the Yellow Jackets have won three of their last four dual matches and placed third at last weekend's 19th Annual John Summa Tournament in Berea (*see more on the Summa Tournament on the opposite page*).

B-W Hosts Seniors' Night on February 17 Versus Case

BEREA, OHIO -- On Thursday, February 17, prior to B-W's final home dual match of the season against Cleveland cross-town rival Case Western Reserve University, the College will honor its senior wrestlers. They are 149-pounder **Scott Conrath** from St. Clairsville, 165-pounder **Joe Heiland** from Shelby and 184-pounder **Sterling Sebek** from Columbus, Georgia.

The Yellow Jacket Leaders to Date

BEREA, OHIO -- After seven weeks of competition, **Devin Carman** tops the team with a 21-3 record and a .875 winning percentage. He also is first on the team with 53 takedowns. **Carman** also has 22 near falls and four total falls. **Bryan Kmetz** is second on the team with 18 wins and an 18-4 overall record and an .818 winning percentage. **Kmetz** is first with 26 near falls and six total falls. In addition, freshman **Gino Russo** has an 11-9 mark at 157 pounds. He is tied for second with junior 174-pounder **T. Terry** in takedowns with 32. Terry is third in wins with 13 and a 13-17 record. **Sterling Sebek** is 11-5 overall with a .688 winning percentage.
